History vs. South Bend

The Lugnuts are 211-189 all-time vs. the Cubs, 101-90 at home and 110-99 in South Bend.

The two clubs met up for a six-game series in Lansing last season, with the Cubs winning four of six games.

The Lugnuts dominated South Bend for years, winning at least 10 games against their foes in 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2000 and 2001, and going 18-6 vs. the South Bend Silver Hawks in 2008 (7-1 in home games).

The Nuts have won three of four in the series to date, the only meetings of the season between the two teams.

Last Night: Cubs 12, Lugnuts 8 (10 innings). Rafael Morel knocked a pair of two-run homers, including in a six-run tenth inning, as the Cubs rallied from 5-0 and 6-3 deficits to score nine unanswered runs for their first win of the series. In defeat, Yuniur Tur fired a career high 7 1/3 innings with four strikeouts.

On Deck: Tomorrow is the series finale, a Capital City Market Kids Day with postgame Kids Run the Bases and an Extra Inning with free ice cream at Capital City Market.

League Overview: Lansing lost and West Michigan won (in Fort Wayne) last night, so with 37 games played and 29 games remaining in the first half, the Lugnuts trail the Whitecaps for first place in the East Division by three games. The winners of the East and West Division in each of the 66-game halves clinch postseason berths.

RoY Candidacy in Full Swing: 2023 Lugnuts shortstop Jacob Wilson, now a rookie with the Athletics, is tied for 2nd in the Majors with 58 base hits and tied for 3rd in the Majors with a .341 batting average. (Meanwhile, 2017 Lugnut Bo Bichette is tied for 3rd in doubles (15) and tied for 4th in base hits (56).)

In the Field: The Nuts have risen to be the second best defensive group in the league, posting a .979 fielding percentage with only 27 errors committed in 1,296 chances. Only West Michigan (25 errors, 1,332 chances, .981) ranks higher.

And on the Mound: Lansing's pitching corps is first in the league in holds (16), first in fewest HBPs (12), first in fewest balks (3), second in fewest walks (131), fourth in WHIP (1.38) and has tossed the only two complete games in the league.

Under the Lights: Let's get specific... the Lugnuts are 1st in the Midwest League in team batting average for night games! (.277 to Cedar Rapids' .270. The Kernels, who have the best overall team batting average in the league, hit .275 for day games, while the Lugnuts are hitting .250 during matinees.)

What a Crowd: Wednesday's attendance of 7,532 was both the Lugnuts' largest crowd of the year and the second largest in the Midwest League this season, trailing only the Dayton Dragons' 8,240 attendance on Saturday, May 10.

Closing in on History: The Kansas City Royals signed former Lugnut Rich Hill to a Minor League contract on Tuesday; if Hill reaches the Majors, he'll play for his record-tying 14th different MLB team. The 45-year-old southpaw pitched for the Lugnuts 22 years ago, going 0-1 with a 2.76 ERA in 15 appearances, 4 starts, striking out 50 batters in 29 1/3 innings. He allowed only 14

MAY 17TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: The Lugnuts and Dragons went to the 12th inning in a scoreless tie, but Dayton snapped the deadlock with three runs against Jonas Cuotto for a 3-0 win. The game was played in three hours and 19 minutes. (This was a bad year for the Lugnuts in extra innings: They went 1-14, losing their first 12 extra-inning games of the year.)

2018: The Lugnuts extended their winning streak to nine with their second four-game home sweep of the year against the Dayton Dragons, 4-1, at Cooley Law School Stadium. Turner Larkins led the way with six scoreless innings, striking out seven. The Dragons' only run came with two outs in the ninth on a Stuart Fairchild RBI single off Brody Rodning.

2024: With two outs in the bottom of the third inning, seven straight Nuts collected base hits and the entire starting nine reached base, keying a six-run rally for an 8-4 win over Lake County.

In a Nutshell: One of five 2024 draft picks on the Lugnuts' 2025 Opening Day roster, joining Tommy White (2nd round), Gage Jump (2nd round compensatory), Joshua Kuroda-Grauer (3rd round) and Rodney Green, Jr. (4th round)... made his Lugnuts debut in relief on April 6 at Fort Wayne, tossing two scoreless innings with three strikeouts to earn first professional win in Lansing's 5-3 victory... made first MWL start on April 10 vs. Great Lakes: allowed two-out, two-run Joe Vetrano double in 3rd (unearned due to a Sahid Valenzuela error), breaking 1-1 tie; tossed five innings in all; suffered the loss in Lugnuts' 3-2 defeat.

Last Game: May 11 at West Michigan – in his second start of the series, Robinson allowed eight hits, one walk and five runs in four innings, with three strikeouts, in a 6-2 loss... gave up a two-run homer to Jack Penney in a three-run 2nd inning and an RBI single to Penney in a two-run 3rd inning... 78 pitches, 50 strikes.

Marshall High School (Falls Church, Virginia)... named All-Conference First Team as sophomore, junior and senior... named Conference Pitcher of the Year and Conference Player of the Year as a senior: 66 2/3 IP, 1.49 ERA, 60 K... George C. Marshall is best known for the Marshall Plan, which saw the United States give \$13.3 billion to help rebuild Western European economies; it earned Marshall the 1953 Nobel Peace Prize... Marshall's nickname is the Statesmen... other notable Marshall alumni include the first woman to officially run the Boston Marathon, Kathrine Switzer; safety and current Dallas Cowboys special teams coordinator Nick Sorensen; defensive end Michael McCrary; table tennis legend Sean O'Neill; and pitcher Pete Schourek.

Texas Tech: Robinson opened up his time in Lubbock as a reliever in 2022, appearing in 12 games (including nine appearances without allowing an earned run)... as a sophomore, was named to the 2023 Collegiate National Team; posted 5.36 ERA in 45 1/3 innings before finishing strong, posting five scoreless innings with eight strikeouts in the Big 12 Tournament against Oklahoma State to earn a nod on the All-Tournament Team, then limited No. 2 Florida to two ER in five innings in the NCAA Tournament... as a junior, led the Red Raiders with 76 IP in 15 starts, with a 5.09 ERA; struck out 11 in six innings at Oklahoma State on May 11, 2024... drafted following junior year... notable Texas Tech pros include Josh Tomlin, Danny Coulombe, Josh Jung, and the inimitable Dallas Braden.

Welcome to Pro Ball: Signed for \$150,000 after being selected with the first pick of Day 3 by the A's... made pro debut for Stockton on August 23, 2024 (2 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 2 K)... made three starts in total before Stockton's season ended, allowing exactly two earned runs in each outing... lefties hit .333 (6-for-18) with 1 BB / 6 K, while righties hit .273 (3-for-11) with 2 BB, 3 K... base-stealers went 2-for-2... pitched in the 2025 Crosstown Showdown, tossing two scoreless innings against Michigan State in relief of Yunior Tur.
