2023: Entered season as Phillies second-ranked prosepct, trailing only Andrew Painter. Earned invite to Phillies spring training. Appeared in two games (one start) and threw three innings. Allowed no runs and one hit. Struck out two and walked two. 2022: Split season between High-A Jersey Shore and Double-A Reading. Went 7-8 over 18 starts with Jersey Shore. With Reading, he started five games and went 1-3 with a 4.01 ERA. 2021: Spent entire season with Single-A Clearwater. He started 14 games and went 1-3 with a 4.43 ERA over 44.2 nnings pitched. 2020: Was first round selection of Phillies out of Jesuit High School in Portland, Oregon. High School: First baseman and pitcher for Jesuit. Injured shoulder as sophomore and required surgery. As a junior Abel posted a 10–0 record with a 1.26 ERA and 111 strikeouts in 72+1/3 innings pitched while also batting .294 with 12 runs scored and 14 RBIs as he helped lead the Crusaders to a state championship and was named the Oregon Gatorade Player of the Year and a Junior All-American by MaxPreps.
