FROM THE CROWS NEST

POSTSEASON PICTURE: On Thursday night, the Marauders were eliminated from postseason contention after Clearwater's victory over Tampa. The Marauders were eyeinig their first postseason appearance since 2021 when they won their second FSL title. Clearwater will face first-half winner Lakeland in the West Divisional round, while St. Lucie will host Daytona for the East Divisional Round. After three more games with Dunedin to end the regular season, the two will begin the 2026 regular season at TD Ballpark in Dunedin on April 2.

CLEVARI TOES THE RUBBER: Right hander Clevari Tejada will toe to rubber for the Marauders in game five of the series for his team-leading 23rd start. Over a career-best 87 innings this season, Tejada has pitched to a 5.07 ERA and completed five innings or more six times. Last Saturday vs Tampa, he completed 2.2 innings and allowed four runs. Over his five outings in July, Tejada was dominant, allowing just four earned runs over 19 innings of work (1.89 ERA). However, the right hander struggled in August, allowing 17 ER over his five outings (9.00 ERA). Tejada's fastball saw a major uptick in velocity in July, as he averaged 94.9 miles per hour and topped out at 96.9 - good for his hardest pitch of the season. 12 of his 13 hardest thrown pitches this year have come during his last seven outings. Tejada's slider has been a plus offering to both left-and-right-handed hitters, as opposing batters at just 10-for-51 against it (196, 38.3% Whiff). His splitter has also surrendered just seven hits this season (156) and has generated a 37.0 percent whiff rate. Overall this season, Tejada has seen an increase in swing-and-miss (18.7% K, +1.1% from 2024) and decrease in walks (9.9% BB, -1.6% from 2024).

SETTING THE TABLE: Infielder Ethan Lege walked twice in last night's game to extend his on-base streak to 17 games, passing Jhonny Severino (6/24-7/12) for the longest such streak by a Marauder this season. Over the stretch, Lege has reached base at a .391 clip via 13 hits and 12 walks. After drawing just seven free passes in his first 34 games/128 plate appearances (5.4% BB), the Ole Miss product has walked 19 times in his last 28 games/106 plate appearances (17.9% BB).

MR. 100: After Diamondbacks infielder Jordan Lawler graduated from MLB Pipeline's Top 100 prospects list, Marauders outfielder Edward Florentino was named the No. 100 prospect in all of baseball (No. 98 via Baseball America). He was also named Florida State League Player of the Month for his dominant performance in July. He remains the only Marauders player to be honored this season by Minor League Baseball. Over the 23-game stretch, Florentino slashed .301/.433/.663 with 16 stolen bases and 17 walks. His eight home runs and 23 RBI were the most of any player throughout the Florida State League and Single-A. Florentino was also one of three Single-A players, and the only in the FSL, to tally 15 or more walks and ten or more extra-base hits. Florentino is the Pirates No. 5 ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline and was promoted to Single-A Bradenton on June 21.

FLY FLY AWAY: The Marauders currently lead the Florida State League with 102 home runs, marking their fifth season in franchise history reaching the triple-digit threshold. With two games to go, they're 15 away from matching their all-time high of 117 in 2023. Moreover, they also have blasted the most in Single-A, as they've now passed San Jose (California League, 98). 157 of their 578 total runs have been generated via the long ball (27.2%). They're 37-32 when leaving the yard at least once, and 22-38 when not homering at all. They've seen six players launch 9+ home runs this season, more than any other team in the FSL (A. Plaz, Y. De Los Santos, K. Griffin, J. Severino, E. Florentino, E. Rodriguez).

TONY TATERS: Pirates No. 30 prospect (MLB Pipeline) **Tony Blanco Jr.** demolished two homers during the Marauders previous homestand. On July 30, he sent a fastball 415 feet to left field, that cleared the confines of LECOM Park. The ball left his bat at 118.9 miles per hour, marking the hardest-hit ball in Single-A at the time, clearing the next closest batted ball by 4.4 mph. Three nights later, he also demolished a walk-off three-run homer that left the bat at 119.8 mph - the hardest-batted ball in MiLB this season. Only three batted balls at the Major-League level have been hit harder this season. He joins Oneil Cruz (122.9 mph) and Vladamir Guerrero Jr. (120.4 mph) on the list. Only him and Cruz (122.9 mph) have left the yard with such batted ball quality. He was activated and assigned to Single-A Bradenton on Saturday, July 19 at Jupiter.

MARAUDERS ON THE MEND: In this year's draft the Pittsburgh Pirates selected RHP Seth Hernandez sixth overall in the first round of the 2025 MLB Draft and signed with the organization on Tuesday for 7.25 million dollars, the largest bonus ever for a prep pitcher. Hernandez was recently named 2025 Gatorade National High School Player of the Year and spent the 2025 season as a senior at Corona High School in California (0.39 ERA/53.1P, 105 K). He was committed to Vanderbilt University. At 19 years old, he was touted as the best prep arm in the draft, and the No. 3 overall prospect in the draft class via MLB Pipeline. His fastball reached 100 miles per hour, paired with an esteemed changeup, curveball and slider.

CLEVARI TEJADA'S HIGHS

Right hander **Clevari Tejada** will toe to rubber for the Marauders in game five of the series for his team-leading 23rd start. Over a career-best 87 innings this season, Tejada has pitched to a 5.07 ERA and completed five innings or more six times. Last Saturday vs Tampa, he completed 2.2 innings and allowed four runs. Over his five outings in July, Tejada was dominant, allowing just four earned runs over 19 innings of work (1.89 ERA). However, the right hander struggled in August, allowing 17 ER over his five outings (9.00 ERA). Tejada's fastball saw a major uptick in velocity in July, as he averaged 94.9 miles per hour and topped out at 96.9 - good for his hardest pitch of the season. 12 of his 13 hardest thrown pitches this year have come during his last five outings. Tejada's slider has been a plus offering to both left-and-right-handed hitters, as opposing batters at just 10-for-51 against it (.196, 38.3% Whiff). His splitter has also surrendered just seven hits this season (.156) and has generated a 37.0 percent whiff rate. Overall this season, Tejada has seen an increase in swing-and-miss (18.7% K, +1.1% from 2024) and decrease in walks (9.9% BB, -1.6% from 2024).
