LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox saw their brief losing skid extend to three-consecutive games on Saturday night, dropping another tight game with the Richmond Flying Squirrels. After Bowie took an initial one-run lead, Richmond scored the final three runs of the game, highlighted by a two-run home run by Will Wilson, to secure the 3-1 win. Bowie had more trouble driving in baserunners, as they left another eight runners on base. Over the course of their last three games, Bowie has stranded 29 total runners. Each side scored one run in the third inning, including a two-out RBI double from Hudson Haskin for Bowie. Following four innings on the mound by Zach Peek, Richmond attacked Conner Loeprich to take the lead, while Richmond used a combination of Matt Frisbee and five relievers to win.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Richmond and Bowie meet for the second time this month, after the Squirrels took two out of three at Prince George's Stadium over the opening weekend of the season. Richmond has only managed .500 ball since Opening Weekend, however, after taking four-of-six from Altoona in their first homestand of the year, but having the inverse happen on their recent road trip to Erie. While they did play fewer innings because of a doubleheader, Richmond struggled with Erie's league-leading pitching, scoring only 20 runs over the course of the six-game series.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Lefty Jake Dahlberg was Richmond's Opening Day starter, and fired 4.1 scoreless innings against Bowie while striking out eight batters, and turned to fire six more blanks on Tuesday to open this current series, stranding five baserunners along the way. In his two starts after Opening Day, Dahlberg has hurled ten innings, but allowed five earned runs and three total home runs. In his most recent outing, he worked six innings against Erie while striking out nine batters in a no decision. A former farm hand of the St. Louis Cardinals, he eventually spent parts of three seasons pitching with the Chicago Dogs in the independent American Association before being signed by the Giants in July of 2021. In 10 starts with the Giants High-A affiliate in Eugene, he went 2-5 with a 6.60 ERA, but still fanned 61 batters against only nine walks in his 46.1 innings of work. A graduate of the University of Illinois Chicago, he was named the Horizon League Pitcher of the Year in his junior season before being drafted by St. Louis.

TOP GUNNAR

Infielder Gunnar Henderson drew two walks to go along with a first-inning single last night for Bowie, giving him 21 walks on the year, second-most in the League. Gunnar has increased his walk rate from just 12.1% across three levels played last season up to 24.7% so far this season. Henderson is ranked as the Orioles #3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's #64 overall prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline. Listed as #4 for the Orioles and #57 in MiLB by Baseball America. He was named the Orioles Organization All-Star at third base by MiLB.com for his 2021 season.

OUT OF GAS

Bowie's constant struggle with leaving runners on base this series has made an impact on some of their numbers. Bowie has slipped out of the top spot for batting with runners in scoring position, thanks to a 1-for-24 mark at the plate over their last three games. Bowie has also stranded a total of 29 runners on base in the three-game stretch, bumping them up to 145 runners left on base this season, an average of 7.6 per game. Bowie was second in the Double-A Northeast in 2021, when they stranded just over 800 total runners across the season, a little over 6.7 per game.

SLIM MARGINS

Bowie had an early handle on one-run games this season, but have dropped three of their last four, falling to 3-3 in one-run games. Bowie has either won in either one-run games or in out-of-reach games, as Bowie has not won a game by two or three runs. It's looking like the Baysox may see plenty of one-run games this season, as their six one-run games are the fewest in the Southwest Division. Bowie's +17 run differential is the second-highest in the league, mostly thanks to their 20-6 win over Akron on 4/19 and their 10-0 win over Richmond on 4/27.

BUSY BATTERIES

This series between Bowie and Richmond lived up to expectations with its large volume of strikeouts. Richmond is tied for second in the Eastern League with 221 strikeouts at the plate, Bowie is not too far behind at 219, the fifth-most in the League. Bowie has been climbing the charts recently, however, as they lead the League with 125 strikeouts since April 18, including two different games where they struck out 17 times.

Career Notes

- Spent his time following the 2020 draft at the Angels alternate site at Long Beach State before being dealt to Baltimore the same December
- Orioles EVP/GM Mike Elias had targeted Stallings in the 2020 draft, but was taken earlier by the Angels.
- Threw two complete game shutouts in his junior season at Tennessee. He earned two SEC Pitcher of the Week awards, and was also named to the 2019 SEC All-Defensive team

What They're Saying:

Baseball America (2021): "Stallings is a polished righthander who mixes his pitches, limits his walks and lasts deep into his starts. His fastball sits 90-92 mph and his short, sharp mid-80s slider is his best secondary offering. Stallings mixes in an average low-80s changeup he commands well and a big, upper-70s curveball he is trying to throw for more strikes early in the count. He has a smooth, up-tempo delivery that is easy to repeat and allows him to command and sequence his four-pitch repertoire effectively. Stallings has a chance to move fast because of his command, advanced feel for pitching and business-like approach. His lack of a plus pitch limits his ceiling to a back-of-the-rotation starter."

Baysox Pitching Coach Josh Conway - Working with Stallings at Aberdeen in 2021: "He's a gamer. As far as the stuff goes, he's not going to blow up the radar gun, but he knows how to use what he's got....He's always in the zone.....a very efficient guy pounding the zone, coming right after you and basically daring you to hit him, which is nice. And he takes his strikeouts as needed. He found himself in a ton of 0-2, 1-2 counts this year, just being ahead of hitters, attacking guys in four pitches or less. Really had that mentality of, 'I'm just going to go right after you.' It was intriguing to see. He did a great job."

Notes by Outing

- 4/13 @ BNG Allowed three baserunners in the first inning, but no runs across thanks to a double play. Struck out two batters in a perfect second inning, but allowed two runs across in the third on consecutive two-out doubles. Followed with a perfect fourth on a pop out and two ground outs. Bowie had an early three-run home run, Binghamton would tie the game, and Bowie would sneak a run across in the seventh to win.
- 4/20 v AKR Allowed a two-out single to Brayan Rocchio in the first inning, the only hit in the game for Akron. Logged two strikeouts looking in the second inning, part of a string of nine consecutive outs after the single. Allowed a two-out walk in the fourth inning, then again in the fifth inning. Ryan Watson piggybacked with four perfect innings. Tied for the longest scoreless outing of his career.
- 4/26 @ RIC Struck out the first two batters of the game, but allowed a solo home run to Sean Roby. Loaded the bases to start the second inning on a walk, a hit-by-pitch, and an error, but retired the next eight batters and worked a double play to avoid more runs. Bowie was shutout.

Coaching Staff

Manager: Kyle Moore

The 2022 season will be the 13th season for Moore in the Orioles organization. He played 29 games over two seasons (2010-11) before becoming a coach. He spent three seasons as a player/coach (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds) before being named as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016 and the Keys hitting coach in 2017. Conway was selected in the fourth round of the 2012 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Chicago Cubs out of Coastal Carolina. He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double-A in 2016. The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
