

Dutchess Stadium was built in just 71 days in 1994. Crews bolted the last few seats into place when the gates were opening for the inaugural home opener on June 18, 1994 as the Renegades battled the Pittsfield Mets. The original Hudson Valley Renegades were an affiliate of the Texas Rangers before becoming a Rangers-Devil Rays co-op in 1997 and then a full-fledged affiliate of the Tampa Bay Devil Rays from 1998 through 2020.

A new affiliation with the New York Yankees took hold and the Hudson Valley Renegades opened a new era at the stadium in 2021.

The playing surface was natural grass from the stadium's opening until 2014, when the surface was replaced by Astro Turf.

# STADIUM GROUND RULES

1. Any batted or thrown ball that enters the dugout or strikes any equipment inside the dugout area is considered to be a dead ball and one base will be awarded.
2. Any thrown ball that strikes the protective screen in front of the dugouts will be considered a live ball. Should it enter the dugout area and return to the field of play or become lodged it will be considered a dead ball and one base will be awarded.
3. Any batted or thrown ball that becomes lodged under a bullpen area bench is considered to be a dead ball and one additional base will be awarded.
4. Any batted or thrown ball that becomes lodged in the tarp or enters the tarp cylinder shall be considered a dead ball and one additional base will be awarded.
5. No defensive player shall be permitted to place any footing on the tarp or tarp cylinder. A player may lean on the tarp.
6. A fairly batted or thrown ball lodged in the protective padding on the outfield wall shall result in two bases awarded.
7. A batted ball that hits the padding and bounces over the wall shall result in two bases awarded.
8. Any batted ball that becomes lodged in or beneath the outfield gate will be considered a dead ball and two bases shall be awarded
9. A fly ball that hits the yellow line on the outfield wall and then goes over the wall is a home run. A fly ball that hits the yellow line on the outfield wall and then goes back on the field is in play. Any ball that strikes a sign above the yellow line and returns to the field of play is deemed a home run.

## HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS

By receiving a media credential, a media member agrees to observe all MLB, MiLB and Club rules; any applicable government orders in a local market; and other precautionary steps that are in place to preserve health and safety. Media members must wear face coverings at all times, covering their nose and mouth, and practice physical distancing while possible in the presence on player, coaches and field staff. Media members should bring their own face coverings to the ballpark, but Clubs are permitted to use a Club-provided face covering if the Club determines that the media member's personal face covering is inappropriate for any reason. Failure to comply with any health and safety initiatives will result in a loss of access to the ballpark.

## ACCESS

Approved media members will not be permitted in Restricted Areas or in close proximity to player, coaches and field staff. The Restricted Areas include clubhouses, locker rooms, dugouts, training rooms, weight rooms, interview rooms and any route inside the ballpark/facility utilized by players, coaches and field staff. Approved media members who can provide proof of full vaccination will have access to the playing field, but are restricted to the warning track and camera wells, and must wear a face covering at all times. This level of access will be designated by a sticker on the media member's credential.

## CLUBHOUSE AND DUGOUTS

The clubhouse and dugouts will be closed to all media. This is subject to change pending guidance from the New York Yankees.

## VIRTUAL INTERVIEWS

Approved media members may arrange for interviews with players, coaches and field staff by video conference or telephone call, and all shall be coordinated by Club Media Relations/Communications personnel. Pre-game interviews should be arranged prior to and following Renegades batting practice on game and practice days. Any one media member who cannot show proof of full vaccination must conduct all interviews virtually. This policy is subject to ongoing review by Major League Baseball and its Clubs, based on the advice of medical experts and the applicable local guidance in the host city.

## PHOTOGRAPHERS

Photographers who can provide proof of full vaccination in accordance with policies set by MLB, its Clubs and local governance are allowed in the camera wells on the field during games provided they have on display a proper field photo pass issued by the Hudson Valley Renegades. Field access is restricted to the warning tracks only. Any secondary use of any picture, audio description, film/tape or drawing of an event at Dutchess Stadium (including, but not limited to: the use in delayed editorial or non-editorial, advertising, sales promotion or merchandising) by a holder of a media pass is prohibited without prior specific written approval of the Hudson Valley Renegades.

## PRESS BOX

The press box is located behind home plate with seating for media as soon as you walk in. You are required to have an official credential on your person at all times. Seating is limited and may be assigned to auxiliary areas. Additional seating is available upon request.

## INTERVIEWS

Pre-game interviews should be arranged prior to and following Renegades batting practice on game and practice days. Post-game interviews are available starting 10 minutes after every game.

## MEDIA NOTES

Game information and statistics are available in the press box approximately two hours before game time. Anyone needing information earlier should contact the media relations department. Box scores and play-by-play sheets are available in the press box after the game. Additionally, game information will be available online via the Renegades Virtual Press Box (<https://www.milb.com/hudson-valley/team/pressbox>).

# RENEGADES BASEBALL NETWORK

Prior to the 2022 season, the Hudson Valley Renegades and iHeartMedia announced that Z93 would be returning as the radio home of Renegades Baseball. It was also announced that Joe Vasile was taking over as the "Voice of the Renegades," and he would be joined by Emmanuel Berbari to form a new radio team for Hudson Valley.

Z93 will air all 132 regular season games and all postseason games on its airwaves. Fans can catch the Renegades Baseball Network over the air at 93.3 FM, with coverage spanning parts of nine counties in New York and three states.

In addition to the over-the-air broadcast, all games will be streamed live over the internet with links available through hvrenegades.com and on z93hv.iheart.com. The games will also be streamed through the iHeartRadio App, available for free on all app stores.

When the Renegades are at home, follow along with all the action on MiLB.tv.



**JOE VASILE:** Entering his first season with the Renegades, Joe comes to the Hudson Valley after spending three seasons and four years with the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the Triple-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. He began his career as the Broadcasting and Media Relations intern for the Fayetteville SwampDogs in 2014, where he was named the Coastal Plain League Broadcaster of the Year. He was promoted to Assistant General Manager and Broadcaster the next season, making him the youngest AGM in the industry.

A native of Paramus, New Jersey, In 2016, Joe was the Media Relations and Broadcasting Assistant for the Salem Red Sox, and held the same role with the Long Island Ducks in 2017 before starting with SWB. During the offseason Joe serves as the voice of Bucknell University women's basketball and football, and broadcasts basketball at Saint Peter's University. He hosts the baseball history podcast "Secondary Lead," and is a 2013 graduate of The College of New Jersey with a B.A. in Communication Studies: Radio/TV/Film.



**EMMANUEL BERBARI:** Emmanuel joined Siena College as "Voice of the Saints" in 2021, calling men's basketball and a variety of sports on ESPN+. He also hosts and produces shows on WFAN in New York City, where he's worked in a variety of capacities since 2018. Emmanuel's play-by-play experience includes baseball stints with the Cape Cod Baseball League's Chatham Anglers and Hamptons Collegiate Baseball League, and Fordham University athletics on ESPN's digital platforms. In 2019, he covered the New York Yankees as a full-season credentialed beat reporter.

A proud Fordham and WFUV alum, Emmanuel served as Sports Manager at the station. During his time at WFUV Sports, he was the lead play-by-play announcer for Fordham Athletics, earning recognition as the first three-time recipient of the Marty Glickman Award for Excellence in Play-By-Play. Emmanuel was twice named an All-American by the Sportscasters Talent Agency of America. Emmanuel is a native of Greenlawn, N.Y.
