**TODAY'S GAME:** The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, continuing a six-game set at Erie.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Jackson Glenn and Mike Jarvis each had two hits in a 4-3 defeat at Erie. Noe Toribio fired 2.1 scoreless innings of relief following Anthony Solometo's start.

**GET SHORTY:** Righty Aaron Shortridge has turned in his best work of the season since the calendar flipped to the second half. Since June 28 he's recorded a 3.32 ERA, the best mark by a qualified Curve pitcher. In the month of August, Shortridge has earned a win in all 5 of his starts and recorded a 1.91 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) with just 7 walks and 24 strikeouts. 9 times this season, Shortridge has turned in a quality start. In the month of August, the 26-year-old ranks: 4th in ERA (1.91), 1st in W (5), 1st in IP (33.0), and T-8th in WHIP (1.09). Overall on the season he ranks 1st in the Eastern League with 24 starts, T-1st with 10 wins, and 2nd with 127.1 IP.

**A HISTORIC NIGHT IN CURVE, PA:** With right-hander Paul Skenes making his Double-A debut on Saturday, August 26, the Curve welcomed the largest crowd in franchise history with 10,164 fans at Peoples Natural Gas Field. The attendance total surpassed the Pirates-Curve Exhibition game on March 30, 2013 (10,116) and is the largest crowd in the Eastern League since July 27, 2013 when the Portland Sea Dogs hosted the Harrisburg Senators in front of 16,674 fans at Fenway Park. It was the fourth time since 2005 that an Eastern League club has announced over 10,000 fans in a game at an Eastern League Park. Altoona won a wild back-and-forth affair with the 'Ducks after Skenes didn't make it out of the first inning. Matt Gorski picked up three hits, including a game-tying double in the ninth inning. Joe Perez reached in all five of his plate appearances (including hitting his 6th home run in 13 games with Altoona) and Carter Bins sent the record crowd home happy with a walk-off infield single that ricocheted off the pitcher with the bases loaded and two out in the ninth inning.

**HE'S HERE:** Right-hander Paul Skenes, the No. 1 Overall selection in the 2023 draft has joined the Curve for his Double-A debut on Saturday, August 26. Skenes is the 5th player No. 1 overall selection to suit up for the Curve following RHP Kris Benson (1996 / 2002 rehab), RHP Bryan Bullington (2002, 2004 with Curve), RHP Gerrit Cole (2011 / 2012 with Curve) and C Henry Davis (2021 / 2022-23 with Curve). Skenes allowed 2 walks and 3 groundball hits with an exit velocity under 90 mph in his Double-A debut on August 26 against Akron.

**FLAVA-FRAZ:** Outfielder Matt Fraizer matched his career-high with four hits and reached base in all five of his plate appearances in Altoona's 8-1 win over Akron on Wednesday, August 23. Fraizer has reached base safely in 14 straight games in which he's batting: .364/.397/.527 with 2 2B, 2 3B, 1 HR and 6 RBI. He owns the league's longest active hit streak at 13 straight games. Fraizer's 102 hits rank 6th in the Eastern League and his 59 runs scored rank 9th in the Eastern League.

**NOT YOUR AVERAGE JOE:** Signed as a minor league free agent on August 10 after six seasons in the Astros system, utility man Joe Perez has reached base safely in each of his 16 games played with Altoona, batting .351/.471/.719 with 3 2B, 6 HR, 14 RBI, and 18 K's. Twice in a Curve uniform he's homered in back-to-back games.

**OUR OWN HOWLER:** Left-hander Jackson Wolf, acquired from the Padres in the Rich Hill and Ji Man Choi deal, has remained one of Double-A's best strikeout artists this season. He's struck out 20 in 21.0 innings since joining the Curve, giving him 125 this season between San Antonio and Altoona, the 10th-most strikeouts by a pitcher at the level, also ranks 13th in ERA (3.95), 8th in BAA (.226) and 5th in WHIP (1.12).

**THE BIG LEFTY:** Lefty Anthony Solometo is the youngest pitcher to reach the Eastern League this season, doing so at 20 years, 6 months and 15 days when he made his debut on June 17 at Somerset. Solometo is the 13th player in franchise history to suit up for the Curve under the age of 21 and slots in as the 5th-youngest player in the team's history between C Ryan Doumit, who was 20 years, 4 months, 0 days old when he debuted on August 3, 2001, and LHP Sean Burnett, who was 20 years, 6 months, 18 days old when he debuted on April 4, 2003. Solometo leads all qualified Pirates minor leaguers with a 3.31 ERA and ranks 5th with 116 strikeouts this season. He is one of 8 players to play in the EL at age 20 or younger, Harrisburg has two of them: Brady House and James Wood. Jackson Holliday (BOW), Jasson Dominguez (SOM), Yanquel Fernandez (HFD), Blaze Jordan (POR) and Marcelo Mayer (POR) are the others in the league that are not permitted to drink alcohol.

**STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE:** Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out. Entering play on Friday, September 1, Altoona has struck out 998 times, still the fewest among Double-A teams and 4th-fewest in minor league baseball. Altoona's franchise record for fewest strikeouts in a season is 811 achieved in 2003 when the Curve struck out an average of 5.75 times per game. The 2023 Curve are striking out an average of 8.31 times per game.

**THE 'WOLVES OF THE SEA:** Managed by Gabe Alvarez for a second straight season, the SeaWolves are headed back to the postseason with a First Half Championship already under their belt. Erie ranks 2nd in the league in runs scored entering this series, 3rd in OPS and their pitching staff ranks 4th in ERA and 2nd in strikeouts among Eastern League teams. INF Jace Jung and RHP Ty Madden highlight their roster.

**THE FIRST HOWLER:** Tyler Mattison starts a bullpen day for Erie. Mattison was Detroit's 4th round pick in 2021 out of Bryant University and has been terrific for Erie this season, punching out 39 batters in 27.0 innings with a 2.00 ERA. Mattison is ranked as the No. 27 prospect in the Tigers system by MLB Pipeline as a relief arm that could move quickly this year.

## TODAY IN CURVE HISTORY

2004 - Curve clinched first division title in franchise history with 4-2 win over Trenton. Brad Eldred hit his 15th homer since joining the Curve in late July and Zach Duke was the winning pitcher.

2017 - Mitch Keller fanned 11 Harrisburg Senators and picked up the winning decision with six scoreless frames of Altoona's 6-5 win over the Senators.

2021 - Roansy Contreras returns after missing 2 months with a right forearm injury and throws 2 innings with 3 strikeouts. Marcos Gonzalez knocked a solo homer in the second inning to lead Akron to a 9-5 win over Altoona.

**2023:** Made his professional debut on August 10 with the FCL Pirates and tossed a scoreless inning... Promoted to Bradenton on August 15 and made two starts, totaling 3.0 scoreless innings... Made his Double-A debut on August 26 against Akron in front of a PNG Field record 10,164 fans, left after hitting pitch limit (33)...

**COLLEGE:** Began his collegiate career at the Air Force Academy where he was one of the nation's best two-way players as a freshman... Batted .367/.453/.669 with 31 2B, 24 HR and 81 RBI in 100 career games at the plate... Went 11-4 with a 2.72 ERA in 33 games (15 starts) in two seasons on the mound... Was named the National Co-Freshman of the Year by Collegiate Baseball in 2021 an award he shared with future LSU teammate OF Dylan Crews... **Earned the 2022 John Olerud Award** given to the nation's best two-way player, a season in which he went 10-3 with a 2.73 ERA and struck out 96 batters in 85.2 IP and batted .314/.412/.634 with 10 2B, 13 HR and 38 RBI at the plate... Transferred to LSU for the 2023 season and focused solely on pitching... **Earned the 2023 Dick Howser Trophy** given to the nation's best **NCAA Division I** player for the 2023 season after he finished 13-2 in 2023 with a 1.69 ERA in 122.2 innings... Also voted the 2023 National Player of the Year by Collegiate Baseball and D1 Baseball... Named the 2023 SEC Pitcher of the Year, first LSU winner since Aaron Nola in 2013 and 2014... Was named the Most Outstanding Player at the 2023 College World Series after going 1-0 with a 1.15 ERA with 21 strikeouts in two starts in Omaha... Struck out 48% of batters he faced in SEC play...

## SKENES CAREER NOTES

Features a fastball (96-100), curveball, slider, and change-up

**CAREER TRANSACTIONS:** Drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 1st round (1st overall) of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of LSU... Signed on July 18, 2023 for a bonus of \$9.2 million, the largest bonus ever given, breaking Spencer Torkelson's \$8.4 million dollar bonus in 2020...

**CURVE CUTS:** Paul Skenes... Attended El Toro High School in Lake Forest, CA where he was a three-year letterwinner and team captain as a senior... Grew up rooting for the LA Angels... Spent the first two seasons of his collegiate career at the Air Force Academy where he earned the 2022 John Olerud Award as the nation's best two-way player... Was a member of Cadet Squadron 9... Also saw time as a catcher at Air Force... Son of Karen and Craig Skenes; Craig works for a pharmaceuticals company, and Karen is a stay-at-home mom... has an older sister, Lauren, and a younger sister, Kristen... His uncles Mike and Pete served in the U.S. Navy and his uncle, Dan, served in the U.S. Coast Guard... Majored in military strategic studies while at Air Force... Chose to attend Air Force for "The opportunities it presents both while I am here and after I graduate. Also, the people I meet here are the best people to be around and will make me better." (h/t Air Force Sports Information)... Air Force Head Coach Mike Kazlauskys told NOLA.com in Spring 2023 "He will serve his country in some manner moving forward. It's just going to be a matter of when. Paul and I have spoken about that piece. We'll get him back in the military once his professional playing days are over. It's a big deal for Paul to be able to serve his country..." Had he remained at Air Force he would have had to fulfill his military service obligation following graduation, his only way to avoid that was to transfer before his junior season... After working at 93-95 mph and touching 99 with his fastball as a sophomore, Skenes averaged 98 mph and hit 102 with his fastball at LSU... **Pledged to make a \$10 donation for every strikeout he recorded in 2023 at LSU to Folds of Honor, a nonprofit organization that provides educational scholarships to the spouses and children of military and first responders who have died or been disabled... Struck out an SEC single-season record 209 batters resulting in a \$2,090 donation...** Became the first LSU player to be selected No. 1 overall since Ben McDonald was picked by Baltimore in 1989 (McDonald previously held the SEC single-season strikeout record)... He and OF Dylan Crews (No. 2 Overall - Washington) are the first college teammates to ever be selected in the top two picks of the draft... Was ranked as the No. 1 prospect in the 2023 Draft by MLB Pipeline, No. 2 by *Baseball America*... Was rated as having the "Best Fastball", "Best Breaking Ball", third in "Best Control" and fifth in "Best Changeup" in the 2023 college class by *Baseball America*... Was also rated as the "Best Athlete" among the 2023 college class by *Baseball America*...
