Over Early: The Springfield Cardinals (44-24, 87-50) scored six runs in the first two innings against starter Eric Yost, letting them coast to a 7-4 win over the San Antonio Missions (26-41, 65-71). Liam Doyle, the 2025 first-round pick by the St. Louis Cardinals, made his Double-A debut for the Cardinals and threw two scoreless innings. He turned it over to the bullpen from there, and four Springfield relievers held the Missions to a single run until the ninth.

That's All, Folks: Today marks the final game of the 2025 regular season for the San Antonio Missions. One game against Frisco was canceled, so this is game No. 137. The 2026 season begins on Thursday, April 2 in Tulsa when the Missions visit the Drillers, and the home slate begins on Tuesday, April 7 as the Corpus Christi Hooks come to town.

What Could Have Been: The Missions finished a stellar first half 39-30 tied with the Midland RockHounds for first place in the Texas League South, but Midland holding the tiebreaker gave them the automatic playoff bid. All the Missions needed to do was win their game on June 22 at home against Frisco, but they fell 8-1 and handed Midland the division.

A Surreal Day: On July 31, the Missions were 13-17 and six games back of first place in the Texas League South. On that same day, the San Diego Padres made a major splash and ended up trading four San Antonio Missions to acquire major league talent. Henry Baez, the reigning Padres' Minor League Pitcher of the Year who led the Texas League in ERA, and No. 3 Padres' prospect Braden Nett went to Oakland for Mason Miller and JP Sears, Brandon Valenzuela, who led the Missions in home runs and RBIs, went to the Toronto Blue Jays for Will Wagner, and Tyson Neighbors, drafted just last year out of Kansas State, went to the Baltimore Orioles for Ramon Laureano and Ryan O'Hearn. Since that day, the Missions went 13-24 and fell out of the Texas League South race.

Happy Memories: The 2025 season was filled with memorable moments, from 10 walk-off wins and two walk-off home runs, to relievers David Morgan and Bradgley Rodriguez both getting called up directly from San Antonio to San Diego. Eduarniel Núñez also made it to San Diego after a quick pit stop at Triple-A El Paso.

The Formula: Scoring first was the way to go for San Antonio, as they are 37-18 when getting on the board first. The problem became that the Missions have been outscored 64-44 in the first inning, and 44 runs are the second fewest in any inning behind only the 9th, when they don't always hit. They also are 50-22 when scoring at least four runs.

A Tale of Two Teams: The differences between home and road performances ultimately defined the Missions. At home, the Missions hit just .207 and scored 213 runs (3.08/game). On the road, the Missions hit .252 and scored 314 runs (4.68/game). In the second half especially, the Missions were just 9-21 at home compared to 17-20 on the road.

Finish Where We Started: 22-year-old Jagger Haynes, San Antonio's Opening Day starter, takes the mound today on the final day of the season as well. The lefty is 3-4 with a 4.27 ERA in 25 games (24 starts) across 99 innings with 60 walks and 98 strikeouts. Haynes left the game in the third inning on August 1 in Frisco with an apparent injury and went two weeks before starting again on August 15, so he didn't face Springfield until this Tuesday. Haynes threw three innings and allowed three runs on four hits with four walks and a strikeout as he lost. San Antonio is where Jagger Haynes fared best this season. In 12 starts at Wolff Stadium, the southpaw boasted a 1-2 record with a 2.81 ERA with just four homers allowed. In contrast, Haynes's 12 road appearances see a record of 2-2 with a 5.85 ERA, and he has allowed eight homers on the road. Haynes has nine pickoffs after 13 a year ago. The Whiteville, North Carolina native spent all of 2024 with High-A Fort Wayne. Haynes went 2-6 with a 4.64 ERA in 22 starts across 110.2 IP with the TinCaps. The San Diego Padres drafted Haynes in the 5th round of the 2020 draft out of high school when he was just 17-years old with a \$300,000 signing bonus, but he dealt with injuries immediately after including undergoing Tommy John Surgery. He is ranked as the 10th best prospect in the Padres organization according to MLB Pipeline.

Him Again: 23-year-old Chen-Wei Lin, who can touch 100mph, starts for Springfield today. He is 0-2 with a 6.02 ERA in 16 starts across Single-A Palm Beach, High-A Peoria and Double-A Springfield. With the Cardinals, he has allowed 10 runs in 5.2 innings across 3 starts with seven walks and 11 strikeouts. He faced the Missions on Tuesday, going three innings with three hits, one run, one walk and six strikeouts. Last year with Palm Beach, Lin was 10-5 with a 2.79 ERA in 22 starts across 116 innings with 36 walks and 123 strikeouts. MLB Pipeline ranks Lin as the No. 16 prospect in the St. Louis Cardinals' system. The Cardinals signed Lin in 2023 after he played in the 2022 Northwoods League and 2023 MLB Draft League, but he is from Tanei, Tawian and he became the Cardinals' first signee from Taiwan.
