IRONPIGS CRUSH JUMBO SHRIMP 14-5

Thanks to an infield single from **Tristan Gray** in the bottom of the 10th, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp earned a walk-off 6-5 win over the Lehigh Valley IronPigs Saturday. Tied tive, Jacksonville walked off Lehigh Valley in the bottom of the 10th. **Troy Johnston** started as the ghost runner at second and **Deyvison De Los Santos** was intentionally walked for his fifth time on-base. A wild pitch advanced runners to second and third and Gray smacked an infield single scoring Johnston from third giving the Jumbo Shrimp a walk-off win 6-5.

ROCKET MAN

Still at just 21 years old, **Deyvison De Los Santos** has had a monstrous 2024 season between Jacksonville, Triple-A Reno and Double-A Amarillo. Currently, De Los Santos leads all of full season Mills in home runs (31), RBIs (90), slugging (.643) and OPS (1.026). He ranks second in total bases (240), tied for fourth in hits (120) and extra-base hits (50). Of the top 100 exit velos in the minors in 2024, the Dominican has hit four of them, trailing **Jhonkensy Noel** (6x), **Orelvis Martinez** (6x) and **Pedro León** (5x).

IT'S TEARIN' UP MY START WHEN I'M WITH YOU

In 2005, Jacksonville starting pitchers ranked just 25th in Double-A with 741.0 innings, which represented 60.6 percent of the club's 1223.2 innings. This season, the Jumbo Shrimp's starting rotation has worked 51.5 percent of the club's innings, a total of 475.1 out of 923.2 frames. That figure is the eighth-most in Triple-A. Jacksonville lid-lifters also lead the level in ERA (4.51; next-closest is Memphis at 4.61) while ranking third in WHIP (1.38), seventh in BAA (.257), eighth in OPS against (.777) and ninth in walks (188).

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 24-32 (.429) record. Jacksonville has scored only 236 runs at home (4.2 per game), third-fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring more than a half-run more per game on the road, totaling 239 (4.8 per game). Meanwhile, on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered only 214 runs (4.3 per game), the second-fewest in Triple-A. They yielded the 12th-fewest runs of any team at home (4.9 per game).

GET PITCH OR DIF TRYIN'

Jacksonville has gone 26-20 (.565) in their last 46 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 29 of those 46 affairs (63.0 percent). Since this run began on June 7, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A in fewest runs allowed (184) and ERA (3.79) while ranking second in WHIP (1.35), fourth in BAA (.246), fifth in OPS against (.738) and third in hits allowed (367), respectively.

SOULJA TROY

Heading into play on May 25, **Troy Johnston**, the reigning Marlins Minor League Player of the Year, was hitting just .240/.294/.316/.610 with only 12 doubles, one home run, 21 RBIs, nine walks and 16 runs scored in 48 games. However, over the last 57 contests, the Puyallup, Wash., native is a sizzling 68-for-212, slashing .321/.389/.500/.889 with 14 doubles, three triples, six homers, 28 RBIs, 21 walks and 38 runs scored. Johnston has 18 multi-hit games in his last 38 contests and is the season's IL leader in hits (115) while also ranking third in doubles (26) and 20th in batting average (.282).

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 62 of his last 73 games, notching 25 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 90-for-284 (.317/.387/.482/.869) with 21 doubles, four triples, six home runs, 42 RBIs, 34 walks and 38 runs scored. On the season, Sanoja ranks seventh in batting average (.297), tied for seventh in doubles (23) and tied for 11th in hits (96).

SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 11 of the last 13 games after doing so just three times in the previous 10 contests... Will Banfield is batting .347/.390/.611/1.001 with four doubles, five home runs, 15 RBIs, six walks and 17 runs scored in his last 21 games... Jacksonville has dropped five of their last seven games. This stretch comes on the heels of seven victories in eight contests.
