APPLE SLICES

SUNDAYS ARE FOR YOST: TinCaps starter Eric Yost turned in his second official quality start last Sunday. The Northeastern grad struck out eight across 6 1/3 innings pitched, giving up one run on one hit. Yost's 1.76 ERA is second-best in the Midwest League. His 8.3% BB% is 7th while his 3.29 BB/9 is 8th. He leads the team in strikeouts (42) and innings pitched (41). In May, Yost is 2-2 with a 1.46 ERA, striking out 27 while walking eight. On May 4, Yost gave up just one run across seven innings, striking out a career-high 11.

COMEBACK 'CAPS: Combining for six unanswered runs in the sixth and seventh innings Saturday, the TinCaps have now come behind in 13 of their 25 wins this season. 10 of those came in their first 13 wins. They have come back from as large as seven runs.

THROUGH SIX INNINGS: The TinCaps are undefeated when leading after six innings this season. A perfect 19-0 record has been helped out by four Fort Wayne relievers holding sub-3.00 ERAs.

BIG LEAGUE BRADGLEY: Friday, the San Diego Padres called up right-handed pitcher **Bradley Rodriguez**. The No. 14 Padres prospect, according to MLB.com, made his MLB debut Saturday, pitching 1 2/3 scoreless innings against the Pirates. He is the second 2024 TinCap to make his Major League debut. In 29 games with the 'Caps, Rodriguez struck out 45 in 41 2/3 innings.

260 TO THE SHOW: Since Fort Wayne's MiLB franchise was founded in 1993, a total of 234 former players have gone on to appear in Major League Baseball. **Ryan Bergert** (2022-23), **Tirso Ornelas** (2018, 21), **Omar Cruz** (2019), **Robert Hassell III** (2021-22), **David Morgan** (2023-24), and **Bradley Rodriguez** (2024) have made their MLB debuts this season. Current Padres include Morgan, Rodriguez, LHP **Adrian Morejon** (2017), OF **Fernando Tatis Jr.** (2017), **Luis Campusano** (2018), and **Jackson Merrill** (2023). After dealing with injury, the 2024 NL Rookie of the Year Runner Up is hitting .333 to begin the year in 28 games.

EVERYONE KNOWS, IT'S BUTTERS: TinCaps infielder **Brandon Butterworth** is on a season-long seven-game hit streak. The NC State grad is batting .360 (9-for-25) on the stretch with a trio of triples, a home run, and 10 RBI. On Friday, Butterworth put together a 2-for-4 performance with a home run. He is tied for the team lead with 11 multi-hit performances. The TinCaps infielder is tied for the league lead with four triples and tied for 6th with 32 runs scored.

BAT 'EM IN BRANDON: **Brandon Butterworth** is second in the Midwest League in average with runners in scoring position, hitting .405 (15-for-37) with six extra-base hits and 17 RBI. He is only below No. 7 overall prospect **Max Clark** and is one spot ahead of Twins No. 4 prospect **Kaelen Culpepper**.

FISHING FOR KARP: TinCaps outfielder **Braedon Karpachios** reached base three times on Saturday with a walk, a single, and a reach on error. On Thursday, the lefty went 3-for-4 with a walk, RBI single, and later a two-run double in the ninth — his seventh multi-hit and fourth multi-RBI performance. Karpachios is 5th in the MWL with 33 walks and is 7th with an 18.9% BB%. His six home runs are tied for 12th.

WALKING ROSMAN: TinCaps infielder **Rosman Verdugo** has nine walks in his last 22 plate appearances (six games). The No. 24 Padres prospect walked four times in his first 77 plate appearances to begin the year.

JAKE SNIDER: Has reached base in 17 out of his last 18 games. A double on Saturday, Snider has six extra-base hits this season.

NIGHT, NIGHT FROM NEIGHBORS: For active pitchers who've thrown at least 20 innings, **Tyson Neighbors'** 45.6% strikeout rate is 3rd in Minor League Baseball. Leading the Midwest league, it is the highest in franchise history with data available back to 2006. The No. 15 Padres prospect also leads the league in K/9 (16.2), and swinging strike% (22.7%), and ranks 8th in K-BB ratio (6.00). Neighbors is tied for 5th in strikeouts (36) among relievers. The righthander holds a 1.35 ERA across 20.0 IP with four saves.

SHUTDOWN MAL: Down a pair Saturday, TinCaps reliever **Josh Mallitz** played the stopper role once again with 2 1/3 shutout innings in relief. Mallitz both struck out and walked two while not allowing a hit. The Ole Miss grad has recorded 12 1/3 consecutive shutout innings across his last five outings, striking out 19. Since April 30, Mallitz has made six straight appearances of at least two innings, holding a 1.00 ERA with 23 strikeouts. He is tied for 7th in the MWL in strikeouts (35) among relievers.

EYEING IT LIKE A HAWK(INS): Fort Wayne reliever **Garrett Hawkins** has not allowed a run in his last 10 outings. Across 12 2/3 quiet innings, Hawkins has struck out 19, with his fastball topping 98 mph. He is tied for 4th in the league with four wins and for 10th amongst Midwest League relievers with 33 strikeouts. After 702 days without a professional appearance, Hawkins moved to the TinCaps bullpen after beginning his career as a starter.

OSWALDO LINARES: He went 2-for-4 Friday before a 1-for-2 Sunday with a two-run double and a sac fly. Linares is hitting .320 (8-for-25) in May with three doubles, a triple, and six RBI.

JACK COSTELLO: Doubled twice Friday off of Loons left-handed starter Luke Fox. Costello ranks 5th in the MWL, hitting .354 against left-handed pitchers with five doubles (1st), eight extra-base hits (1st), and 12 RBI (1st). He is doing so with 14 or more plate appearances than the five above him.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Fort Wayne TinCaps are on their longest road trip of the season. 12 games in 13 days, the 'Caps begin with a six-game series against Great Lakes in Midland, Michigan. The team then heads to Beloit, Wisconsin, to take on the Marlins-affiliated Sky Carp. The 'Caps head home June 10 to start a series with the South Bend Cubs.

MAJOR LEAGUE MORGAN: Former TinCaps right-handed pitcher **David Morgan** made his Major League debut Monday in the Padres' 4-3 walk-off win in 11 innings. Morgan made three appearances in Fort Wayne in 2023 before being in the closer role to begin 2024. He struck out 40 in 31 1/3 innings pitched, securing four saves. He is the first player from the 2024 TinCaps to make their debut.

BOBBY BARRELS: A week removed from his MLB debut, **Robert Hassell III** made his presence known with a 3-for-5 night vs the Mariners with his first MLB home run on Thursday. Last week, the Washington Nationals selected the contract of the former TinCap. On the very first pitch he saw, Hassell lined a single to right field, collecting his first major league hit. Across 93 games between 2021 and 2022, Hassell III hit .280 with 37 extra-base hits, including 14 home runs, while driving in 66 RBIs. In just his third game in a TinCap uniform, Hassell III became one of just two players in franchise history to complete a three-home run game. Hassell drove in five in an 11-inning win at Great Lakes on Sept. 1, 2021, including a two-run home run in the final inning to seal the win.

LEO DE VRIES' HISTORIC APRIL: On Monday, May 5, Minor League Baseball announced **Leo De Vries** as the Midwest League Player of the Month for April. He is the fifth TinCap player to win Player of the Month since the Midwest League began issuing the award in 2013 and first since current Guardians left-handed pitcher **Joey Cantillo** in 2019. Across 19 games, the No. 1 Padres prospect led the Midwest League in SLG (.625) and OPS (1.003), while being tied for the league lead in triples (3). The switch-hitter also ranked third in extra-base hits (12), total bases (45), and AVG (.306), while being tied for fifth in RBIs (19) and tied for seventh in home runs (4). Later on in the day, De Vries won the Midwest League Player of the Week award for the second straight week. De Vries is the first TinCap to ever win the award in back-to-back weeks and just the fourth TinCaps player to receive the honor twice in the same season, alongside **Fernando Tatis Jr.** (2017), **Rymer Liriano** (2011), and **Jason Hagerty** (2010). The last player in the Midwest League to achieve the accolade consecutively was current Tampa Bay Rays outfielder **Jonny DeLuca** with the Great Lakes Loons in 2022.

- **BACKGROUND:** In 2007, the Fort Wayne City Council approved the Harrison Square Project to build a new ballpark downtown as well as other amenities.
- **DEBUT:** Opening Day for Parkview Field took place on April 16, 2009. The TinCaps played in front of a sold-out crowd and beat the Dayton Dragons 7-0.
- **CAPACITY:** 8,100
- **RECORD CROWD:** 9,508 (July 4, 2019)
- **DIMENSIONS:** 336 feet to the left-field foul pole... 377 feet to left-center field... 400 feet to straight-away centerfield... 383 feet to right-center field... and 318 feet to the right-field foul pole.
- **WALLS:** Range from 10 feet tall, from center to right-center field, up to 15 feet tall in the outfield corners as well as a small section of left-center field.
- **MORE THAN BASEBALL:** Parkview Field hosts hundreds of special events yearly, including concerts such as Florida Georgia Line, Dierks Bentley, Zac Brown Band, and Nelly.
