JACKSONVILLE BLANKED BY GWINNETT 2-0

Despite five strong innings and six strikeouts from ${\bf Jake}$ Walters (L, 0-3), the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp fell 2-0 to the Gwinnett Stripers Friday night in front of 7.918 fans at 121 Financial Ballpark, Gwinnett (67-73, 34-31) took their first and only lead in the top of the fifth. After two quick outs, Joe Hudson doubled off Jacksonville (68-74, 36-32) reliever Richard Rodriguez and then scored off a base hit from Dalton Guthrie to put the Stripers ahead 1-0. The Stripers added their final tally in the eighth for a 2-0 win. Jacksonville finished 0-for-6 with runners in scoring position.

FOR THREE!

After five straight losing seasons from 2015-2019, Jacksonville has earned consecutive winning campaigns in 2021 and 2022. Sitting at 68-73 (.482) with 8 games remaining in the 2023 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp would have to finish the season 7-1 to make it three winning seasons in a row. Additionally, Jacksonville has posted a 34-38 record at 121 Financial Ballpark this year. Jacksonville will not have a winning record at home for the first time since the team returned to the Internation League. Prior to 2023, the last time the Jumbo Shrimp suffered a losing home record was when they went 27-41 in 2018.

Over the last month, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 55 runs, 46 earned, on 102 hits (7.8 H/9) in 117.0 innings for a 3.53 ERA. During this stretch, Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to strike out 139 batters (10.7 K/9) against 77 walks (5.9 BB/9).

MEN OF STEAL

While Jacksonville ranks just 11th in the 20-team International League in stolen bases with 121, the club has been exceptional in their efficiency at swiping bags. The Jumbo Shrimp have been successful on stealing a base at 81.8 percent of their attempts, a figure that ranks tied for third in Triple-A. Over their last 28 games dating back to August 14, Jacksonville base runners have been successful on 25 of 31 stolen base attempts (80.6 percent).

BROKEN BATS

Since beginning a series with Charlotte on August 29, the Jumbo Shrimp offense has been mired in a massive slump. Jacksonville has scored three runs or fewer in 13 of their last 16 games, with the club mustering a meager .198/.290/.290/.580 batting line as a team. Not coincidentally, the Jumbo Shrimp's 43 runs (2.7 per game) ranks 29th in Triple-A during this span. Despite getting outscored 62-43, Jacksonville has posted an 8-8 record. All eight of the club's victories have been decided by three runs or fewer.

TROY MEETS WORLD

After struggling in Jacksonville to close the 2022 season, Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City this year. In 44 games with the Jumbo Shrimp this year, Johnston is 57-for-172 (.331/.399/.547/.946) with 11 doubles, one triple, eight home runs and 32 RBIs. Johnston reached base at least once in each of his first 31 games, an on-base streak that marked the longest by a Jacksonville hitter since at least 2010. Including his time with Double-A Pensacola, Johnston has driven in 115 runs in 127 games this season, which ranks first in MiLB. He is the first Marlins' minor leaguer to post a season with at least 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases (Johnston has 26 and 22, respectively, between Double-A and Triple-A) since 2008.

Jerar Encarnacion endured a terrible slump in the middle of the year. In 46 games from May 16-July 14, the Bayaguana, D.R., native went just 23-for-163 (.141/.258/.380/.638) at the plate with just one double, one triple, 12 home runs, 19 RBIs and 24 walks (12.6 BB%). Encarnacion struck out a remarkable 80 times, a rate of 42.1 percent over his 190 plate appearances. In his last 36 games, however, the 26-year-old is 27-for-115 (.235/.369/.426/.795) with four doubles, six home runs, 20 RBIs and 25 walks (17.7 BB percent).

SHRIMP RITE

Jacksonville's elimination number sits at two with eight games to play, meaning any number of Jumbo Shrimp losses or Durham wins adding up to two will eliminate Jacksonville from playoff contention.


