SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

LOOKING LIKE LUTZ: OF Tristen Lutz tallied a multi-home run game on Saturday night, his first since June 4, 2019 against the Frederick Keys as a member of the Carolina Mudcats in High-A... The multi-home run performance was the fourth of his career... His second home run was measured at 416-feet and left the bat at 107 MPH.

<u>THE SUMMER OF CHOURIO</u>: OF Jackson Chourio hit his team-leading 15th home run of the year on Thursday, becoming one of three teenagers with at least 15 home runs in 2023, and the only one to do so in Double-A and Triple-A.

- Since July 1, Chourio is among the Southern League leaders in stolen bases (3rd, 8), AVG (4th, .383), slugging percentage (5th, .691), OPS (5th, 1.129) and RBI (T-5th, 18).
- Chourio is the first teenager to tally at least 15 home runs in a season in the high minors since INF Fernando Tatis Jr. did so in 2018 with the Double-A San Antonio Missions... Six players have reached the mark since 2005.
- Chourio enters today five home runs away from becoming the first teenager to record a 20/20 season in the high minors since OF Delmon Young reached the mark with the Montgomery Biscuits in 2005.

<u>THEY HAVE THE POWER</u>: Entering today, the Shuckers have 38 home runs in July, the second-most out of any month in franchise history... Their 38 home runs are also the most in the Southern League, and tied for the second-most in Double-A... The Shuckers need five home runs today to tie their franchise record of 43, set in July of 2018.

NOW THAT'S A SERIES WIN: The Shuckers have already clinched their third straight series win, thanks to five straight wins this week against the Barons... The three straight series wins are longest series winning streak by the Shuckers since they won three straight series coming out of the All-Star Break in 2022... A win today would also clinch Biloxi's first six-game series sweep since July 20-25, 2021 against the Mississippi Braves.

<u>SWIPING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS</u>: The Shuckers enter today with 172 stolen bases, the second-most in Double-A and the sixth-most in Minor League Baseball.

- The Shuckers are currently on pace to tally 250 stolen bases, the most by any Double-A team since 2005... Their 250 would be 14 shy of the Southern League record, set by the Birmingham Barons in 1989.
- OF Jackson Choruio (31) has combined with INF Tyler Black (47) to reach become the first Shuckers' pair to steal at least 30 in a year since 2017... The pair have combined to steal more bases (78) than 12 different full-season Mil B teams.

<u>TODAY'S STARTER // RHP JAMES MEEKER [5-3, 3.43]</u>: After a career-high six innings and 72 pitches on Tuesday in the series-opener, **RHP James Meeker** will make his seventh start and 23rd appearance on the year... Entering today, Meeker has issued a walk to 2.4% of batters faced, the lowest mark in Minor League Baseball (min. 60 IP).
