JACOB DEGROM FANS THREE IN REHAB START AS RIDERS DOWN MISSIONS, 5-4:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the San Antonio Missions 10-4 on Friday evening from Riders Field. Frisco (27-22, 71-47) erupted for three runs in the bottom of the first inning against San Antonio (22-26, 53-63) starter Sam Whiting. **Alejandro Osuna** opened the frame with a triple and later scored on an RBI single by **Cody Freeman**. **Aaron Zavala** delivered a two-run double to give Frisco a 3-0 advantage. **Nick Krauth** (8-5) had his best stuff, sitting down the first eight batters he faced before allowing a harmless two-out single in the third. Leading 3-0 in the bottom of the fourth, **Alex De Goti** led off the inning with a triple and came around to score on an RBI single by Osuna. **Keyber Rodriguez** extended the Frisco lead to 5-0 with a sacrifice fly that plated **Tucker Mitchell**. Krauth exited with the bases loaded in the sixth inning, giving way to **Jackson Kelly**. Kelly secured the second out of the inning on a sacrifice fly by Romeo Sanabria that cut the Frisco lead to 5-1 and later ended the Missions threat with a strikeout. After throwing just 40 pitches through the first four innings, Krauth finished after 5.1 innings of one-run baseball where he surrendered just two hits and two walks while fanning five. Frisco responded with a five-run bottom of the sixth inning, sending 11 batters to the plate. **Abimelec Ortiz** opened the scoring with a two-run single before RBI doubles by Josh Hatcher and Zavala pushed the RoughRiders lead to 10-1. In the top of the seventh, Joshua Mears homered against **Andy Rodriguez**. The righty allowed a pair of runs in the eighth inning on an RBI double by Ripken Reyes and an RBI single by Sanabria, cutting the Frisco lead to 10-4. **Larson Kindreich** walked the first batter he faced in the ninth, but went on to strike out the side and seal the win for the Riders. Offensively, the RoughRiders managed 11 hits with five going for extra bases. Osuna led the way with a 3-for-4 evening as Zavala drove in four runs to pace the lineup. Zavala and De Goti both notched two hits in the win.

REHAB CITY:

After **Jacob deGrom** made his first rehab start for the RoughRiders on Thursday, that put Frisco at eight rehabbers this season. The hitters include **Josh Jung** and **Nathaniel Lowe** while **Cody Bradford**, **Dane Dunning**, **Josh Sborz**, **Jacob Latz** and **Tyler Mahle** make up the pitchers. In 2018, the RoughRiders had 12 rehabbers, the most in franchise history. This season marks the highest volume of rehabbers since 2018.

PLEASE DON'T HIT ME ONE MORE TIME:

The Riders pitching staff has been a strength this season, but they have struggled over their last 10 games. During that stretch, Springfield and San Antonio have hit .309 (114-for-369) with 23 doubles, six home runs and averaging 6.9 runs per game on the offensive side, taking six of 10 games. Frisco's bullpen had a 7.42 ERA (36ER/43.2 IP) and has allowed 63 hits over 43.2 innings while blowing leads in four of their six losses. The Riders have lost back-to-back series for the first time all season now and are 6-10 in their last 16 games.

HOMER HAPPY:

Last Friday, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with **Luis Mieses** capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders have hit 11 home runs in the last seven games, with those 11 home runs being second in the Texas League this week (Amarillo, 13). Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 87 across their 118 games (on pace for 103, which would be for the fifth-fewest in the 21 seasons of the franchise).

RISP-ECT THIS PLEASE:

Over the last 28 games, the Riders are fourth in the Texas League with a .747 OPS, second with a .264 batting average and are sixth with 4.6 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .212 (55-for-260) with runners in scoring position over their last 28 games.

READY TO ROCK(ER):

RoughRiders starting pitcher **Kumar Rocker** has been fantastic in his five starts with the RoughRiders since returning from his "Tommy John" surgery rehab this season. In the four starts, he has pitched 19.2 innings, allowing just one run on nine hits and three walks with 29 strikeouts. Additionally, he has been incredibly efficient, averaging just 13.0 pitches per inning with the Riders. Rocker, who was selected by the Rangers as the No. 3 overall pick in the 2022 draft, is the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers organization and the No. 1 pitching prospect.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 39-21 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco has a +72 run differential, a 4.06 ERA and is averaging 5.7 runs per game with a .768 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 32-26 with a 3.22 ERA, but a +21 run differential while averaging 3.9 runs per game and owning a .638 OPS (10th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has 10 of his 14 home runs at home while **Abimelec Ortiz** has hit nine of his 10 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .304/.400/.516/.916 at home as opposed to .138/.202/.204/.406 on the road.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

ABOUT EMILIANO

-Signed in 2020 for \$10,000 at age 18 (which is much older than the normal 16-year-old international signing age for most Dominican players).

-Routinely touches triple digits with his fastball.

-Comps to Jordano Ventura because of small frame and electric stuff. Changeup has splitter-like action to it.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation and as the No. 16 prospect in the Rangers organization according to MLB.com.

-After allowing four runs over 2.2 innings in first start, has gone 2-0 with 1.20 ERA over last six starts (4ER/30.0IP).

-He allowed two doubles in his first start and did not allow any extra-base hits after until 5/26, when he surrendered a solo home run.

-Tied career-high with 11 strikeouts on 6/16 vs. AMA.

-Participated in the 2024 Futures Game. As the starter for the American League at Globe Life Field, he became the first pitcher in Futures Game history to throw two perfect innings, retiring all six batters he faced on 14 pitches (6 in the first inning, 8 in the second) with one strikeout.

2023 SEASON

-Finished 4th among Rangers farm hands in 2023 with a 12.26 K/9 (7th-best in the South Atlantic League).

-Missed the first month and more with minor right forearm tightness (activated 5/23).

-Went 2-1, 4.88 ERA (13 ER/24.0 IP) with 27 SO/15 BB and a .258 opp. BA over first 8 G/6 GS before forgoing his 4-seam fastball for a sinker, and was 3-2, 4.30 ERA (18 ER/37.2 IP) with 57 SO/18 BB and a .213 opp. BA in 10 G/9 GS after making the change (beg. 7/16).

-10.13 K/9 with 4s fastball, 13.62 K/9 after change to 2s fastball.

-Named the Arizona Fall League Reliever of the Year after going 1-0 with five saves across eight scoreless outings (11.0 innings) with 48.7 % strikeout rate (19 of 39 batters).

2022 SEASON

-Transitioned to a starting role after appearing exclusively as a reliever in 2021

-Spent entire campaign at Down East (A), recorded team-high 115 strikeouts, 7th-most in Carolina League, and his 12.27 SO/9 figure ranked 2nd among Texas farmhands (min. 50.0 IP) to Larson Kindreich (12.66)

-Went 1-0, 1.53 ERA (3 ER/17.2 IP) and 35 SO over 4 starts in August, earning the Texas organization's Minor League Starting Pitcher of the Month award.

2021 SEASON

-Struck out 48 of 133 (36.1%) batters faced and held opponents to a .214 BA (24-112)

-Participated in the Rangers' Fall Instructional League and Texas Tour games against local universities in October
