JUMBO SHRIMP WALK-OFF ON STRIPERS

After blowing a two-run lead in the ninth inning Sunday, Lorenzo Quintana delivered a walk-off single for Jacksonville to beat Gwinnett 5-4. A Lewin Díaz sacrifice fly in the first and Joe Dunand two-run home run in the second gave the Jumbo Shrimp the initial advantage. The Stripers went on the board in the third on Pat Valaika's two-run single. The score remained 3-2 until the eighth, when JJ Bleday collected an RBI single. Back-to-back RBI doubles in the ninth inning for Braden Shewmake and Valaika evened the tally before Quintana's heroics in the ninth.

SFLF-STARTERS

Through the season's first 10 games, Jacksonville starting pitchers ceded at least four runs on six different outings, posting a collective 7.85 ERA in the process. Over the last eight games, though, Jumbo Shrimp starters have yielded more than two earned runs in a start just once. In total during this run, the Jumbo Shrimp starting rotation has surrendered just 12 runs, eight earned, in 38.1 innings for a 1.88 ERA. During this eight-game run, the club's lid-lifters have registered 26 strikeouts (6.1 K/9) against 31 hits (7.3 H/9) and 15 walks (3.5 BB/9).

RETURN OF THE CARDIAC SHRIMP

The Jumbo Shrimp walked-off on Gwinnett 3-2 in 10 innings on Friday, marking Jacksonville's first walk-off victory of the season. Two days later, the Jumbo Shrimp notched another walk-off triumph, besting the Stripers 5-4. In 2021, 21 of the Jumbo Shrimp's 75 wins came in their last at-bat, a rate of 28 percent. Of those 21 last at-bat triumphs, 11 were walkoffs at 121 Financial Ballpark. Those close victories helped Jacksonville go a whopping 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer in 2021.

CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE

Charles Leblanc went 1-for-4 with a run scored on Sunday, continuing a fantastic start to 2022. The Laval, Quebic City native has already registered multiple hits in six of his 14 games this year, and on the season, ranks fourth in the International League in batting average (.365) and OPS (1.097). He also places fifth in slugging percentage (.654), seventh in on-base percentage (.443), tied for ninth in both hits (19) and home runs (4) and tied for 13th in RBIs (13).

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 23 home runs thus far in 2022, ranking fifth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast in recent years: no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. In fact, the last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its level in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers.

LET THE GOOD TIMES ROLL

Jacksonville's seven-game winning streak - their longest in the month of April since a seven-game run from April 12-18, 2009, and matching their best from the entirety of the 2021 season - came to an end Saturday with a 10-8 defeat to Gwinnett, Nonetheless, the Jumbo Shrimp have won eight of the past nine games, outscoring their opponents by a whopping 64-28 margin and compiling a 93-55 advantage in hits and 13-3 margin in home runs. Since this stretch began on April 15, the Jumbo Shrimp rank sixth out of 120 Minor League Baseball teams in runs, tied for seventh in hits, and tied for 19th in home runs. The club's 24 runs allowed is tied for fifth-fewest in MiLB during this span, with Jacksonville's 2.39 team ERA placing four.

LEWIN AND CLARK BURDICK

Both Lewin Díaz and Peyton Burdick have gotten off to a strong starts. Díaz is 16-for-62, slashing .258/.377/.452/.829 with three doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs and 13 runs scored, Meanwhile, Burdick, the Marlins' reigning Minor League Player of the Year, is 12-for-50, slashing .240/.415/.480/.895 with a double, triple, three homers, six RBIs and a league-leading 17 runs scored. Thus, of the 110 runs the Jumbo Shrimp have scored this season - a figure that ranks second in the IL - the pair have accounted for 46 of those tallies (not double-counting the run scored and RBI from home runs), a ratio of 41.8 percent.

SHRIMP SPECK

Lorenzo Quintana ranks sixth in the IL in SLG (.643), seventh in average (.339), tied for ninth in both hits (9) and home runs (4), tied for 10th in RBIs (14) and 11th in OPS (1.020).

ABOUT BRAXTON

-The Miami Marlins' first-round pick in 2016, Garrett made his professional debut in 2017 but lasted just four starts until an injured elbow forced him to undergo Tommy John Surgery. Garrett went under the knife on June 20, 2017 and missed the rest of the 2017 campaign, as well as the entirety of the 2018 season. While rehabbing, however, he roomed with fellow Marlins prospect Jordan Holloway, who had underwent Tommy John Surgery just five days before Garrett did so.

-Garrett began his high school career at Foley High School in Alabama. However, he moved to Florence when his father, Steve, became the Florence Falcons' head baseball coach.

-Under the tutelage of his father, Garrett was named Alabama's Mr. Baseball as a junior and the state's Gatorade Player of the Year and a first team USA Today All-American as a senior, when he posted a 0.53 ERA with 131 strikeouts in 65.1 innings

2022 SEASON

2021 SEASON

-Garrett was promoted on May 15 to Miami. He made a three-inning relief appearance that night at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles before being optioned back to Jacksonville the following day. The Marlins have recalled and optioned Garrett several more times throughout the 2021 season.

-Garrett's best major league start came on July 24 against San Diego, a game in which he yielded just two runs on four hits in 7.0 innings with 10 strikeouts against one walk.

2020 SEASON

-Garrett made his major league debut for the Marlins in game two of a doubleheader on September 13, 2020 against the Philadelphia Phillies. He ceded just one run on three hits in five innings, striking out six against two walks.

-The southpaw made one additional MLB start one week later, in the backend of a doubleheader against the Washington Nationals. However, Garrett surrendered five runs, four earned, on five hits and three walks in 2.2 frames.

2019 SEASON

-Garrett was promoted to Jacksonville on August 28 from High-A Jupiter. At the time of his promotion, the southpaw ranked fourth in the Florida State League in batting average against (.230), fourth in strikeouts (118) and ninth in ERA (3.34).

-Out of the 109 pitchers in the Florida State League with at least 50.0 innings pitched, Garrett was 11th in xFIP (2.72) and 20th in strikeout percentage (26.9 percent). He had posted the circuit's 10th-lowest fly ball rate (27.8 percent) and 15th-highest ground ball rate (52.7 percent).

2018 SEASON

-Garrett did not pitch during the 2018 season, as he was recovering from Tommy John Surgery.

2017 SEASON

-The Florence, Ala., native did not allow more than one run in each of his first three professional starts. However, he surrendered four runs on six hits in 1.2 frames on May 25 against Kannapolis, which turned out to be his final outing before he underwent Tommy John Surgery.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Had he not decided to turn pro, Garrett had signed to pitch at Vanderbilt University.
