Behind a stellar offensive night, the Frisco RoughRiders took down the Northwest Arkansas Naturals 10-2 on Thursday night from Arvest Ballpark. The RoughRiders (27-32) struck first for the eighth time in the last nine games, this time in the second inning. Scott Kapers and Luisangel Acuña bashed RBI singles before Thomas Saggese lifted a sacrifice fly to center to make it 3-0. After the Naturals (22-38) answered with a Jorge Bonifacio solo home run in the bottom of the inning, the Riders volleyed back with two more runs on RBI singles from Kellen Strahm and Nick Tanielu to grab a 5-1 lead. Bonifacio struck again with another solo shot in the fourth and the 5-2 game held until the eighth inning. Acuña then blasted a three-run shot in the eighth inning, his fourth long ball of the season and first since May 11th. Frisco scored two more in the ninth on a duo of RBI groundouts from Jax Biggers and Acuña, who tied his career high with five RBIs on the night. Seth Nordlin started for the Riders, allowing just two runs over four innings. Hever Bueno, Alex Speas (2-0), John Matthews, Nick Starr and Juan Mejia then followed in shutout work from the bullpen. Jonathan Bowlan (1-5) allowed five runs in relief to take the loss for the Naturals. Tanielu headed the RoughRiders offensively with four hits while Acuña, Strahm and Kapers all also had two-hit games.

## IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME

Outfielder Kellen Strahm has been hot lately, hitting safely in six-straight games while batting . 440 (11-for-25)/.500/.600/1.100 with one double, one home run, four RBIs, five runs, three walks and a steal. Over the last six games, he has raised his average from . 200 to .232 and his OPS from . 612 to .674 .

OWEN THEM NOTHING, GIVING THEM EVERYTHING:
Pitcher Owen White was named Texas League Pitcher of the Week for the week of June 5-11. White took the hill for the RoughRiders on June 7 in Corpus Christi and tossed seven shutout innings to earn the win. White gave up just one hit to the 23 batters he faced, walking two and striking out six. Frisco won the game, $9-0$. White now has three starts in which he has not allowed a run, earned or unearned. In seven of his 11 starts, he has allowed two runs or fewer. His ERA this season is 3.54 over 53.1 innings. Last year, White won the award in just his second start at the Double-A level. The former second-round selection in 2018 has a 3.24 ERA over 75 innings in Double-A. White made his MLB debut on Tuesday, allowing three runs over two innings with two strikeouts.

## THOMAS IS BACK IN NWA:

Thomas Saggese returns to Northwest Arkansas for the first time since his first week in Double-A in 2022, in which he won Texas League Player of the Week by batting .381 ( 8 -for-21)/.409/.857/1.266 with three doubles, two triples, a home run, nine RBIs, five runs scored with a steal and a walk. In the first three games of the series this year, he is hitting .429 ( 6 -for-14)/.471/.714/1.185 with a double, a home run, two runs, three RBls, two walks.

## THE SPEAS THAT PLEASES:

Reliever Alex Speas now has an ERA under 1.00 at 0.79 over 20 appearances. In 23.2 innings, he has struck out 39 to 11 walks. Opponents are hitting just .134 against him and he has not allowed an earned run over his last 11 outings. During that span, he has struck out 24 to four walks over 13.1 innings. On the season, righties are just hitting .117 (7-for-60) against him on the season with a .377 OPS.

POWER SURGE:
After only hitting two home runs over a two-week span, the RoughRiders have hit 11 long balls over their last nine games. In the nine games, Frisco is hitting $.264 / .364 / .441 / .805$ with 21 doubles, 11 home runs and averaging 6.7 runs per game. Luisangel Acuña has led the way, hitting .344 (13-for38)/.390/.579/.969 in the span while Thomas Saggese hit four home runs.

## AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, tied for first in the Texas League with a .600 average (12-for-20) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.619 OPS on the first pitch after homering on the first pitch on Saturday, which is second in the league. Luisangel Acuña has also been great, hitting . 475 (19-for-40) on the initial offering while his 19 hits on the first pitch lead the league.

## DUSTIN' THEM AND LEAVING THEM BEHIND:

Dustin Harris has been running wild for the RoughRiders this season. After stealing 19 bases in 85 games in 2022, Harris has already swiped 24 bags in 57 games this season. Harris is on pace for 56 steals, which would by far be a career high. Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 28 and is on pace for a career-best 65 swipes. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League steals with 91 bases in 105 attempts ( 87 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:
The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with Thomas Saggese hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese (2)). Frisco also has a 1.101 OPS with the bags full, which is fourth in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.321 and Triple-A Saint Paul, 1.181, Double-A Somerset, 1.118).

## ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .303 (67-for-221)/.370/.443/.813 through the first 51 games. Over his last 47 games, he is batting .315/.386/.468/.854. Acuña is riding a nine-game hitting streak, batting .349 (15-for-43). When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (117)

WALK THIS WAY:
On the season, Frisco's 297 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .354 team OBP is third in the Texas League. Dustin Harris is first in the league with 42 walks.

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.
-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.
-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games ( 13 starts), Garcia went $10-1$ with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a . 160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went $20-2$ with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.
-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.
-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings
-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

## 2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April llth at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on $5 / 10$ during a day game.
Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

## 2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.
-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

Averaged $11.8 \mathrm{~K} / 9$ over his 14 games ( 13 starts).

## 2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.
