WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Single-A Fredericksburg picked up their second win of the Single-A second half on Sunday, beating Salem (BOS) 3-0 in their series finale...CF **GAVIN FEIN** clubbed two homers in the win, his fourth and fifth of the season.

SLIPPING THRU OUR FEATHERS: On a Father's Day Sunday afternoon where ESL Ballpark was filled to the brim - and one that also marked the end of the International League first half - the Red Wings were unable to prevail in their series finale with the Toledo Mud Hens, falling 9-6 to end the set in a 3-3 split...a trio of Wings went yard, as CF **ANDREW PINCKNEY** and C **RILEY ADAMS** found their respective sweet spots in the bottom of the fourth inning, and LF **TREY LIPSCOMB** trimmed the deficit to three runs with a home run in the closing inning...Rochester kicks off the second half tonight with a six-game set in Charlotte against the Knights...the Red Wings will send opener LHP **ZACH PENROD** to the mound, followed by RHP **LUIS PERALES**, and Charlotte will counter with RHP Zach Franklin...

Memphis beat Nashville by a score of 10-8 on Sunday, pushing the Red Wings into second place (1.0 GB) to wrap up the IL first half.

PUSHIN P'S: Taking the mound first for the Red Wings tonight will be LHP **ZACH PENROD**...this will be the southpaw's fifth start of 2026, and 30th of his professional career...he boasts' a 3.60 ERA (2 ER/5.0 IP) in four appearances as an opener, with seven strikeouts and a .211 BAA...RHP **LUIS PERALES** will take the bulk of the work, in what will be the sixth relief appearance of his professional career and second of 2026 (4/30 G1 vs. WOR)...in his previous start on 6/17 vs. TOL, the hard-throwing right-hander allowed four earned on five hits through 4.1 innings, while striking out five and walking two...he is holding opposing batters to just a .200 batting average this season, T-7th best among all Triple-A pitchers with at least 40.0 IP...

Perales averages 98.4 MPH on his four-seam fastball this season, eighth-hardest among all Inter national League pitchers (min. 10 G).

TURNING THE PAGE: Sunday afternoon marked the end of the International League first half...Memphis finished 1.0 game ahead of Rochester with a 47-28 record, and will host the second-half winner in a best-of-three IL Championship Series beginning on Tuesday, 9/22...the winner of that series will advance to the Triple-A National Championship game against the Pacific Coast League champion on Saturday, 9/27 in Las Vegas...despite finishing in second place, the Red Wings are the only Triple-A team - and one of eight in full-season MiLB - to win more than 40 games since 4/5, going 41-24 over that stretch...

Rochester is now sitting at 45-28 overall (0-0 in 2nd half), the first time they have been at least 17 games over .500 on 6/23 since at least 1983.

LOOSE LIPS(COMB): LF **TREY LIPSCOMB** went 2-for-5 at the plate in Sunday's loss, including a late home run that pulled the team within three...the Maryland native is now third in RBI on the Wings with 36...the left fielder also extended his on base streak to seven games in the contest...since the start of the final series of the first half on 6/16, Lipscomb leads the team in slugging (.778), total bases (14), and extra-base hits (4), while posting an on-base percentage of .400...through June, Lipscomb leads the Red Wings in AVG (.286), SLG (.571), and OPS (.898)...

Lipscomb is one home run away from a career high with 13, having played 69 fewer games than his current career high set in 2023...he is one shy of Joey Meneses for fourth most among all Red Wings as a Nationals affiliate with 28.

PHILL-ING IT UP: 2B **PHILLIP GLASSER** finished Sunday's series finale going 1-for-3 with a double that drove in three runners...the double extended his on-base streak to 14 games, hit streak to eight games (T-4th longest active in IL), and RBI streak to four games (T-2nd longest active streak in IL)...the former 2023 10th round pick out of the University of Indiana leads all active Red Wings (Min 30 AB's) by slashing .441/.474/1.003 this month, and also leads the International League in AVG (.441) and RBI (13)...

With runners in scoring position this month, Glasser ranks second in full-season Minor League Baseball (Min 15 AB) with a .625 average behind Double-A Harrisburg C Caleb Lomavita (.836).

THE ADAMS BOMB: C **RILEY ADAMS** went yard for the fifth time this season in Sunday afternoon's first half finale, finishing the game 1-for-2 with a walk, a hit-by-pitch, and a pair of runs scored...the homer was Adams' third of June, the first time he's hit that mark in a month since July of 2025 with Washington...Adams' five homers this season have gone for a combined distance of 1,951 feet, with four leaving the bat at over 100 MPH.

PINCKNEY POWER: OF **ANDREW PINCKNEY** began the Wings' back-to-back home run sequence in the bottom of the fourth inning, sending a 402-foot shot to right center field...the Tuscaloosa, AL native followed his ninth home run of the season with a run scored on a three-run Phillip Glasser double in the eighth inning...his two runs on Sunday place him fourth on the Red Wings with 38 on the season, and move him into a three-way tie for the team lead (11) in June...

Pinckney has been a part of six of the team's last nine back-to-back home runs, including all four in 2025...through the midway point of the season, the Red Wings have already surpassed last season's total with five.

Entering sixth season of professional baseball, first with Nationals after being acquired from Boston in exchange for LHP Jake Bennett on 12/15/2025...originally signed with Boston as an international free agent on 7/2/2019...earned Arizona Fall League Rising Stars honors in 2025...named Carolina League Pitcher of the Week on 6/18/2023 with Single-A Salem...Earned Florida Coast League Pitcher of the Month for July and Pitcher of the Week on 7/17 with FCL Red Sox in 2022.

- Left-handed batters are hitting .152 against him this season, while overall opposing batters are hitting .200, the seventh lowest among Triple-A pitchers this season. (Min 40.0 IP).
- Tallied his 250th career MiLB strikeout on 5/6 at SYR.
- Currently averages 98.4 MPH on his four-seam fastball, which is the third-hardest among all Triple-A starting pitchers.
- Made his most recent start (13th app.) of 2026 on 6/17 vs TOL, tossing 4.1 innings with five strikeouts...in 3/29, became the first Red Wing pitcher since at least 2023 to throw multiple pitches over 100.0 MPH in the same outing, which he has now done three times this season.
- Missed most of the 2025 season due to Tommy John surgery...made one start with Double-A Portland (BOS) before he was transferred to Triple-A Worcester on 9/16.
- Made his Triple-A debut on 9/17 against Rochester, striking out three batters in 1.0 inning of work.
- Made nine starts in 2024 for High-A Greenville (BOS, 7) and Double-A Portland (2) in 2024, going 2-2 with a 2.94 ERA (11 ER/33.2 IP), 56 strikeouts, 12 walks, a 1.31 WHIP, .250 BAA, and only one homer allowed...averaged 14.97 K/9, the 15th-highest mark in MiLB and the highest in the Red Sox system (min. 30.0 IP).
- In final outing with Greenville on May 21 at Greensboro (PIT), allowed only one hit in 5.0 scoreless innings while matching a career high with 12 strikeouts.
- Placed on the 7-Day Injured List on 6/9...on 6/27/2024, underwent Tommy John surgery, performed by Dr. Jeffrey Dugas at the Andrews Sports Medicine & Orthopedics Center in Birmingham, AL.
- 2025 Pitch mix; 4-Seam FB - 98.8 MPH, 28% usage; Cutter - 91.1 MPH, 41% usage; Slider - 87.5 MPH, 14% usage; Changeup - 85.0 MPH, 17% usage.

- Among all pitchers in the International League, he is tied for fourth with five wins and tied for seventh with 72 strikeouts in 49.1 IP.
- Recalled by Washington on 4/24 for his MLB debut the same day at Chicago-AL...allowed two earned on two hits across 2.0 innings of relief, striking out one and walking four.
- Named Nationals Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2025 with a 6-7 record, 3.28 ERA (49 ER/134.1 IP), 135 strikeouts, and 55 walks across 27 games (26 GS) between High-A Wilmington, Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester, setting career marks in nearly every category.
- Ranked among qualified Nationals Minor League pitchers with a .186 BAA (2nd), 104 strikeouts (2nd), 1.08 WHIP (3rd), 104.0 innings pitched (4th), and a 3.28 ERA (5th).
- Began the season with High-A Wilmington...transferred to Double-A Harrisburg on 5/23, and Triple-A Rochester on 8/6.
- Matched his career-high three times with 7.0 innings pitched (4/23, 5/17, 6/19)...set a career-high with 10 strikeouts in game one of a doubleheader on 4/12 against Hub City (TEX).
- Across seven appearances (6 GS) from 6/8-7/27 with Double-A Harrisburg, allowed just five earned across 39.2 innings (1.13 ERA) while holding batters to a .163 BAA.
- Made his only relief appearance of his career on 6/19 vs. BNG, with Double-A Harrisburg...turned in 7.0 scoreless innings on four hits, with eight strikeouts and two walks.
- Made Triple-A debut on 8/7 at Norfolk, striking out seven across 5.0 innings.
- Has compiled 68 MiLB appearances (67 GS) in his professional career, surpassing 300 career strikeouts in his Triple-A debut.
