TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes hold a 2-1 series advantage after claiming a 6-2 win last night over El Paso ... The Isotopes have won just three of their last eight after winning eight of their previous 10 contests ... Albuquerque is expected to start Juan Hillman while Luke Westphal is slated to toe the rubber for the Chibuahuas

VS. EL PASO: Albuquerque has won seven of its last 10 games against EL Paso. With two more wins in the set, the club can claim their second-straight season series victory over the Chihuahuas and third series triumph of the year, and second series win over El Paso in 2024.

INDEPENDENCE DAY: The Isotopes improve to 13-7 all-time on Independence Day and 5-4 on the road. It's the Isotopes first win on July 4th since 2021 (12-7 vs. El Paso).

DINGERS: The Isotopes belted two homers last night and have tallied a dinger in 19 of their last 20 contests (34 during span), including 10 multi-homer games.

TWO RUNS OR FEWER: Albuquerque limited El Paso to just two runs for the second time this series and fourth overall time in 2024. They've held their opponent to two or fewer runs four times since June 22.

FREE PASSES: The Isotopes pitching staff issued just one walk on the night, tied for the second-fewest free passes in a game in 2024 (six times). The staff has walked one or fewer four times since May 29.

ATTENDANCE: Over 45 openings, Albuquerque has tallied the third-highest total attendance in all of Minor League Baseball (296,330) and highest in the Pacific Coast League ... The club is also averaging 6,585 per game, the highest in the Pacific Coast League.

XBH: The Isotopes collected just two extra-base hits last night (two homers), the 12th time the club has tallied just two extra-base hits. Albuquerque won just their second game recording just two XBH (also: June 25 vs. Salt Lake, 8-4).

PITCHING STAFF: The pitching staff held the Chihuahuas to just one extra-base hits, the 10th time the staff has limited their opponent to one. The team has yet to hold the opposition to zero in 2024.

HITS: Albuquerque has recorded double-digit hits in three-straight games, the longest streak since a six-game stretch from May 17-23.

TAKE FLIGHT: Jimmy Herron recorded two hits and three RBI for his 11th multi-hit contest last night, second in his last three games and fourth in last eight. Recorded three RBI for the second time in 2024 (last: April 14 vs. Sugar Land). Has multi-hit RBI in two-straight games for first time this year.

STOVIE: Hunter Stovall collected two hits yesterday for his 14th multi-hit contest of the year and eighth in his last 13 games (June 15) ... Has a hit in 14 of his last 16 contests, slashing .365/.423/.524 with four doubles, two homers and 10 RBI ... Does not have an extra-base hit since a two-double game on June at Oklahoma City.

HIS NAME IS DREW: Drew Romo tallied his 21st multi-hit game of the year last night, second-straight and third in his last six games. Has multi-hits in two-straight games for first time since May 15-18 vs. Sugar Land. Romo is 6-for-14 to start July after batting .231 in June.

BIG WILLIE STYLE: Willie MacIver connected on his 14th multihit game of 2024 last night and second-straight. Has four-game RBI streak for second time this year, five during stretch (also: June 11-16 vs. EL Paso) ... Also has a four-game hitting streak (6x13).

GRANNY: Grant Lavigne belted his 12th homer last night and first since June 25 vs. Salt Lake. Has a hit in four-straight contests (5x15).

T-BONE: Trevor Boone saw his three-game streak with a homer come to an end Wednesday, the second longest for an Isotope in 2024 (Hunter Goodman, four: April 17-20 at El Paso).

JC: Julio Carreras swiped his 20th bag of the season June 19, establishing a new career high.

MR. JONES: Greg Jones is just 1-for-17 over his last three contests with three hitless games ... In his first seven games after being optioned to Albuquerque from Colorado (June 22-29), slashed .419/.471/.806 with a double, triple, three homers and five RBI.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 6th in average (.309) ... Sean Bouchard is T-5th in triples (5) ... Julio Carreras is T-8th in SB (20) ... Greg Jones in T-11th in stolen bases (19).

TEAM STATS: Offensively in MiLB, the club is 1st in triples (40), and total bases (1,407), 2nd in hits (817), slugging (.478) average (.278), 3rd in OPS (.834) and 8th in runs (492).

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
