| <p><b>BACK TO PRATT:</b> Brewers no. 4-rated prospect Cooper Pratt homered in back-to-back games for the first time in his professional career after his three-run homer off Tyler Ferguson in the third inning Saturday night. Pratt joined Luke Adams (4/3-5), Eddys Leonard (4/24-25), and Luis Lara (4/25-26) as the fourth Sounds player to homer in consecutive games this season. Over his last 20 games, Pratt is hitting .301 (22-for-73) with four home runs, four doubles, two triples, and 18 RBI with 15 walks and 15 runs scored.</p> <p><b>SLAMI SAMMICH:</b> Eddys Leonard is one of nine players in the minor leagues with multiple grand slams this season. Leonard gave Nashville a 5-0 lead in the bottom of the first inning after clearing the bases off I-Cubs starter Vince Velasquez. Since the Sounds moved to First Horizon Park ahead of the 2015 season, he's the sixth Nashville player with multiple grand slams in the same season. Leonard had just one career grand slam entering the year and now ranks sixth in all Triple-A with a 1.016 OPS and is eighth in SLG (.595). He is tied with Luis Lara for the team lead in HR with seven.</p> <p><b>CLEARED FOR TAKEOFF:</b> Jett Williams capped an 8-run first inning for Nashville with his fourth home run of the season and first since hitting a walk-off three-run shot to beat Norfolk on April 29 at First Horizon Park. The Brewers no. 3-rated prospect is hitting .313 (14-for-44) with four doubles, a triple, and a now a home run in 13 games in the month of May. The eight-run frame for</p> | <p>Nashville was the most runs scored in any single inning this season and the most since also plating eight runs on April 7, 2024, against St. Paul.</p> <p><b>BALL TILL YOU STALL:</b> Garrett Stallings turned in his second straight scoreless outing and quality start on Saturday night. The right-hander worked a season-high 6.2 IP with six strikeouts and four hits allowed. The 6.2 IP is the most in a game for a Nashville pitcher this season and the most for Stallings in a start since working 7.0 IP on September 13, 2023, with Norfolk. Saturday night was his 20th career quality start and 12th of his Triple-A career. Stallings has not allowed an earned run over his last 14.0 IP dating back to his start on May 2nd. Saturday night was the fifth time with consecutive quality starts in his career. He worked three straight QS from June 23-July 4, 2021 to set his career-high.</p> <p><b>ONLY IN MILB:</b> Infielder Ethan Murray earned a handful of firsts on Friday night. He delivered the first walk-off hit of his professional career with a single in the bottom of the 11th inning to score Brock Wilken and give Nashville their second walk-off win of the season. On any other night, that would be the story in itself. However, Friday night was not just any other night. Murray came to the plate in the bottom of the 11th after having just pitched a scoreless top of the 11th after playing the first 10 innings of the game at third base. It also just so happened to be the first pitching appearance</p> | <p>of his minor league career, and he tossed a clean sheet in his mound debut, working around a leadoff walk to strand two runners in scoring position. His first career walk-off hit made him the pitcher of record, and his bat earned himself the first win of his professional career.</p> <p><b>RESPECTFULLY, OF COURSE:</b> Another day, another appearance without allowing an earned run for Brewers no. 28-rated prospect Craig Yoho. The right-hander worked his seventh consecutive appearance and ninth overall in 10 games with a little help from Junior Fernandez, who erased both hits allowed by Yoho in the top of the 10th inning with an inning-ending double play. <b>Since making his professional debut in 2023, Yoho owns the best ERA in the minor leagues (1.20) for any pitcher with 100+ appearances.</b> The next closest is Zach Agnos, who posted a 1.77 ERA in 102 MiLB games over the same span. You would have to lower the number of appearances to 27+ to find a pitcher with a lower ERA than Yoho. Brock Stewart, who is currently in the Dodgers organization, owns a 1.03 ERA over his last 27 appearances in the minor leagues since the start of 2023. The 2.1 IP worked by Yoho were the second-most in his 104 career minor league games and helped to set a new single-game high in Triple-A. He set his career-high for IP with 3.0 IP on May 7, 2024, with High-A Wisconsin. Friday night was his 60th game without allowing an earned run in 67 total appearances with Nashville since making his Triple-A debut on August 9, 2024.</p> |
