SALT LAKE TAKES THE OPENER

The E-Train fell 7-2 to the Bees on Tuesday. Salt Lake CF Nelson Rada knocked a one-out double, moved to third on a single from SS Chad Stevens, then scored thanks to a sacrifice fly from DH Carter Kieboom in the third. Round Rock RF Trevor Hauver made it a 2-1 game in the bottom of the frame with a double that scored 2B Alex De Goti and CF Dustin Harris. LF Cavin Biggio tied the contest at two apiece in the fourth as he scored on a wild pitch. The Bees continued their push and claimed a 4-2 lead in the sixth inning. C Sebastián Rivero led off the frame with a solo home run before RF Ben Gamel scored Rada with a double. Salt Lake added two more to their total when Stevens recorded a two-RBI double with one out in the top of the eighth inning. Kieboom increased the visitors' lead to 7-2 with a single that scored Stevens. Round Rock threatened, loading the bases with two singles and a walk in the eighth inning, but a groundout ended the attempt. The E-Train put one runner aboard in the ninth before the Bees recorded the final out to claim the 7-2 win.

BACK TO CJ

RHP Carl Edwards Jr. is set for his seventh start with the Express. He has gone 5.0 innings or more in his last two starts. On August 21 at St. Paul, he earned the win in 5.0 shutout innings with four walks and six strikeouts. The 33-year-old opened the season with Salt Lake and tossed a 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) in seven games and one start with two saves. He appeared with the Angels from April 23-26 before he was designated for assignment.

HARRIS HEATER

CF Dustin Harris extended his hitting streak to nine games after going 3-for-5 with one run scored yesterday. He is slashing .375/.419/.550 with five doubles, a triple, four RBI, eight runs scored, three walks, six strikeouts and four stolen bases during the streak.

SAY HELLO TO THE NEW GUY

INF/OF Dylan Moore is set to make his Express debut on Wednesday. Moore signed a minor league contract with Texas after he was designated for assignment by the Seattle Mariners on August 23. Moore appeared in 671 games with Seattle from 2019-2025. He earned the 2024 Rawlings American League Utility Gold Glove.

HAUVER KEEPS ROLLING

Express OF Trevor Hauver extended his on-base streak to nine games yesterday. Since August 16, 2024 he leads the PCL in OBP (.417) and is tied for third in walks in the PCL in the second half (33).

AN EYE ON THE STANDINGS

Round Rock is 3.0 games out of first place with 25 games remaining. Their next three series comes against Salt Lake, at Albuquerque and back home to face Sugar Land. Those three teams own a combined second half record of 68-85. The Express end the year at Sacramento (31-21).

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2025 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's third season with the E-Train. In 2024, Davis secured his 800th win as a manager on July 12 at Reno. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided the E-Train to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 744-665 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
