**YESTERDAY:** Vinny Capra had three more hits and scored the only run in New Hampshire's 7-1 loss to Portland. Cameron Cannon singled home two runs in the top of the third inning and Tristo Casas added a two-run homer off starter Luis Quinones (L, 2-4). Kole Cottam homered in the fifth, and Casas added a second longball in the ninth to make it 7-0. New Hampshire was handcuffed by Jay Groome, making his first start at Double-A a winning one. He allowed two hits, did not walk a batter, striking out ten. The Fisher Cats loaded the bases in the ninth on a single by Capra, a single by LJ Talley and a Kevin Vicuna HBP. Demi Orimoloye singled for the run, extending his season-best hit streak to eight games.

**2022 SCHEDULE RELEASE:** The Fisher Cats have released a 2022 schedule, featuring home matchups on Father's Day, Fourth of July, and Labor Day Weekend. New Hampshire opens up the year on the road at Portland before their home opener on April 12<sup>th</sup> against Hartford. New Hampshire will also host Richmond, Erie, and Altoona for inter-divisional play.

**BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY:** September 5, 2018—The Fisher Cats opened the playoffs with an 8-0 win over Trenton. TJ Zeuch worked the first six innings, and Kirby Snead, Dusty Isaacs, and Travis Bergen finished up. Offensively, the Fisher Cats scored three in the sixth and five runs in the eighth. Bo Bichette plated the first run with a double, Cavan Biggio drove in the next two with a double to make it 3-0. Jon Berti knocked in two with a single in the big eighth inning.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays won 10-8 over Oakland, surviving a five-run ninth-inning from the Athletics. Lourdes Gurriel Jr. went 3-5 with a homer, a double, and four RBI...First-place Buffalo swept a doubleheader from Scranton-Wilkes-Barre. Otto Lopez homered, his first at Triple-A and Nash Knight added a three-run shot in the 8-4 opener. Thomas Hatch picked up the win. The Bisons won the second game 6-2...Everett won 10-9 over Vancouver in 11 innings, Dunedin blanked Palm Beach 8-0.

**PLAYOFF PICTURE DOUBLE-A NORTHEAST:** (Two best overall records meet for the title): Akron is 67-39, best overall record in the league. Rubber Ducks have won first five vs. Altoona. Somerset is 62-44 and Bowie 61-44 after the Patriots 4-1 win last night. At 60-45, Portland is 1.5 back of the Baysox.

**TO STARTER:** RHP Jeremy Beasley will open for the Fisher Cats in one of the games (box on relievers page). Made his second Fisher Cats appearance on Tuesday, working the fourth inning of the resumption of the suspended game from July 4. He did not allow a run. Also served as the opener August 11 in Harrisburg. 25-year old appearaed in eight games for the Blue Jays this season and also made 17 appearances for Triple-A Buffalo.

RHP Maximo Castillo is the only pitcher in the Minor Leagues with 11 wins- seeks his 12<sup>th</sup> this afternoon as he faces Portland for the second time in the series. Won Tuesday night, allowing three runs in six innings. He allowed five hits, walked one and struck out eight. Castillo has won each of his last four starts against the Sea Dogs.

Portland will start AJ Politi in one of the games. Makes his 16<sup>th</sup> start. Worked last Sunday against Reading, lifted in the second after allowing five runs on five hits. Politi worked six scoreless in a 1-0 win over the Fisher Cats on July 31 in the second game of a doubleheader at Hadlock Field. He won four games in July. The Red Sox took the 25-year old in the 15<sup>th</sup> round of the 2018 draft (Seton Hall).
