A LOOK BACK AT LAST YEAR

The 2024 Baysox finished the season with an overall record of 62-75 and fell short of the postseason for a third straight year. Despite this, Baysox pitching was one of the best in the Eastern League and in Double-A. Chesapeake set a single-season franchise record with 1,319 strikeouts, which was 2nd-most in the Eastern League and in Double-A. They also had the 4th-best ERA in the Eastern League (3.79). Samuel Basallo was named the Eastern League's Top MLB Prospect, becoming the second Baysox player in franchise history to be named and the first since Adley Rutschman. Two 2024 Baysox also made their MLB debuts in Billy Cook (Pirates) and Seth Johnson (Phillies).

MEET THE SQUAD

Chesapeake's 2025 Opening Day roster features 19 returners from last year and nine newcomers. Of the returners, five are top 30 Orioles prospects with three in the top 15, according to MLB Pipeline. OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** (No. 3), RHP **Patrick Reilly** (No. 10), C **Creed Willems** (No. 12), RHP **Trace Bright** (No. 25) and RHP **Alex Pham** (No. 29) all return to Bowie while notable newcomers include top-20 O's prospect RHP **Juan Nunez** (No. 20), RHP **Zach Fruit**, former Royal RHP **Dylan Coleman** and non-roster Spring Training invitee IF **Jeremiah Jackson**.

ELECTRIC ENRIQUE

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** begins his first full season in Double-A after swiping the second-most bases in the Minors last year with 74 stolen bags. The Orioles' 17th overall selection in 2023 led all O's minor leaguers in runs, tied for second in triples, and was fourth in hits. The Orioles top outfield prospect also received a Minor League Rawlings Gold Glove Award after recording only two errors all season.

CREED CRUSHES

C **Creed Willems** is set to begin his first full season in Chesapeake. The Orioles No. 12 prospect matched his career-high with 17 homers and set a new career-high with 65 RBI last season. Willems raked in the final series of the regular season last year, going 10-for-21 (.476) with three doubles, a homer and eight RBI against Erie. He also played in the Arizona Fall League and was named a Fall League All Star after batting .338 with an .891 OPS.

TELL THE WHOLE PHAM

RHP **Alex Pham** receives the Baysox Opening Day start for the second straight year, becoming just the second Baysox pitcher ever to receive two Opening Day starts. The Orioles No. 29 prospect collected a career-high 138 strikeouts last season, which was the 3rd-most in the Eastern League and the 6th-most in all of Double-A. Pham has been sharp in his career against Altoona, posting a 2.97 ERA in seven outings.

OPENING DAY HISTORY

In the 31 seasons of Chesapeake Baysox baseball, the Baysox are 15-16 all-time on Opening Day. Over the last 10 seasons, the Baysox have lost six of those season openers. Last year, the Baysox grabbed a first inning lead against Reading but the Fightin' Phils scored three in the 9th to secure the win at Prince George's Stadium.

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

The Altoona Curve host the Baysox for the first three of 21 total meetings between the two this season. The Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates went 62-76 overall last year but fared better in the second half after a franchise record 15-game losing streak in the first half. Altoona's active roster features five Pirates' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com), IF Termarr Johnson (No. 4), LHP Hunter Barco (No. 7), IF Jack Brannigan (No. 11), UTL Mitch Jebb (No. 13) and LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 14).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Hunter Barco gets the Opening Day starting nod for the Curve in 2025. The Pirates 2nd round pick in 2022 pitched mostly in High-A Greensboro where he struck out 77 batters in 62 innings to a 3.34 ERA. Barco made two starts for Altoona in mid-July but missed the remainder of the season due to a stress response in his left shin. Barco pitched collegiately at Florida, where he was teammates with former Baysox OF Jud Fabian.

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasma De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" - a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasma de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
