Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the second game in a six-game series at the West Michigan Whitecaps, High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This is the 475th all-time meeting between the two teams and the second tilt in a 21-game season series. Lansing is coming off a 7-5 homestand, winning four of six against Fort Wayne and splitting a six-game series with Lake County.

Last Night: Whitecaps 2, Lugnuts 0. In a scant two hours on the nose, West Michigan blanked the Nuts behind Andrew Sears' five hitless innings and two-hit relief from a trio of relievers, with the Whitecaps' no-hit bid broken up with two outs in the eighth inning on a T.J. Schofield-Sam clean single to center field. Kyle Robinson pitched 6 2/3 innings for his third straight quality start, but allowed two third-inning runs, deciding the game.

On Deck: The GLIAC Tournament takes over Jackson® Field™ beginning tomorrow; meanwhile, the Lugnuts play the Whitecaps through Sunday, returning home for a sixgame series running from May 13-18 against the South Bend Cubs.

Prospecting: The Nuts boast the Athletics' second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman Tommy White (40th overall), currently on the Injured List; southpaw starter Gage Jump (73rd), shortstop Joshua Kuroda-Grauer (75th) and outfielder Rodney Green, Jr. (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 13 and Green is No. 18. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old Steven Echavarria, rated No. 12, and outfielder Nate Nankil, who is No. 28.

Hump Day Success: The Nuts are undefeated in four Wednesday games this season, outscoring the opposition 24-8 - and of those eight runs allowed, five came off Yunior Tur in 13 2/3 innings, spanning three starts. All other pitchers combined have allowed only three runs and 10 hits in 19 1/3 innings.

Congratulations! Minor League Baseball named tonight's starter, Gage Jump, its Midwest League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 28-May 4, recognizing Jump's near-perfect effort on a rain-shortened Thursday in Lansing: a five-inning complete game shutout with seven strikeouts while allowing only one baserunner, a Jonah Advincula single in the fourth inning. Jump edged teammates Kyle Robinson (six hitless innings) and Grant Judkins (six scoreless innings, two hits allowed) for the honor.

Congratulations, Part II: Starter Kyle Robinson was honored on the field on Sunday as the Lugnuts Booster Club Player of the Month for April. Robinson earned the win in the Lugnuts' first victory of the season on April 6 at Fort Wayne, following up with one earned run allowed in five innings vs. Great Lakes on April 10; two runs allowed in 4 2/3 innings at Wisconsin on April 17; and back to back quality starts, with six innings of one-run ball vs. Fort Wayne on April 24 and six hitless innings vs. Lake County on April 30.

No Offense, but...: The Lugnuts have collected exactly two hits in each of their last two games, walking off the Lake County Captains on Sunday, 1-0, in ten innings on a Sahid Valenzuela single, and breaking up West Michigan's no-hit bid yesterday in the eighth inning. This comes after the Lugnuts only notched five hits in a 3-1 loss on Saturday. All told, Lansing has nine hits in its last 27 1/3 innings.

Low Scoring on the Road: The Nuts are slashing a cool .285/.388/.421 in 18 games at home this year, an .809 OPS, albeit while posting a 4.98 ERA and allowing a .250 average against. But in 10 games on the road, Lansing is batting .217/.320/.293, a .613 OPS, with an ERA of 3.04 and an opponent average of .231.

2009: When Henderson Álvarez was on the mound, magical things had a way of happening. On this day, the 19-year-old fired a nine-inning complete game against Peoria in two hours and one minute, allowing four hits, one walk, one run, and one strikeout in a Lugnuts 4-1 victory.

2010: The Lugnuts collected seven doubles and one triple – The Great Balbino Fuenmayor had two doubles and one triple by himself – in a 9-4 victory at Fort Wayne. No. 9 hitter Chris Hopkins led a 16-hit attack by going 4-for-5 with a steal. Chad Jenkins tossed seven innings, allowing only Nate Freiman's two-run homer in the 4th.

2024: In one hour and 54 minutes, the Loons opened up a six-game series with the Lugnuts with a 2-0 shutout, thanks to a Chris Newell two-run homer in the sixth inning at Dow Diamond. Lansing starter Wander Guante fired five scoreless frames, only to see Jacob Watters victimized by an immediate Noah Miller double and Newell home run in the sixth. Watters held the Loons hitless from there, but the damage was done.
