NEWS & NOTES

THE LAND OF THE BRAVES: The Hudson Valley Renegades match up with Rome Braves for the second and final series of the season. Their first meeting back in April, was a part of a two-week road trip through the South where the Renegades took five out of six from Rome and finished the road swing 9-3.

HITTING THE FINAL STRETCH™: With only six games remaining in the first half of the South Atlantic League season, the Hudson Valley Renegades find themselves in first place, one game ahead of the Greensboro Grasshoppers for the SAL North lead. The Renegades magic number is six.

LAST TIME OUT: After the Rome Braves plated three runs in the top of the ninth inning to tie the game at four, the Hudson Valley Renegades recorded their third walk-off win of the season on a **Spencer Henson** bases loaded hit by pitch in the 10th inning. **Alexander Vargas** singled home a run and **Grant Richardson** crushed an inside the park home run in the sixth. **Zach Messinger** punched out seven batters in five shutout innings.

TEXAS FOREVER: On Thursday, the New York Yankees announced the promotion of RHP Chase Hampton to Double-A Somerset. In nine starts with the 'Gades this season, Hampton owned a 2-1 record with a 2.68 ERA in 47.0 innings. The Texas Tech product ranked 1st in the South Atlantic and 6th in all of Minor League baseball with 77 strikeouts.

TWIN KILLINGS: The Hudson Valley Renegades used a season-high four double plays on Thursday night to circumvent traffic on the bases in a 5-4 victory over Rome. Their previous high was three on May 14th against the Aberdeen IronBirds. The three ground ball twin killings are tied for the most in a game in the South Atlantic League this season.

THE 10 K CLUB: After RHP Juan Carela racked up his second 10-strikeout game of the season on Friday night, **Drew Thorpe** struck out a career-high 12 batters on Sunday. The feat has been performed seven times this year with **Chase Hampton** collecting three 10 K games and Thorpe holding the other two. The 12-strikeout performance by Thorpe on Sunday is tied for the second most in High-A this year. In 2022, the Renegades had only three double-digit strikeout performances by a single pitcher, both T.J. Sikkema in his final two games with the club before he was traded to Kansas City in the Andrew Benintendi trade.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER: Hudson Valley's bullpen has been nails during the last 15 games. Renegades relievers combined for a 1.25 ERA (50.1 IP, 21 H, 9 R/7 ER, 20 BB, 59 K). The home run hit by Brandon Parker on Wednesday was the first earned run allowed by the 'Gades bullpen since May 31st. The streak spanned 36.1 innings.

STARTERS AIN'T TOO SHABBY EITHER: The last turn through the rotation

for Hudson Valley has seen some outstanding pitching. Since May 31st against Aberdeen, Renegades starters have a 1.46 ERA (80.0 IP, 44 H, 20 R, 13 ER, 33 BB, 103 K), the best in Minor League Baseball in that span. The 1-3 strikeouts are also the most in the MiLB as well. The Springfield Cardinals (STL-AA) have tossed only three more innings in this span for the Minor League lead in innings.

THE ANTHONY GARCIA EFFECT: Since his return to the lineup on June 3rd, the Renegades are 7-1 with **Anthony Garcia** in the starting nine. In his first eight games back, Garcia is 8-for-32 with a 3B, HR, 4 RBIs, three walks and six runs.

BIG WINS AND LOSSES: The Renegades have already played in an extraordinary number of lopsided games this season, with 23 of the team's 60 games (38.3%) being decided by 5-or-more runs.

- ❖ Hudson Valley sports a 13-10 (.565) record in game decided by 5+ runs.
- ❖ The club has already played seven games decided by 11-or-more runs, and has a 4-3 (.500) record in those games.
- ❖ The 'Gades have also played 16 one-run games, and are 6-10 (.375).

DOUBLE OR NOTHING: **Spencer Jones** tallied his 19th double of the season on Wednesday against the Rome Braves. Jones is 2nd in the South Atlantic League only trailing Wilfred Veras (WS) who has amounted 21 total. The 19 doubles are good for third in High-A and are the most among all NYY Minor Leaguers.

DON'T RUN ON ME: Renegades catcher **Antonio Gómez** caught a pair of runners on Sunday against Jersey Shore to bring his total runners thrown out to 20 in 33 games behind home plate this year.

- ❖ He owns the highest mark in the South Atlantic League and High-A, and good for t-7th in MiLB.
- ❖ Gómez has thrown out 27.1% of would-be basestealers this year. The SAL average is around 21%.
- ❖ Nick Clarro (AUG -- A, ATL) leads MiLB with 35 CS while Gómez is t-7th.
- ❖ In the month of May, Gómez caught 34.1% of attempted runners (14-for-41).

CLIMBING THE LADDER: With a hit on Sunday, **Eduardo Torrealba** has tallied 117 career hits with the Renegades, good for third all-time. With his performance on Friday, he surpassed **Jacson McGowan** and **Luis Mateo**. **Angel Perez** holds the franchise record with 125.

PUTTING THEM ON THE HARD WAY: After plunking another batter on Wednesday, the Renegades have hit 48 batters with pitches this season, the most of any team in the South Atlantic League and 15th-most in MiLB. Incredibly the Modesto Nuts (SEA, A) have hit 73 batters this season in 60 games.

RASCAL'S RUBBISH

BREAUX: On a Minor League rehab assignment from Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. Led HV with 17 HR in 2021 season.

CABRERA: Set a new career high with 5 RBIs on 6/6 @ Jersey Shore --> 2-for-4, R, 2 2B, 5 RBI, BB, 2 K.

CRISP: Was hitting .400/.625/.400 in three games (2-for-5) with Double-A Somerset to start the season.

COWLES: Picked up his 10th multi-hit game of the season on 6/6 @ Jersey Shore, and his first three-hit game.

FLORES: Held hitless in back-to-back games for the first time in his career on 5/2 & 5/3 vs Wilmington.

GARCIA: After only playing in only one game (2 AB) since 5/3, went 1-for-3 vs ABD (6/4).

GÓMEZ: Hit .151/.200/.233 in May after batting .271/.358/.339 in April.

HENSON: Back-to-back-to-back multi-hit games on 5/24, 5/25, and 5/26 at Wilmington -- 9-for-16, 2 2B, HR, 3 RBI

JONES: Ranks 2nd in the South Atlantic League, third among all High-A players and first among Yankees minor leaguers in doubles (19).

RICHARDSON: Batted .417/.517/.583 during seven-game hitting streak from May 18-27.

SÁNCHEZ: Finished 2nd on the team, 5th in the SAL in SB (32) last year...tied franchise record with two triples vs WIL (5/3).

TORREALBA: Picked up his 100th and 101st hits as a Renegade on 5/10 @ Aberdeen.

VARGAS: For the 2018 international signing period, was ranked by MLB.com as the No. 8 prospect.

LAST TIME OUT: Carela brushed off a shaky start to strike out 10 across 5.2 innings on Friday night at Jersey Shore as the Renegades won 8-4 in 10 innings. He allowed two runs in the first and another in the third, but settled down after that to his normal self. He allowed only one hit after the third inning, and walked only one batter, the last batter he faced in the game, Leandro Pineda. He became the second Renegades pitcher of the season to strike out 10 batters in back-to-back starts, joining Chase Hampton.

YANKEES DIRECTOR OF PITCHING SAM BRIEND ON CARELA: "Carela was always one of those guys we thought could develop into one of the biggest arms in our system. A really athletic kid, if you look at it in 2019 where he started in the Complex League, he struggled to throw strikes to now throwing strikes. Year over year he's continued to mature and develop. He's added a cutter from last year, and he's really taken ownership of that pitch. He's starting to get it more in the zone, and he's always had the slider that he developed last year which kind of set his career on fire and we are starting to see more of the velocity that we always thought was there. It's really exciting to see him start to put all of those pieces together and get a better idea of who this kid really is."

2023 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season on the Renegades Break Camp Roster.
- Tied his career-high with nine strikeouts on April 15 against Aberdeen in 4.1 IP. Left with HV leading 1-0.
- Named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on 4/24: 0-0, 5.2 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 8 K in 1 GS at Rome.
- Allowed 12 hits on 4/29 at Greenville, the most by a Renegades pitcher in a single-game since 2005. His nine runs allowed were the **most by a Renegades pitcher since Frank De Los Santos allowed 10 runs on July 31, 2008 at Tri-City.**
- Tied franchise record (since 2005) by hitting three batters on 5/19 vs Brooklyn, a record shared with eight others, most recently T.J. Sikkema on 7/3/2022.
- Threw 6.1 innings (0 ER) on 5/26 at Wilmington, tying his career high for innings pitched (6/16/22 @ St. Lucie).
- Became the first Renegades SP to complete 7.0 innings in a start in 2023 on 6/3/2023 vs Aberdeen.** The last Renegades pitcher to complete 7.0-or-more innings was Richard Fitts on Aug. 27, 2022 vs Hickory (8.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 7 K)... It was the first time since 8/14/2021 that a Hudson Valley starter threw 7.0 innings and the team did not win (Randy Vásquez vs. Jersey Shore), and just the second occurrence since the start of the 2013 season.
- Became the second Renegades starter to strike out 10 batters in back-to-back starts when he did so on June 2 & 9, joining Chase Hampton, who did so on May 27 and June 3.

2022 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season with the Single-A Tampa Tarpons... assigned to High-A Hudson Valley on 8/4.
- Named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week on 6/12: 1-0, 0.00 ERA, 6.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 9 K in 1 GS vs Palm Beach Cardinals.
- Praised early in the season by Yankees Director of Pitching Sam Briend for his intellect, ability to self-evaluate his strengths and weaknesses, game planning, and ability to learn from mistakes.
