Tonight's Game: The Sounds welcome the Charlotte Knights to Nashville for a six-game series against the White Sox affiliate. Nashville took two losses to end the series at Jacksonville, going 4-2 in the Sunshine State. The Knights took both of the final two games against Durham to get a series win against their in-state rival last week. Left-hander Nick Bennett will be on the bump for Nashville in the series opener. He'll face right-hander Jonathan Cannon, who makes his sixth start for Charlotte in 2024.

Nick Bennett: The 26-year-old left-hander will be making his ninth appearance (fourth start) with the Sounds this season. He is 1-3, with a 5.23 ERA (20.2 IP/12 ER). In his last outing at Durham on May 11, Bennett allowed a season-high seven hits, and tied a career-high with six earned runs across 4.0 innings in his 100th career minor league outing. In his three starts, he has a 8.25 ERA (12.0 IP/11 ER) with four strikeouts. He only has nine strikeouts in 20.2 innings of work this season. He has been stingy against lefties, holding them to a .125 clip (4-for-32) compared to a .353 batting average (18-for-51) for righties. The Cincinnati, Ohio native attended the University of Louisville from 2017-19 where he had a 3.51 ERA (215 IP/84 ER) with 209 strikeouts for the Cardinals. Bennett was selected in the sixth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft by the Brewers.

Jonathan Cannon: The 23-year-old right-hander will be making his sixth start for the Knights in 2024. He is 1-2, with a 4.70 ERA (23.0 IP/12 ER) and 23 strikeouts. He has three starts with the White Sox this season going 0-1, with a 7.24 ERA (13.2 IP/11 ER). In his last outing versus Durham on May 16, Cannon went 5.0 innings, allowing three hits, one earned run and striking out five. With only two starts at the Triple-A level, Cannon made his MLB debut on April 17 against Kansas City. He was efficient, going 5.0 innings, allowing one earned run on 79 pitches. With struggles in his next two MLB starts, he returned to Charlotte at the beginning of May. Cannon has been able to keep the ball in the park, allowing just one home run in his five starts with Charlotte. He was drafted in the third round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft from the University of Georgia. He currently ranks as the no. 11 ranked prospect in the White Sox system according to MLB.com.

It Feels Like the First Time: In the seventh inning of Sunday's game, Francisco Mejía had the first passed ball by a Sounds player this season. Only the Omaha Storm Chasers have yet to have one in Triple-A. Sunday was also the first time since September 23, 2023 versus Jacksonville that Nashville had three errors in a game. Enoli Paredes allowed his first earned run in 10 outings (April 17 vs. Omaha). This season, Paredes has a 1.31 ERA (20.2 IP/3 ER) with 34 strikeouts.

Return of the Pitchers: Evan McKendry made his first appearance since April 11 after missing over a month on the injured list. Though only scheduled to throw one inning, he was unable to make it through the first inning, allowing four hits and two earned runs with only one out recorded. In his three previous starts with the Sounds in 2024, McKendry was 0-2, with a 6.60 ERA (15.0 IP/11 ER), with nine strikeouts. Taylor Clarke made his third MLB rehab appearance on Sunday, going 2.0 innings with three hits and two runs (one earned run) allowed. He has allowed an earned run in all three appearances with two of them via the home run.

'64 Skylark: Vinny Capra had his third home run of the season with a solo blast in the fifth inning on Sunday and extended his hitting streak to six games. He had a team-leading nine hits in the Jacksonville series with four runs scored, a double, a home run and two RBI. During his hitting streak dating back to May 12, Capra is 10-for-28. In May, Capra is hitting .328 (20-for-61) with a .808 OPS. He leads the team in hits (20), total bases (28), and is second in runs scored (10) in May.

Triple the Fun: Isaac Collins hit his third triple of the season in Sunday's loss which puts him into a tie for the team lead with Tyler Black. In the series at Jacksonville, Collins was 7-21, with three extra-base hits, four RBI and five walks. With 16 triples on the season, Nashville leads the International League as are third in all of Triple-A.

Home Sweet Home: The Sounds completed a 12-game road trip at Durham and Jacksonville with a 7-5 record. It was their only back-to-back road series trip of the season. They have a 13-14 record on the road and are tied with Scranton/WB and Durham for the most road games in Triple-A with 27. Before the road trip, Nashville was 6-0 in series finales but dropped both Sunday games on the road.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 705-606 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,297-2,126 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

Most Wins by Minor League Managers

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.
