The two teams are coming off an unusual doubleheader split yesterday, making up a postponement from April in Eastlake, Ohio, so that the Lugnuts were the home team in Game 1 and the Captains were the home team in Game 2 last night.

Welcome to Lansing: Tonight will see the newest Lugnut makes his Midwest League debut, with right-hander **Jake Garland** taking the ball against Lake County right-hander **Aaron Davenport**. The Athletics' 17th-round selection last season from the University of Miami, Garland posted a 2.78 ERA in six appearances, four starts, with the Single-A Stockton Ports; on April 13, he struck out seven batters in five perfect innings against Modesto and was named the California League's Pitcher of the Week.

Big League Nuts: Four former Lugnuts have reached the Majors this year, all win with the Oakland A's: **Ryan Noda** (March 30), **Hogan Harris** (April 14), **Mason Miller** (April 19) and **Garrett Acton** (May 14). 177 Nuts have now reached the Majors all-time since the inaugural 1996 season.

Starting Lineup: Lansing starting pitchers used this year: **Brady Basso**, **Blake Beers**, **Joelvis Del Rosario**, **Christian Fernandez**, **Grant Holman**, **Mitch Myers**, **Jack Owen**, **Jack Perkins** and **Jacob Watters**. **Jake Garland** makes no. 10 tonight.

Streiking: Catcher **Daniel Susac** reached base twice yesterday, going 0-for-2 with a walk in Game 1 and 2-for-4 in Game 2, reaching base for the 16th and 17th straight games. He is currently slashing .340/.446/.489 in May, raising his overall slash line to .284/.362/.457, an .819 OPS.

Thievery: First baseman / outfielder **Danny Bautista, Jr.** has stolen bases in each of the three games of this series, giving him six steals in seven attempts in May and seven steals in nine attempts overall. Bautista is batting .271 (13-for-48) this month with four multi-hit games.

Hoos(ier) the New Top Prospect? With **Jordan Diaz** graduating from prospect definition, the other Lugnuts on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 list like **Daniel Susac**, **Max Muncy**, **Clark Elliott**, **Euribiel Angeles**, **Jacob Watters** and **Joelvis Del Rosario** each moved up one slot, making room for starter **Jack Perkins** to be the new No. 30 prospect in the A's system.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2014: In a tie game in the bottom of the ninth, Dayton Dragons reliever Evan Mitchell attempted to complete an intentional walk to Jorge Saez with runners at first and third, but catcher Brandon Dailey's passed ball on Ball 4 brought Justin Atkinson in from third with the winning run in a 4-3 Lugnuts win.

2017: The Nuts win their 1500th game all-time, winning 5-1 at South Bend's Four Winds Field. Patrick Murphy carried a perfect game bid into the sixth inning, outdueling top prospect Dylan Cease. Lansing had lost five straight games before finally reaching the milestone.

In a Nutshell: Making Lugnuts debut today, becoming the 10th different starting pitcher this season and the 909th all-time Lansing Lugnut... joins Jacob Watters (4th round) and Jack Perkins (5th) as 2022 draft picks in the rotation... @JakeGarland25.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg).

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... only two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.
