Penultimate Home Series

The Fightin Phils return home for their second-to-last home series of the season against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It's the 12th-of-17 matchups between the teams this season, and first-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium. Reading leads the season-series 6-5.

Quiet Sunday

The Fightin Phils dropped the finale, and ultimately the series, to the Akron RubberDucks with a 2-1 loss on Sunday. Eiberson Castellano was sharp over five innings of work, allowing no runs and one hit, with five strikeouts. Reading's lone run came in the seventh when Gabriel Rincones Jr. reached and scored on a wild pitch. Akron got one run in the eighth as Carlos Francisco blew the save by allowing a game-tying home run. Then, the RubberDucks won it in the ninth when Andrew Schultz allowed a game-winning single to suffer the loss.

Crawford's Cruising

Phillies No. 3 Prospect Justin Crawford turned in perhaps his best game at the Double-A level on Saturday night. Crawford had three hits, two runs, a grand slam and five RBI. His five RBI tied a career-high, with the last time being Aug. 5, 2023, with Clearwater against Lakeland. Crawford's grand slam was the third of Crawford's professional career, with his other two coming on Aug. 5, 2023, with Clearwater against Lakeland; and May 30, 2024, with Jersey Shore against Brooklyn. Crawford now has 10 professional home runs, and three of them have been grand slams. His grand slam was Reading's second of the season and first since Robert Moore on June 1, 2024, at Hartford.

Rincones Rolling

Gabriel Rincones Jr. turned in one of his best days as a professional on Saturday. Between both games of the doubleheader, Rincones Jr. went five-for-eight, with four runs, two doubles, two home runs and four RBI. Rincones had homered in three-straight games (8/9-10), making him the first R-Phil to homer in three-consecutive contests since Oliver Dunn did it from Aug. 15-17, of 2023. Rincones also went deep in both games of Saturday's doubleheader, marking the first time a Fightin Phil has hit a homer in both ends of a twin bill since Jorge Bonifacio did it on May 27, 2021, against Richmond. Last week, Rincones slashed .375/.423/.875, with a 1.298 OPS. He added seven runs, three doubles, three home runs and eight RBI.

On the Way Up

The Philadelphia Phillies announced multiple promotions prior to Tuesday night's game. Pitchers Robinson Pina and Seth Johnson were both promoted to Triple-A Lehigh Valley. Pina was stellar for the Fightin Phils, winning 12 games and ranking amongst the Eastern League leaders in multiple categories. His 12 wins were the most by an R-Phil since Austin Hyatt in 2011. Johnson made just two starts with Reading after being acquired from Baltimore in the Gregory Soto trade, but he did spend the other part of the season with Double-A Bowie. Coming to Reading from High-A Jersey Shore are pitchers Braedan Fausnaught and Moises Chace, along with infielder Zach Arnold. Fausnaught played his college baseball at West Chester and Chace was also in the Soto deal with Johnson. Arnold played his college baseball at Houston and LSU and spent the entire season with High-A Jersey Shore.

Welcome to the Show

Max Lazar, who did not allow a run over eight appearances with Reading this season, pitched two-scoreless outings with the Phillies this past weekend in Arizona. Lazar became the fourth former Fightin Phil to make his Major League debut in 2024. He joins Erik Miller (2022), Oliver Dunn (2023) and Tyler Phillips (2021, '23) as other former R-Phils to make the big leagues this season. Lazar is the sixth player who played under Al Pedrique in Reading (2023-24) to go on to play in the big leagues, joining Johan Rojas, Orion Kerkering, Drew Ellis, Oliver Dunn and Tyler Phillips.

This Day in Baseballtown History

August 13, 2023: At New Hampshire, Reading Manager Al Pedrique earns his 1,000th career win with an 8-3 victory over the Fisher Cats. Pedrique is in his first season with the Fightin Phils and the win total includes his time as both a Minor League and Major League Manager.

The Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight after finishing in last place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 30-38 record. They are last in the Northeast Division with a 13-23 record in the second half of the season. New Hampshire most recently took two-of-five at home against Erie. Following this week, New Hampshire hosts Hartford. New Hampshire's roster features 10 players ranked amongst the Toronto Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Adam Macko (10), Charles McAdoo (13), Cade Doughty (15), CJ Van Eyk (18), Eddinson Paulino (20), Dahian Santos (23), Yohendrick Pinango (26), Dasan Brown (27), RJ Schreck (29) and Josh Rivera (29).

Cat on the Bump

Righty Devereaux Harrison makes the start tonight for New Hampshire. This season, Harrison is 4-6, with a 4.97 ERA over 20 starts. He last pitched Aug. 6 against Erie, going six innings, allowing five runs on eight hits, with three strikeouts, in a no-decision. Harrison faced Reading this season twice, allowing three runs over five innings in a win on June 18, and allowing four runs over six innings in a no-decision on July 25. Harrison spent all of 2023 with High-A Vancouver, going 5-5, with a 2.95 ERA over 26 appearances and 16 starts. The 23-year old was drafted by Toronto in the ninth round in 2022 out of Long Beach State.
