Worcester Red Sox LHP Connelly Early (2-1, 4.08) vs. Durham Bulls RHP Jesse Scholtens (1-2, 5.57)

Three Up After Three Down – The Worcester Red Sox – winners of three in a row (August 23-26) on the heels of three losses in a row (August 21 & 22) – look to make it four straight wins tonight when they take on the Durham Bulls (AAA-Tampa Bay) in game two of their 6-game set at 6:35 pm at Durham Bulls Athletic Park. The WooSox took the series-opener last night, 5-2 and this evening will shoot for their first 4-game winning streak in over a month since they won the first four games of a series at St. Paul from July 22-25. This series continues with four straight games at 6:35 pm (tonight thru Saturday) before the series finale on Sunday at 1:05 pm. Tonight's game can be heard locally on NASH 98.9 FM, The Pike 100.1 FM, and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network.

A Trace of History – WooSox manager **Chad Tracy** is two wins shy of reaching 300 victories in his Worcester managerial career. Coming into tonight's game in Durham he has a 298-273 record since taking over as WooSox manager for the 2022 season. He has had winning seasons in each of his first three years at the helm and currently owns a 65-61 record this season with 23 games to go. "Trace", who turned 40 this past July 4th, would become the fifth manager in modern Red Sox organizational history to reach the 300-win plateau with a Red Sox Triple-A affiliate. Joe Morgan is the all-time leader with 601 wins in his nine years as Pawtucket Red Sox manager (1974-82), followed by other PawSox managers...Buddy Bailey with 502 wins in seven years (1993-96, 2002-04), Ron Johnson with 357 victories in five years (2005-09), and Kevin Boles with 345 wins in his five years as Pawtucket manager (2014-18). Chad had 176 wins in three years as a Minor League manager in the Los Angeles Angels' system from 2015-17 giving him a total of 474 career managerial wins overall heading into play tonight. DAP Me Up – Worcester enjoyed their first-ever game in Durham, North Carolina last night as Nick Sogard (3-for-4) led off the game with a solo HR, Kristian Campbell had 2 hits and scored a run, and Seby Zavala blasted a solo HR to back five Sox pitchers in a 5-2 victory. It was Worcester's initial look at the Durham Bulls Athletic Park (DAP) since the WooSox were born in 2021. The WooSox have hosted Durham at Polar Park in Worcester for three different series...August of 2022, April of 2024, and this past May of 2025. Overall Worcester leads the all-time series, 12 games to 7.

Opposite Directions – While the WooSox have won 3 straight, Durham has currently lost 7 games in a row including a 6-game sweep at the hands of Lehigh Valley in Allentown, PA last week/weekend. Worcester has not lost any of their last five series since getting swept in a 3-game set by Scranton/Wilkes-Barre at home from July 18-20. The WooSox took 4 of 6 from July 22-27 at St. Paul, did the same from July 29 – August 3 at home vs. Lehigh Valley, and since then have split each of their last three 6-game sets...vs. Buffalo from August 5-10, at Iowa from August 12-17, and vs. Jacksonville from August 19-24.

Hot Sox

-INF **Kristian Campbell** has a 5-game hitting streak (9-for-21, .429) with 2 2B, 1 HR, and 4 RBI. In his last 32 games is batting at a .333 clip (41-for-123) with 5 2B, 6 HR, 20 RBI, 8 BB, and 26 runs scored. Had a 15-game hitting streak that began on July 19 and ended on August 7. It was the longest on the WooSox this season and the second longest in WooSox club-history.

-INF **Vaughn Grissom** was placed on the WooSox injured list retroactive to August 19 with right foot inflammation. He has not played since August 9. In his last 29 games he is batting .297 (33-for-111) with 7 doubles, 7 HR, 22 RBI, and 23 runs scored.

-INF **Mikey Romero** has hit in 5 straight games (6-for-19, .316) with 2 2B, 1 HR, 5 RBI, and 4 runs.

-INF **Nick Sogard** has a 10-game hitting streak at a .415 clip (17-for-41) and has reached base safely in 22 straight games dating back to August 1 (Game 2). He also had an 8-game hitting streak from August 3-12. Now hit in 18 of his last 20 games (29-for-76, .382) with 5 2B, 2 HR, 8 RBI, and 19 runs scored. He is tied for 7th in the league with 63 walks.

-C **Seby Zavala** in his last 16 games is batting .292 (14-for-48) with 4 2B, 3 HR, 5 RBI, 12 runs scored, and 15 walks.

-RHP **Bryan Mata** in his last 11 relief appearances has allowed 3 earned runs over 16.1 innings with 17 strikeouts.

-LHP **Payton Tolle** has allowed just one run in his last two starts covering 10 innings going 1-0 – 10 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 14 SO. He has also given up only 1 run in his last 14 innings.

Series Matter – Worcester is 7-8-8 in their first 23 series played this season...seven wins, eight losses, and eight splits. The WooSox have four series remaining on the season (two on the road and two at home). They play here in Durham this week/weekend to end the month of August, begin September with a 6-game set vs. 1st-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre from Sept. 2-7, make their final roadtrip of the year from Sept. 9-14 in Syracuse, and then return home for the final 6-games vs. Rochester from Sept. 16-21.

Home Goods– From July 29 through August 24, the WooSox played 18 of 24 games at Polar Park (going 10-8 in those). The Sox have won 24 of their last 40 games at home since May 23. Overall the WooSox are 34-28 at Polar Park after reaching a season-high of 8-games over .500 at home four different times this season (June 20 & 22, July 2, and August 8). Worcester won a club-record 8 straight at home from May 25 – June 18.

Road Repair – Worcester has won 8 of their last 13 road games after losing 10 of their previous 15 on the road between June 24 – July 13. The WooSox are 31-33 on the road after dipping to a season-high of 6-games below .500 on the road on July 5 & 12.

First Things First – The Sox have scored runs in the 1st inning during 9 of their last 11 games (going 6-3 in those) with a total of 16 runs in those 1st innings. Worcester is 41-22 when they score first in a game compared to 24-39 when the opponent scores first.

August Moon – WooSox batters are hitting .259 in 23 games in August thus far (193-for-744) with 27 HR while Worcester pitchers are 13-10 with a 4.43 ERA (97 ER in 197 IP) with 19 HRA. Worcester has out-scored their opponents, 118-109 this month.

Hump Day – Worcester has had their most success this season on Tuesdays going 15-4 on what has been the opening game of 19 different series that began on Tuesdays. They have had two other Tuesdays postponed due to rain. Worcester has .500 or better records during each of the four weeknights they play games – going 15-4 on Tuesdays, 10-10 on Wednesdays, 11-10 on Thursdays, and 12-11 on Fridays. However, the weekends have not been as kind as they are 7-14 on Saturdays and 11-12 on Sundays for the only two losing days.

Above Board – At 65-61 on the year presently, the Sox have remained over .500 for more than a month now - since July 24. The last time Worcester was at .500 came on July 22 when they were 48-48. They reached 5-games above on August 8 (at 58-53) for the first time since June 28 when they were 42-37. Worcester has been exactly .500 a total of 17 different times this season...1-1, 2-2, 3-3, 8-8, 9-9, 14-14, 16-16, 18-18, 20-20, 21-21, 24-24, 25-25, 26-26, 27-27, 28-28, 47-47, and 48-48.

Durham Dynasty - As winners of the 2nd half of the International League in 2023, the Durham Bulls qualified for the International League playoffs for an amazing 19th time in their first 25 Triple-A seasons. (They did not make the post-season last year and are a longshot to qualify this season). Durham did lose their playoff series to eventual 2023 Triple-A Champion Norfolk as the Bulls fell short in their attempt to repeat and defend their 2022 International League Championship. The Durham Bulls became the Triple-A affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays in 1998 when they joined the International League. From 1998 – 2019 (the last year of the former International League), Durham won nine (9) Governors' Cup Championships as champions of the IL post-season. Those titles came in 1998, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003 (over the PawSox), 2009, 2013 (over the PawSox again), 2017, and 2018. Pawtucket did defeat Durham in a thrilling 5-game Governors' Cup Finals series in 2014. In 2021 in the new Triple-A East, Durham had the best record of any of the 20-teams in the league winning the Triple-A East South Division with their 86-44 overall record. And in 2022 the Bulls won their 10th Governor's Cup before falling one game short of another title in September of 2023.

This Season vs. Durham – The WooSox are 5-2 vs. Durham this season following their 5-2 victory last night at DAP. The Sox took 4 of 6 from the Bulls three months ago at Polar Park in Worcester. The Sox won the opener on May 20, 8-2, lost the next night in 10-innings, 7-4. May 22 was rained out. Worcester won Game 1 of a doubleheader the next night, 5-4, but Game 2 was rained out necessitating another make-up doubleheader on May 24. The clubs split those... WooSox won the opener, 2-1 and the Bulls took the nightcap, 7-3. Worcester won the series finale on May 25, 3-1 to take the series, 4 to 2.

Stats vs. the Bulls – Worcester batters are hitting .280 in the first 7 games vs. Durham this season (60-for-214) with 8 HR & 30 runs scored. WooSox pitchers are 5-2 with a 3.41 ERA vs. the Bulls (22 ER in 58 IP) with 8 HRA and 24 runs allowed.

Weather Getting Better and not Wetter – The WooSox are 13-10 in August with one home postponement to date this month (August 20). They had two home rainouts and one road rainout in July while going 10-13. Worcester finished 15-10 in June with no postponements. The Sox went 13-14 in the month of May (with one home postponement) after going 1-1 in March (with one home postponement) and 13-13 in April (with two home postponements & one home cancellation along with one road postponement).

Goodbye to July – Ironically, the WooSox began the month of July with a home rainout on July 1 vs. Syracuse and they ended July yesterday with another home rainout on July 31 vs. Lehigh Valley. Worcester finished 10-13 in July. Sox batters hit .264 with 29 HR while Sox pitchers were 10-13 with a 5.44 ERA and 38 HRA in July. The Sox were out-scored by their opponents, 124-122.

Tough Finish to a Winning June – Worcester posted a winning June with their 15-10 record that began with their 9-game winning streak from June 1-11 and was 14-5 prior to the start of the 2nd half (1-5 to end the month). The WooSox out-scored their opponents, 140-124 in June while batting .240 with solid production including 49 doubles, 7 triples, 34 HR and 140 runs scored. WooSox pitchers were 15-10 with a 4.72 ERA in June with 23 HRA & 124 runs allowed.

Other Month to Month - WooSox hitters batted .246 in May with 29 HR & 114 runs scored while Sox pitchers were 13-14 with a 4.84 ERA during the month with 32 HRA and 132 runs allowed. Worcester hit .273 in April with 25 HR & 145 runs scored and WooSox pitchers were 13-13 in April with a 4.74 ERA along with 26 HRA and 128 runs given up.

Highs and Lows – Worcester has been a season-high of 8-games over .500 on three different occasions (last on June 22 at 41-33). Those are their best marks since finishing last year with a 79-71 record. The WooSox have been at the .500 mark 17 different times this season... 1-1, 2-2, 3-3, 8-8, 9-9, 14-14, 16-16, 18-18, 20-20, 21-21, 24-24, 25-25, 26-26, 27-27, 28-28, 47-47, and 48-48. The Sox were a season-low 4-games below .500 (4-8) on April 11.

Ups and Downs – Worcester's stretch of winning 14 of 18 from June 1-22 was one of their best of the season along with an April 13-24 stretch when they won 10 of 11 games. Their worst stretches have come when they lost 15 of 21 from June 24 – July 20 and from April 25 – May 11 when they lost 11 of 15 games.

Doing One Better – The WooSox are 16-14 in 1-run games on the year and 5-4 in extra innings.

Home Run Derby – Worcester has maximized their use of the long-ball all season as 74 of their total 148 HR on the year have come with runners on base. Worcester batters have belted (74) solo HR, (48) 2-run homers, (18) 3-run blasts & (8) grand slams.

Streaks Appeal – The WooSox enjoyed a season-high and Worcester club-record 9-game winning streak June 1-11. They fell two wins shy of matching the longest winning streak for a Red Sox Triple-A affiliate in 55+ years...since the Pawtucket Red Sox won 11 straight in 2014. The WooSox have also had two 5-game winning streaks (from April 13-18 and again from April 20-24). Worcester had a season-high 5-game losing streak from April 25-30.

Weather or Not – Worcester's 8 home postponements this season are the most in the International League and all of Triple-A. Worcester has endured 10 weather-related postponements overall this year (2 on the road). The 8 PPD at Polar Park are adding on to a new WooSox club record for most home games either postponed or cancelled in a single season. The WooSox' previous mark of six home postponements was set in 2021 during Worcester's inaugural season at Polar Park. This season's postponed or cancelled home games have come on Saturday, March 29; Tuesday, April 8; Saturday, April 12 (which was cancelled); Saturday, April 26; Thursday May 22; Tuesday, July 1; Thursday, July 31; and Wednesday, August 20. Worcester has had only two road games postponed (April 16 in Rochester due to snow and July 23 at St. Paul).

A Winning Tradition – The 2024 Worcester Red Sox went 79-71 to post a winning season for the fourth time in as many years of existence and for the third year in a row under manager Chad Tracy. Trace is only the second Red Sox Triple-A manager to ever post three consecutive winning seasons. Darrell Johnson did so from 1971-73 (the first two years when the Red Sox Triple-A club was in Louisville before moving to Pawtucket in 1973). Worcester finished 35-40 during the first half last year but then improved to 44-31 in the second half. Overall the 2024 WooSox went 40-34 at home and 39-37 on the road. The 2021 WooSox had a 74-54 record during their abbreviated inaugural season, the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73, and the 2023 club posted a 79-68 mark.

2024 WooSox Batters Led the Way – Worcester led all 20 International League clubs in a host of team offensive categories last season. The WooSox led the league with 869 runs scored and also led the IL with 786 walks. Worcester paced the league by a wide margin

with an impressive .369 on-base pct. as the WooSox were the only team in the IL with an OBP of over .359. Furthermore, Worcester had the 2nd best OPS in the league at .795.

2024 Rankings – Worcester finished 5th in the IL in team batting with a .259 average. On the pitching side, the Sox were 10th in team ERA (4.84). Sox pitchers allowed the 2nd fewest HR in the league. Defensively, the WooSox were 11th with a .979 field pct. (107 errors in 5126 total chances).

Players Aplenty - The 2024 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records (previously set by the 2023 WooSox) as they made 281 player transactions during the 2024 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used 84 different players in 2024 (37 position players and 47 pitchers) to better the mark of 79 players in 2023. Ironically, the 2021 WooSox broke a long-standing Red Sox Triple-A record when they used 72 different players to beat the 1995 Pawtucket Red Sox (during a strike year when replacement players were used for the first month+ of that season) and the 2006 PawSox who each employed 70 different players. When Chad Tracy made his Worcester debut in 2022, the WooSox quickly set a new record using 75 different players (that was immediately topped first in 2023 and again in 2024).

WooSox to BoSox - The WooSox sent 28 different players to Boston during the 2024 season (not counting rehab players). A total of 22 different players were promoted from Double-A Portland to Triple-A Worcester last season.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) GAME RECAP – The Portland Sea Dogs (24-27)/(58-60) opened a 6-game series at Hartford with a 6-2 win last night. John Holobetz (1-1) earned his first Double-A victory going 6 innings allowing 2 runs with 6 strikeouts. Reidis Sena notched SV #5 with 3 scoreless innings of relief with 4 SO. Ahbram Liendo had 2 RBI and Caden Rose roped a solo HR (#6).

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – None today as of early this afternoon. Worcester has made 140 player moves since June 1 (including 49 in June, 44 in July, and 47 thus far in August).

The WooSox have used 72 different players already this season (42 pitchers and 30 position players). Last year thru August 31, 2024, the WooSox had employed 75 different players (43 pitchers and 32 position players) on their way to a Red Sox Triple-A record 84 players used during the 2024 season. Worcester added 9 new players last September (4 pitchers & 5 position players) to reach 84.

Furthermore, the WooSox have had four different players make their Triple-A debuts this month. RHP David Sandlin (August 1), INF Mikey Romero (August 1), LHP Connelly Early (August 2), and LHP Payton Tolle (August 10) have all been promoted from Double-A Portland and made their Worcester debuts during the past homestand at Polar Park.

Since the start of the season the WooSox have sent RHP Hunter Dobbins (three times), RHP Robert Stock (twice), C Blake Sabol, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Michael Fulmer, INF Nick Sogard (three times), RHP Luis Guerrero (three times), RHP Cooper Criswell (six times), INF Abraham Toro, RHP Nick Burdi (twice), INF Marcelo Mayer, RHP Zack Kelly (twice), INF/OF Nate Eaton (three times), RHP Brian Van Belle, OF Roman Anthony, RHP Richard Fitts (three times), RHP Isaiah Campbell (twice), INF David Hamilton (twice), LHP Jovani Moran (twice), LHP Brennan Bernardino to Boston, and OF Jhostynxon Garcia. Sogard, Murphy, Isaiah Campbell, and Toro are all back with Worcester. The Red Sox have also recalled rehabbers RHP Lucas Giolito, C Connor Wong, INF/OF Romy Gonzalez, OF Wilyer Abreu, LHP Chris Murphy, RHP Jordan Hicks, and RHP Tanner Houck directly from Worcester this season.
