RIDERS TAKE DOWN ROCKHOUNDS 2-1, WIN GAME FIVE OF THE SERIES:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Midland RockHounds 2-1 on Saturday evening from Riders Field. Frisco (26-17) starter **Dane Acker** (2-1) tossed 5.0 innings, allowing just one unearned run on three hits and three walks while fanning four. Locked in a scoreless battle in the bottom of the fourth, Midland (28-16) starter Blake Beers (2-3) allowed a leadoff homer to **Cody Freeman**, his sixth jack of the season. Two batters later, **Abimelec Ortiz** blasted a 420-foot shot to center, giving Frisco a 2-0 advantage. Midland scratched across an unearned run in the top of the fifth, using a pair of errors and a groundout by Jack Winkler to cut the Riders lead to 2-1. Beers recorded a quality start, spinning 7.0 two-run frames while surrendering just two hits (both homers). **Triston Polley** spun 1.2 innings of scoreless ball, allowing two hits and a walk with a pair of K's. **Ricky DeVito** recorded the final out of the seventh and worked a scoreless ninth. **Andy Rodriguez** snatched his second save of the season, facing the minimum in the ninth. Acker, Polley, DeVito and Rodriguez held the RockHounds hitless with runners in scoring position, going 0-for-7. Offensively, the Riders mustered just three hits, but did work three walks. **Aaron Zavala** reached on a bunt single in the eighth, notching the final hit of the night for Frisco.

FULLY LOADED:

The RoughRiders have been the best hitting club in the Texas League with the bases loaded this season, hitting .333 (12-for-36) with 38 RBIs, but they are one of two teams (Corpus Christi) without a grand slam. This is coming off of last season when the RoughRiders hit a franchise record nine grand slam.

TO BE FAIR, IN MY DEFENSE:

The RoughRiders have committed just 24 errors this season in 43 games, the fewest in all of Minor League Baseball. Their .984 fielding percentage is the best in MiLB as well. Their 42 double plays are first in the Texas League and fourth among non-Triple-A teams. **Cody Freeman** is one of just 14 players in Minor League Baseball who has at least 80 total chances and has no committed an error while he is one of just two non-first baseman infielders with at least 80 chances and no errors.

RISP-ECT THIS:

The RoughRiders have been great with runners in scoring position this season, but have struggled recently. Over their last eight games, they are just 3-5 and are hitting .164 (9-for-55) with runners in scoring position. On the season, they are still first in the Texas League, batting .275 with RISP. **Cody Freeman** leads the team and is eighth in the Texas League, batting .350 with RISP.

MORE THAN O-KAY(ber):

Keyber Rodriguez has been tearing up the baseball over the last week. In his last 10 games, Rodriguez is hitting .432 (16-for-37) with six multi-hit games during that span, including five doubles, a triple, a home run, seven RBIs, two walks, five runs scored and a steal. The infielder raised his batting average from .087 to .300 and OPS from .371 to .865 over the last week.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has the longest on-base streak this season for the RoughRiders, currently at 28 games. During the streak, he hit .308 (32-for-104)/.397/.433/.830 with two doubles, a triple, three home runs, 10 RBIs, 16 walks, six steals and 25 runs scored. The streak is the second-longest active streak in the Texas League. In his career, Strahm has the second-longest on-base streak in RoughRiders franchise history (37 games in 2022). His 161 career walks with the RoughRiders are the second-most in franchise history, trailing only **Guilder Rodriguez**, who walked 206 times over seven seasons from 2009 to 2015.

I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

Cody Freeman had a monster game on April 25th against Amarillo, going 5-for-5 with two home runs and a double. It was the first five-hit game in Freeman's Minor League career and the first one for the Riders since **Blaire Crim** accomplished the feat on September 2nd, 2022 at Amarillo. Freeman is fourth in the league in batting average (.309) and sixth in SLG (.510). In his last 26 games, he has batted .354/.382/.635/1.017 with all five of his homers. This season, he has the seventh-lowest strikeout rate in the Texas League (12.9%) and has just whiffed six times in 19 games and 69 at-bats in May.

THE HATCHER HAMMER:

In an incredible win on April 27th, **Josh Hatcher** hammered a three-run, walk-off home run for a 4-3 win over Amarillo. Hatcher's capper was his third home run in as many games. He is slashing .309/.346/.463/.809. Hatcher is third in the league in batting average (.309). Hatcher was named the Rangers Minor League Player of the Month for April. He slashed .373/.403/.576/.979 over 15 games for Frisco in April with three doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, 11 runs and three steals. He finished third in the Texas League in batting average (.373), tied for eighth in RBIs (16), sixth in slugging (.576) and sixth in OPS (.979).

ABOUT EMILIANO

-Signed in 2020 for \$10,000 at age 18 (which is much older than the normal 16-year-old international signing age for most Dominican players).

-Routinely touches triple digits with his fastball.

-Comps to Jordano Ventura because of small frame and electric stuff. Changeup has splitter-like action to it.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation and as the No. 16 prospect in the Rangers organization according to MLB.com.

-After allowing four runs over 2.2 innings in first start, has gone 2-0 with 1.20 ERA over last six starts (4ER/30.0IP).

-He allowed two doubles in his first start and hasn't allowed any extra-base hits since.

2023 SEASON

-Finished 4th among Rangers farm hands in 2023 with a 12.26 K/9 (7th-best in the South Atlantic League).

-Missed the first month and more with minor right forearm tightness (activated 5/23).

-Went 2-1, 4.88 ERA (13 ER/24.0 IP) with 27 SO/15 BB and a .258 opp. BA over first 8 G/5 GS before forgoing his 4-seam fastball for a sinker, and was 3-2, 4.30 ERA (18 ER/37.2 IP) with 57 SO/18 BB and a .213 opp. BA in 10 G/9 GS after making the change (beg. 7/16).

-10.13 K/9 with 4s fastball, 13.62 K/9 after change to 2s fastball.

-Named the Arizona Fall League Reliever of the Year after going 1-0 with five saves across eight scoreless outings (11.0 innings) with 48.7 % strikeout rate (19 of 39 batters).

2022 SEASON

-Transitioned to a starting role after appearing exclusively as a reliever in 2021

-Spent entire campaign at Down East (A), recorded team-high 115 strikeouts, 7th-most in Carolina League, and his 12.27 SO/9 figure ranked 2nd among Texas farmhands (min. 50.0 IP) to Larson Kindreich (12.66)

-Went 1-0, 1.53 ERA (3 ER/17.2 IP) and 35 SO over 4 starts in August, earning the Texas organization's Minor League Starting Pitcher of the Month award.
