SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

RECORD SETTING MULTI-HIT MADNESS: OF Carlos Rodriguez has tallied multiple hits in five straight games, tied for the longest multi-hit streak in Shuckers' franchise history (since 2015)... Rodriguez is the second Shuckers player this year to record a five-game multi-hit streak and the fifth player in franchise history with a streak of at least five game... OF Jackson Chourio previously tied the record with five straight between July 6 and July 18.

During Rodriguez's five-game multi-hit streak, he is 10-21 (.476) with a double and six RBI... Over that span, he's raised his average from .268 to .283, a 15-point increase.

<u>CLOSING IN ON THE RECORD BOOKS</u>: OF Jackson Chourio enters today three home runs away from becoming the first teenager in Double-A or Triple-A to record 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases in a season since **OF Delmon Young** in 2005 with the Montgomery Biscuits (TB).

Chourio's 71 RBI are tied with OF Dillon Thomas for the second-most in a single-season in Shuckers' history (since 2015)... Chourio is three away from tying the single-season franchise record (74), set by OF Corey Ray in 2017.

<u>TIME TO GO PROSPECTING</u>: Baseball America and MLB Pipeline both released their updated Brewers Top-30 and overall Top-100 prospect lists on Wednesday and Thursday... **OF Jackson Chourio** (No. 2), **C Jeferson Quero** (No. 34) and **RHP Jacob Misiorowski** (No. 38) were all listed within the Top-40 of MLB Pipeline's new rankings... The Brewers have six MLB Pipeline Top-100 prospects, tied with the Cleveland Guardians for the second-most in baseball.

PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS: Entering today, the Biloxi Shuckers would qualify for the 2023 Southern League Playoffs, their first appearance since 2019... The Shuckers have two paths to make the playoffs; win the South Division in the second half OR finish runner-up in the division if the Pensacola Blue Wahoos win the second-half title in the division... The Shuckers have a one-game lead on the Blue Wahoos and the Montgomery Biscuits for the division lead... The Shuckers would face the Blue Wahoos in the South Division Championship Series if they qualify.

<u>TODAY'S STARTER // RHP JACOB MISIOROWSKI (1-1, 7.80)</u>: RHP Jacob Misiorowski makes his fifth Double-A start, and his first against a Braves affiliate... Last time out, Misiorowski tied his career-high with nine strikeouts in just 3.2 innings... Over his first four starts in Double-A, Misiorowski has struck out 29% of batters faced... Today marks his first of two scheduled starts in this week's series against the M-Braves.
