LAST TIME OUT...

TRENTON, N.J. (June 8, 2021) – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders erased an early 5-0 deficit to defeat the Buffalo Bisons 7-5 in a wild contest on Tuesday night at Trenton Thunder Ballpark.

After a one-hour, 45-minute weather delay to start the game, Zack Britton got the start in an MLB rehab assignment. The left-hander was tagged for four runs in 0.1 innings of work. He allowed a two-run double to Tyler White and a two-run home run to Jared Hoying to stake Buffalo to an early 4-0 lead.

Adam Warren allowed one run in 2.2 innings of relief in back of Britton, but the Bisons maintained a 5-0 advantage after the third. In the top of the fourth the RailRiders struck for three runs against Anthony Kay. Derek Dietrich drove home Hoy Park with an RBI single, and three batters later, Andrew Velazquez provided a two-run single to narrow the gap to 5-3.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre edged closer in the top of the sixth when Robinson Chirinos blasted a solo home run against Kay to cut the Buffalo lead to 5-4. Nick Nelson provided 3.0 innings of scoreless relief, while Braden Bristo added a scoreless seventh to keep the Bisons off the board.

Their work paid off in the top of the eighth when the RailRiders rallied for two runs against Tayler Saucedo. With the bases loaded and one out, Dietrich blooped a two-run single to centerfield to give the Baby Bombers a 6-5 lead. SWB added an insurance run in the ninth when Velazquez walked and later scored on a Mike Ford sacrifice fly.

Luis Garcia earned his Triple-A East-leading ninth save of the season by recording the final four outs of the game. In total the RailRiders bullpen allowed only one run in 8.2 innings of work.

NEWS & NOTES

TREY DAY: RailRiders outfielder **Trey Amburgey** has been among the best hitters in all of minor league baseball this season, and entering play Tuesday night, has at least one hit in all 14 games he has played. That stands as the longest active hitting streak in Triple-A East, and is the second-longest in the league this season (**Yariel Gonzalez**, TOL, 16 G). Dating back to the end of the 2019 season, Amburgey has hit in 17 consecutive games and has at least one hit in 21 of his last 22 contests, and has reached base safely in all of those games. He is hitting .395/.477/.737 (30-for-76) in that span. The SWB franchise record for longest hitting streak belongs to **Pablo Ozuna**, who hit in 27 straight games in 2004 for the Red Barons, while the longest on-base streak is **Brandon Drury's** 32-game streak in the 2018 season.

THIS ROAD TRIP FEELS...FAMILIAR: With the Buffalo Bisons having to play their entire home schedule this season at Trenton Thunder Ballpark, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders will play this series in a familiar setting for many players. From 2003 through 2020, the Trenton Thunder were the Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. Sixteen members of the RailRiders roster suited up for the Thunder under its Yankees affiliation. Adding an extra layer of complexity to the arrangement, Buffalo wears Trenton Thunder jerseys while playing at home, including the alternate "Trenton Pork Roll" identity on Fridays. The new Trenton Thunder Draft League team is playing its home games this season not at Trenton Thunder Ballpark, but at nearby Rider University in Lawrenceville, N.J.

WELCOME BACK: Since the RailRiders played on Sunday afternoon, the roster has taken a new look, with five players being added on Tuesday afternoon by the Yankees. **Zack Britton** and **Ryan LaMarre** were both added to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's roster on MLB rehab assignments, with Britton being transferred from Double-A Somerset and LaMarre beginning his. Also, **Trevor Lane**, **Robinson Chirinos** and **Kellin Deglan** were all activated from the Temporally Inactive List after playing in the WBSC Baseball Americas Olympics Qualifying event. Lane represented the United States, while Chirinos played for Team Venezuela and Deglan for Team Canada. Team USA won the event and became the fifth team to qualify for the 2020 Tokyo Olympics (with Japan, Korea, Mexico and Israel).

FAST OUT OF THE GATE: With 20 wins in 29 games, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders have kept themselves in elite company across minor league baseball. Entering play on Wednesday there are only 14 teams across minor league baseball with at least 20 wins, with only Nashville, Durham, and Omaha at that mark among Triple-A East teams. Bowie (AA, BAL) has the best record in minor league baseball at 22-7 (.759) on the season, but Tampa (Low-A, NYY) also sports 22 wins (22-9, .710). Overall, the Yankees have the best organizational record in baseball (77-41, .653), 2.5 games better than Baltimore (74-43, .632), who has the second-best record.

SATURDAY IN THE PARK: Since his promotion from Double-A Somerset, infielder **Hoy Park** has been a hitting machine for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. After a 1-for-4 performance on Tuesday, Park is hitting .362/.471/.707 with 5 doubles, 5 home runs and 14 RBIs in just 16 games played. In 113 games with Trenton in 2019, Park totaled three home runs, and combined with his one home run with Double-A Somerset this year, Park is already one homer shy of his career-high of 7 HR (2017 with Charleston and Tampa). Signed as an international free agent in 2014, Park already has six multi-hit games with the RailRiders, including a pair of three-hit contests. He has reached base safely in 15 games and recorded a hit in 13 of his 16 contests. Hitting Coach **Casey Dykes** credits Park's success to his advanced command of the strike zone and continued emphasis on generating hard contact and hitting the ball in the air.

WALK-A-THON: Through 29 games this season, the RailRiders have drawn 148 walks (5.10 per game), the second-most in all of Triple-A baseball, trailing only Gwinnett (163). No other team in the minors' highest level has taken more than 142 bases on balls (Las Vegas). Overall, the RailRiders are tied for 14th in all of minor league baseball in walks, with Tampa (Low-A, NYY) leading the way with 194 walks. The top four teams in walks all play in the Low-A Southeast, which is using an automated balls and strikes (ABS) system this season. SWB's team .356 OBP is third in Triple-A East, and ranks tied for 15th across all levels of the minors. There are currently three teams in Triple-A East with team OBPs of .350 or higher. Among qualified hitters, the RailRiders claim **Andrew Velazquez** (40th, .344), **Derek Dietrich** and **Socrates Brito** (both t-45th, .337) in the top 50 in OBP in Triple-A East.

LAST TIME OUT: Keller turned in one of his better outings of the season with the RailRiders on Thursday, June 3 against Lehigh Valley. He allowed just one run on four hits while striking out three and throwing a season-high 81 pitches. However, Keller walked four batters, marking the third straight start in which has issued at least four free passes.

WALK IT OFF: Brian Keller has the dubious distinction of leading Triple-A East pitchers in walk rate (min. 15.0 IP) entering play on June 9. In 17.0 innings, Keller's 10.59 BB/9 is more than Garrett Williams' (Memphis) 9.98 BB/9, while Stephen Gonsalves (Worcester) 7.77 BB/9 rates third. By BB%, Keller still paces the circuit at 24.7%, while Williams and Gonsalves check in at second and third again, respectively. The right-hander also leads all upper minor league (AAA and AA) pitchers in both categories.

JOINING THE NO-NO PARADE IN 2019: Keller began the 2019 season on the I.L. due to an elbow injury, and made his season-debut on 6/17 with Staten Island. After one rehab appearance, he was transferred to Double-A Trenton. The highlight of his season came on August 1, when he threw a 7-inning no-hitter against the Altoona Curve, allowing only one walk and needing only 70 pitches. It was the second no-hitter for the Thunder in the season and the 8th in the Eastern League.

LATE ROUND GEM?: The Yankees drafted Keller in the 39th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, a round which no longer exists (MLB shortened draft to 20 rounds for 2021). While it is uncommon for a 39th-round pick to even make it as far as Triple-A, there is precedent for success from the late rounds. Four-time AL All-Star Kenny Rogers was taken in the 39th round of the 1982 draft and accumulated 50.7 bWAR. Mark Buehrle (59.3 bWAR) was a 38th round pick, and current RailRiders LHP Nestor Cortes was chosen in the 36th round of the 2013 draft by the Yankees.

2021 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season on the RailRiders Opening Day Roster.

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- Played all four collegiate seasons at Wisconsin – Milwaukee and as a senior, set school records with 10 wins, 103 K and 107.1 IP.
- 2016 Horizon League Pitcher of the Year Award winner.
- As a SR in high school, went 11-0 with a 0.42 ERA and was named Wisconsin Baseball Coaches Association State Player of the Year.
- In 2017, led all Yankees farmhands with 157 strikeouts, the most for a Yankees minor leaguer since 2007.
