#### SOUNDS SMASH SHRIMP IN SERIES FINALE

Nashville crushed Jacksonville 10-0 in Sunday's series finale. In the game's first five innings, the Sounds jumped out to a 5-0 lead. A bases-loaded walk scored a run in the first, a **Carlos Rodríguez** RBI triple and sacrifice fly scored two runs in the third and **Francisco Mejia** socked a two-run home run in the fifth. In the sixth inning, **Vinny Capra** smashed a grand slam to make it 9-0 and the Sounds capped the scoring an inning later on an **Owen Miller** RBI single. The Jumbo Shrimp were shut out for the eighth time this season, tied for the second-most in the league.

#### IT GETS LATE EARLY OUT HERE

Against a tough Nashville starting rotation, Jacksonville's offense performed reasonably well, knocking out Chad Patrick after three innings on Tuesday, Logan Henderson after 3.2 frames on Wednesday and DL Hall after 2.2 innings on Saturday. However, the Sounds' vaunted bullpen completely dominated the Jumbo Shrimp offense. Nashville relievers combined to surrender only five runs on 13 hits in 26.2 innings (1.69 ERA, 25 K, 8 BB) in the six-game series. From the sixth inning on in the six games of the set, Jacksonville was just 11-for-72 (.153) at the plate.

#### ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 28-34 (.452) record. Jacksonville has scored only 264 runs at home (4.3 per game), the fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring about a half-run more per game on the road, totaling 295 (4.8 per game). Meanwhile, also on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered only 277 runs (4.5 per game), the third-fewest in Triple-A. They've yielded the ninth-fewest runs of any team at home (307, 5.0 per game).

#### WHEN THERE'S A WILL, THERE'S A WAY

Jacksonville catcher **Will Banfield** suffered through a disastrous 10-game stretch from May 30 through June 14, going 0-for-36 at the plate. In the 33 games since then, however, the Snellville, Ga. native completely turned his season around. Since this stretch began with a three-hit game on June 16, Banfield is 37-for-118, slashing .314/.354/.500/.854 with five doubles, one triple, five home runs, 22 RBIs, eight walks and 18 runs scored.

#### STRAIGHT AND NARROW

Of Jacksonville's 10 wins during the month of August, seven have come by three runs or fewer, including five by just one run. The Jumbo Shrimp have played in 42 games this season decided by one run, second to lowa (25-18) for the most in the International League. Jacksonville registered 85 contests (57.0 percent of total games, 39-46, .459) contests decided by three runs or fewer during the 2023 season. In 2024, their 79 games this season determined by these narrow margins represents 63.7 percent of the club's 124 games played thus far in 2024. The Jumbo Shrimp are 40-39 (.506) in those tightly-decided contests.

#### BE STILL, MY BEATING START

Jumbo Shrimp starting pitching picked up considerably in the final five games of the club's series at Nashville. In the last five games, Jacksonville lid-lifters have combined to yield only seven runs, all earned, on 15 hits (5.6 H/9) in 24.0 innings for a 2.63 ERA. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp starting rotation has combined for 25 strikeouts (9.4 K/9) against only six walks (2.3 BB/9).

#### **DE LOS SANTOS CLAUS**

Over his last seven games, **Deyvison De Los Santos** is 10-for-30 (.333) at the plate with three doubles, two home runs, eight RBIs and seven runs scored. On the season, the 21-year-old leads all of Minor League Baseball in home runs (35) and RBIs (105) while ranking second in both slugging (.610) and hits (138), third in extra-base hits (59), sixth in OPS (.975), tied for 12th in runs (80) and 18th in batting average (.313). De Los Santos has 10 of Triple-A's 300 hardest-hit balls this season (111.0 MPH exit velocity & above) despite only playing in 74 games at the level. Among the 489 players with at least 100 plate appearances in Triple-A this season, De Los Santos' 90.6 average exit velocity ranks 24th.

#### SHRIMP BITES

Luarbert Arias starting for Jacksonville on Sunday, becoming the club's 23rd different starting pitcher this season. The franchise record came in 2022, when 26 different Jumbo Shrimp pitchers started a game... Over his last five starts, Darren McCaughan is 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA (25.2 IP, 19 H, 8 BB, 29 K, 207 BAA).

#### **ABOUT DARREN**

-McCaughan was originally selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2017 draft out of Long Beach State. McCaughan made his major league debut for the Mariners on July 21, 2021 by pitching 5.0 innings of one-run ball at Coors Field against the Colorado Rockies.

-On February 9, 2024, two days after being designated for assignment, McCaughan was dealt to the Marlins in exchange for cash considerations.

-A terrific collegiate pitcher, McCaughan earned Big West Pitcher of the Year following both his sophomore (2016) and junior (2017) seasons at Long Beach State. He also became the first Long Beach State pitcher since Jered Weaver (2003-04) to be receive multiple All-American honors in consecutive seasons.

-With 414 strikeouts in 84 starts with Triple-A Tacoma, McCaughan is the "Rainiers" all-time strikeout leader (during Seattle affiliation, since 1995), and has accumulated the third-most strikeouts in franchise history. Ron Herbel (443 K) and Steve Luebber (431 K) from the 1960s and 70s remain the only hurlers who've fanned more batters than McCaughan during Tacoma's Triple-A history (since 1960).

#### 2024 SEASON

-Tabbed as Opening Day starter for Jacksonville, tossed six innings and struck out four en route to 5-4 win over Gwinnett.

-Traded by Miami on May 9 to Cleveland for cash. Designated for assignment by Cleveland on June 30 and claimed by Miami on July 7.

#### 2023 SEASON

-In 12 home starts for Tacoma, McCaughan went 4-1, allowing 31 R, 25 ER on 55 hits in 67.2 innings for a 3.33 ERA.

-Held opponents to a .218 batting average when pitching at home.

-Led all Tacoma pitchers in IP (139.0), starts (25), complete games (T-1st, 1) and strikeouts (130).

#### 2022 SEASON

-Led Tacoma pitching staff in starts (28), IP (154.1) and strikeouts (141).

-Held left-handed hitters to a .213 batting average and notched 76 strikeouts.

#### 2021 SEASON

-McCaughan made his major league debut for the Mariners on July 21, 2021 with 5.0 innings of one-run ball in a game against the Colorado Rockies at Coors Field. He did not allow a hit and also did not strike out a batter. He walked three Rockies hitters in a 6-3 Mariners' loss.

-In Triple-A, left-handed batters posted a .779 OPS against him in 252 plate appearances. Right-handed hitters compiled a .699 OPS against McCaughan in 221 plate appearances.

-An excellent all-around player in high school, McCaughan batted .371 during his senior
