LAST GAME

The Baysox won their second-consecutive game against the Erie SeaWolves on Wednesday night by an 8-7 final. Bowie started fast, scoring six in the top of the first inning and chasing Erie starter Keider Montero after just two-thirds of an inning. John Rhodes, Shayne Fontana, and Billy Cook all had RBI doubles in the frame, while Cesar Prieto and Tim Susnara each produced run-scoring singles. The Baysox would add on another in the second, as Fontana ripped an RBI single to go along with his two-run double, giving him 3 RBI on the night and stretching Bowie's lead to 7-0. John Rhodes would also tack on his second RBI of the game on a base hit in the fourth. The SeaWolves would inch their way back into the contest, as Erie blasted four home runs on the evening - two-run shots from Ben Malgeri and Trei Cruz, along with solo homers from Andrew Navigato and Jake Holton. Right-handed Carlos Tavera surrendered the Malgeri long ball and allowed a run to score on a wild pitch, as control issues limited him to just four innings. Houston Roth allowed three of Erie's four home runs for a team-high 12 on the season, but was able to go three frames before handing the ball to right-hander Ofreidy Gomez, who kept the SeaWolves off the board in the final two frames for his first save as a member of the Baysox.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Erie SeaWolves enter tonight with a record of 29-24 - tied with the Altoona Curve atop the Eastern League Southwest division. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, Erie is 21-11 since entering their first series with the Baysox back in the beginning of May, where they took four of six in Bowie. Erie has not lost a series in that span, and outscored opponents 221-134, after entering the series with Bowie last month holding the worst run differential in the league at -51. No. 2 Tigers/No. 84 overall prospect (via MLB Pipeline) Colt Keith leads a SeaWolves offense that collectively paces the league in OPS (.774) and slugging (.421). Keith ranks second in the league in average (.323) and hits (64), while sitting third in OPS (.964) and extra-base hits (26) and was named the Eastern League's Player of the Month for May on Monday. Keith joins RHPs Wilmer Flores (No. 4 DET), Ty Madden (No. 5 DET), and Dylan Smith (No. 15 DET), alongside LHP Brant Hurter (No. 21 DET), as well as INF Wenceel Perez (No. 8 DET) and Gage Workman (No. 28 DET) as other notable prospects on the Erie roster.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Ty Madden is set to get the ball tonight for Erie. Madden is another arm active in the strike zone for the SeaWolves, as he's allowed 42 hits in 40.2 innings, but has also struck out 49 to accompany just 16 walks. The No. 5 prospect in the Tigers' system, per MLB Pipeline, Madden is coming off an outing where he allowed a season-high in hits (9) and matched a career-high in earned runs (5) through six innings against Richmond this past Friday. Madden faced the Baysox back on 5/4, where he took a no-decision, allowing three runs in five innings, despite allowing a previous season-high seven hits, including a pair of home runs. He also faced Bowie on 9/2 last season, allowing a run on three hits through six frames, with a career-high 10 strikeouts. The 32nd overall pick of Detroit in the 2021 draft out of The University of Texas, Madden's arsenal includes a mid-90s fastball, a mid-80s slider, and a changeup.

DOUBLE THE MAYO!

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo leads the Double-A level with 19 doubles and is second with 27 extra-base hits. The No. 8 Orioles/No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, has doubled in seven of his last 10 games, to go along with six walks in his last five contests. Mayo leads the Baysox with 25 RBI, 31 walks, and a .911 OPS. He is in the midst of a 22-game on-base streak - third-longest by a member of the Baysox this season (John Rhodes - 24 [Active], Heston Kjerstad - 29).

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 70 hits and a .363 average. Back-to-back three-hit games this week gives Prieto eight contests on the season with at least three knocks, and 20 multi-hit affairs on the season. Prieto has now hit safely in 42 of 48 games he's played, and is batting .469 (15-for-32) against the SeaWolves in 2023 with four doubles, a home run, and five multi-hit performances. The No. 16 Orioles' prospect also leads the Baysox and is fourth in the Eastern League with a .411 on-base percentage.

LEADING THE WAY, AWAY FROM HOME

The Baysox sport a 3.22 staff ERA in road contests this season - the best mark at the Double-A level. Despite an overall road record of 10-12 on the season, which has been due in part to poor run support, Bowie has bucked that trend as of late. The Baysox have won six of their last eight games away from home, with the offense averaging 5.5 runs per game in that stretch, including four performances of seven runs or more. In the 11 road games prior, the Baysox averaged just 3.09 runs per game and went 2-9 in those contests.

CAREER NOTES

- 4th most strikeouts (126), 3rd most innings (117.0), and 2nd most starts (22) across the Orioles' system in 2022.
- Named an Orioles Organization All-Star in 2022 after successful stints in High-A Aberdeen and Bowie. Pitched to a 3.69 ERA in 14 appearances/10 starts across 63.1 innings for the Baysox, including a 2.08 ERA in August with a .137 BAA.
- Named Mountain West Pitcher of the Year in 2021.
- Nearly quit baseball before when only team offering him a roster spot out of high school was Division III Pacific Lutheran, "I honestly almost gave up baseball at the end of my high school career, I didn't really know if I loved it, but then I got that one opportunity ... and kind of found this new passion toward baseball."

NOTES BY OUTING

- Baysox Opening Day starter. Allowed two singles in the first inning, and was saved from allowing a run with an outfield assist. Allowed one base hit in every inning besides the third, but never worked with multiple runners on base.
- Allowed first run of the season in the fourth inning after a double and a single. Walked the first two batters of the fifth inning and was lifted.
- Allowed runners into scoring position in three different innings, but none reached third base. Mixed six flyouts and four groundouts.
- Third pitch thrown was hit for a solo home run. Walked and hit a batter later in the frame, but did not see another runner in scoring position. Left game tied at one, bullpen allowed six runs.
- Allowed three consecutive batters to reach in the first inning, and again in the second. An error and a walk lead to another run in the fifth inning.
- Allowed a solo home run to the third batter of the game. Only other runner to reach scoring position was a stolen base with two outs in the fifth.
- Second pitch thrown went for a double, but faced the minimum over the next 17 batters. With two outs in the sixth, a double, error, and three-run home run cost him the shutout performance
- Gave up a leadoff single, but stranded two runners in the first, followed by two perfect innings. Allowed a solo home run in the fourth, and had a runner thrown out at home in the fifth.
- Only allowed five baserunners, and only allowed two in an inning once.
- Allowed a run three batters into the game on a single and double. Allowed a leadoff single in the second inning that scored on a wild pitch, but only other baserunner across five innings was an error.

Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.	Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Herrmann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Herrmann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria.
