Today's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Memphis Redbirds play the finale of a six-game series today. The Sounds got three doubles from David Dahl, but still fell 4-3 in last night's game to the Redbirds. Left-hander Andy Otero starts for Nashville against left-hander Connor Thomas for Memphis.

Andy Otero: 29-year-old Andy Otero starts for the Sounds in the series finale today. The left-hander is 0-2 with a 8.47 ERA in six games (four starts) with Nashville in 2021. The southpaw has also made 13 appearances (5 starts) with Double-A Biloxi and is 3-0 with a 1.98 ERA with the Shuckers. Otero last pitched on August 10 in a start at Louisville and was tagged with the loss. He allowed a career-high 8 runs (6 earned) on 7 hits and 2 walks in 2.2 innings. Otero was signed by Milwaukee to a minor league contract on May 7.

Connor Thomas: 23-year-old Connor Thomas starts for the Redbirds today. The left-hander is 5-2 with a 3.39 ERA in 15 games (eight starts) with Memphis in 2021. He has also pitched in four games (all starts) with Double-A Springfield this year and is 0-2 with a 4.87 ERA. With Memphis, Thomas has covered 66.1 innings and has allowed 65 hits and 17 walks to go along with 58 strikeouts. He last pitched on August 15 in a start at Norfolk where he was tagged with a loss after he allowed 3 runs on 5 hits in 6.0 innings. The Cardinals selected the Georgia native in the 5th round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft.

Back to Losing Ways: After snapping a seven-game losing streak Friday, the Sounds were back to losing ways last night. Nashville has lost 10 of their last 14 games and 13 of their last 16 away from First Horizon Park.

Doubles for Dahl: David Dahl became the first Sound this season to hit three doubles in a game last night and the first since Ramón Laureano on June 13, 2018 at El Paso.

Peterson Rolling: Outfielder Dustin Peterson had one of the biggest games of his career Thursday night with a 4-hit, 4-RBI performance. Both are season-highs for Peterson and just one shy each of matching his career-best. The outfielder is batting .339 (20-for-59) with 9 runs, 5 doubles, 1 home run and 13 RBI in the month of August.

Seven-Game Skid Snapped: The Sounds snapped a season-high seven-game losing streak Friday night with their 5-3 win. The last time a Sounds team lost seven straight games was when the 2015 team went on a seven-game skid from July 22-28. They dropped the final two games in Colorado Springs before getting swept at home by New Orleans in four games. They dropped the first game at home to Iowa on July 28 before a 6-4 win against the I-Cubs on July 29 snapped the losing streak. The longest losing streak in franchise history is 12 games in 1987.

Hiura is Back in Action: Infielder Keston Hiura was reinstated from the 10-day injured list (covid) on Tuesday and has re-joined the Sounds. Hiura has played in 23 games with Nashville this year and is hitting .376 (32-for-85) with 17 runs, 8 doubles, 5 home runs, 15 RBI and 16 walks. He has reached base safely in 23 of his 24 games with Nashville.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,081-1,969. The 2,081 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this date in 2016, the Sounds routed Omaha 12-3. Starter Dillon Overton earned his 12th win of the season, going 6.0 innings and allowing one run. Joey Wendle had four hits and was a home run shy of the cycle. Josh Rodriguez also had three hits.
