**TODAY'S GAME:** Today's action will see the continuation of Friday's postponed game, followed by a seven-inning contest, which will mark the fifth game in the six-game series, as your Quakes take on the Inland Empire 66ers (LAA) at San Manuel Stadium. The Quakes return to LoanMart Field next Tuesday, April 23, hosting Lake Elsinore in a six-game set. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

**VS THE 66ERS:** Today's game is the fourth of 24 head-to-head meetings between the two clubs and the fourth of 12 at San Manuel Stadium. Last year, the Quakes went 8-4 here at San Manuel Stadium, 14-13 overall against the 66ers.

**LAST GAME:** The Quakes and 66ers endured a pair of power outages on Friday night and were eventually postponed. The game began 55 minutes late and then was halted for a second time in the bottom of the first inning, as San Manuel Stadium lost all power for the second time. The Quakes grabbed a pair of runs in the top half of the first inning, but Inland Empire was threatening in the bottom of the inning, as their first two batters reached safely. Both regularly-scheduled starters on Friday were scratched, after getting loose and then having to be shut down due to the first power outage. Cam Tullar allowed the two first-inning runs to the Quakes, while Rancho's David Tiburcio started the bottom of the inning. Today's game will pick up in the bottom of the first with two on and no outs, with Inland Empire's Anthony Scull at the plate. Rancho's Roque Gutierrez is scheduled to take the hill when game one resumes.

**GELOF GETS POW:** The Cal League announced its first set of weekly awards in 2024 and Quakes' third baseman Jake Gelof was named the Cal League Player of the Week after a strong start to the 2024 season. Gelof knocked in 12 runs in his first seven games and entered this week's action with a .320 batting average and a .424 on-base percentage. Gelof also took home the final Cal League Player of the Week award of the 2023 regular season.

**FAMILIAR FACES ON THE FIELD:** The Quakes have 29 active players on their 30-man roster to open this road trip. Of the 29, 23 have seen time in Rancho within the last two years. Returning Quakes include pitchers Patrick Copen, Carlos Duran (2022), Gabe Emmett, Jorge Gonzalez, Roque Gutierrez, Edgardo Henriquez (2022), Carlos Martinez, Garrett McDaniels, Jose Rodriguez, Christian Ruebeck, Noah Ruen, David Tiburcio and Reynaldo Yean. Returning position players include Jesus Galiz, Cameron Decker, Wilman Diaz, Jake Gelof, Jeral Perez, Jordan Thompson, Joe Vetrano, Juan Alonso, Josue De Paula and Kendall George.

**PROSPECTS TO WATCH:** The Quakes have four players on their current roster who are rated by MLB Pipeline as Top-30 Dodgers prospects. Three of them play in the outfield, with Josue De Paula (#4), Kendall George (#12) and Zyhir Hope (#21). Infielder Jake Gelof is the other ranked prospect, as he checks in at #23.

**CARLOS DURAN:** Carlos Duran will make his second start of the year for the Quakes and first against the 66ers. This will be Duran's second appearance with the Quakes since 2021, when he went 2-4 with a 5.25 ERA over 20 games (18 starts). It will also mark his second start since 2022 overall, after suffering a season-ending injury that resulted in Tommy John surgery. Duran threw two scoreless innings against Stockton last Saturday night, but the game was eventually scrapped, so the stats do not count. Duran signed with the Dodgers out of the Dominican Republic in 2018.

**BARRETT KENT:** Right-hander Barrett Kent makes his third start of the year and his first against the Quakes. In his last start, he allowed four runs (three earned) on two hits with six walks over four innings in a loss at Fresno on April 11. Made just three appearances after getting drafted in 2023, covering 8.2 innings in 2023, including one game and four scoreless innings with Inland Empire. Kent was drafted by the Angels in the eighth round of the 2023 draft out of Pottsboro High School in Pottsboro, Texas.
