GAME INFORMATION

POSTSEASON PONIES: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies clinched a spot in the Eastern League Postseason with the Northeast Division first-half title. It marks' Binghamton's 13th-time reaching the postseason in its 33-year franchise history and the second time in the last three years under fourth-year manager Reid Brignac. Binghamton has won three EL Championships (1992, 1994, 2014) and last reached the EL Championship Series in 2023.

NEW YORK METS AFFILIATES: The New York Mets are currently the only organization that has had three affiliates clinch a first-half title and spot in the postseason: Double-A Binghamton (Eastern League Northeast), High-A Brooklyn (South Atlantic League North), and Single-A St. Lucie (Florida State League East). The Detroit Tigers have had two affiliates clinch a first-half title: High-A West Michigan (Midwest League East) and Single-A Lakeland (Florida State League West) with Double-A Erie ahead by 0.5 G in the Eastern League Southwest with 2 games left. **FIRST PLACE PONIES:** The Rumble Ponies are 43-22 and hold the best winning % in Double-A and 4th-best in MiLB (.662). The Rumble Ponies have been in sole possession of first in the Eastern League's Northeast Division since May 18. Binghamton is 25-7 in its last 33 G, since May 14.

LAST GAME: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Harrisburg Senators, 9-3, on Friday at FNB Field. CF Jett Williams (2-for-5, 2B, K) and C Kevin Parada (2-for-4, K) recorded multi-hit games.

JETT IS TAKING OFF: SS/CF Jett Williams, the Mets No. 1 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 46 overall prospect, is hitting .349 (22-for-63) with a 1.104 OPS, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 14 R, 7 2B, 3 3B, 12 XBH, 3 SB with three three-hit games and eight multi-hit games in 16 games in June. Williams has recorded a hit in 11 of his last 14 games, and is hitting .400 (22-for-55) with a 1.238 OPS, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 13 R, 7 2B, 3 3B, 12 XBH, 7 BB, and 2 SB in that span He was named the Eastern League Player of the Week last week (June 9-15), after he produced a .385 AVG (10-for-26), .467 OBP, .962 SLG, 1.428 OPS, 8 XBH, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 8 R, 3 3B, 2 2B, 4 BB, and 1 SB in six games at Richmond. The 21-year-old ranks among the EL: 30 XBH (2nd), 5 3B (T-2nd), 111 TB (3rd), 41 R (3rd), .402 OBP (4th), 19 2B (T-4th), .923 OPS (5th), .521 SIG (6th), .300 AVG (6th), 64 H (6th), 34 BB (T-6th), 19 SB (7th).

GDTTA GD MORABITO: OF **Nick Morabito**, the Mets No. 16 prospect (MLB Pipeline), is riding a seven-game hit streak (13-for-33, .394 AVG, 1.004 OPS, 8 RBI, 7 R, 6 2B, 5 SB) with five multi-hit games in that span. In 14 games in June, Morabito is hitting .328 (21-for-64) with 14 RBI, 11 R, 8 2B, 4 BB, 6 SB with eight multi-hit games. The 22-year-old ranks among the Eastern League: 26 SB (1st), 21 2B (T-1st), 68 H (3rd), 26 XBH (T-5th), 38 R (6th), 102 TB (7th), .294 AVG (9th). Morabito had 26 XBH in his first 60 games this season, after he recorded 26 XBH in 119 games across Single-A. St. Lucie and High-A Brooklyn all of last year.

PARADA PARTY: C Kevin Parada is on a tear over his last 26 G (28-for-88, .318 AVG, .394 OBP, .602 SLG, .997 OPS, 7 HR, 19 RBI, 16 R, 4 2B, 12 BB, 26 K), after getting off to a slow start over his first 25 G this year (10-for-82, .122 AVG, .375 OPS, 1 HR, 4 RBI, 3 R, 5 BB, 29 K). In 17 games in June, Clifford has 4 HR (14 H), 10 RBI, 7 R, 14 BB (15 K), .877 OPS. He had a strong May (27 G, .267 AVG, .843 OPS, 5 HR, 20 RBI, 11 R, 14 BB) and ranked T-3rd in the EL in HR (5) & 3rd in RBI (20) in May, after he hit .200 with a .703 OPS, 3 HR, & 9 RBI in April. The 21-year-old ranks among the EL: 12 HR (T-2nd), 39 RBI (5th), 40 BB (T-4th), 100 TB (9th), 24 XBH (9th).

SMITH ARMY KNIFE: OF/INF D'Andre Smith is riding a six-game hit streak (10-for-26, .385 AVG, .907 OPS, 1 HR, 3 RBI, 2 R, 1 BB, 1 SB with four multi-hit games in that span. In 14 games in June, Smith is hitting .298 with an .835 OPS, 2 HR, 11 RBI, 5 R, 6 XBH, 4 BB, and 3 SB with six multi-hit games.

LD KNDWS: INF Nick Lorusso has collected five hits over his last two games against Harrisburg (5-for-9, .556 AVG, 1.556 OPS, HR, 4 RBI, 3 R, 2B). Lorusso ranks seventh in the Eastern League with 17 doubles. In 15 games in June, the 24-year-old is hitting .271 with 1 HR, 12 RBI, 7 R, 5 2B, 6 XBH, 7 BB.



-Reid Brignac is now the second-longest tenured manager in Binghamton history, behind Pedro Lopez (2012-16).
-In 2024, Brignac led a Rumble Ponies team that at one point won 10-conesecutive games, which marked the franchise's longest winning streak since 2006. Brignac also oversaw Eastern League Pitcher of the Year and Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year Brandon Sproat's dominant stint at Double-A. Brignac helped the Mets' MLB staff after the MiLB season.
-In 2023, Brignac led Binghamton to the postseason for the first time since 2017, going 39-27 in the second-half and 17-5

in the final 22 games. Binghamton swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to advance to the Eastern League Championship Series for the first time since 2014, before falling to the Erie SeaWolves.

-In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, Bryce Montes de Oca).
-Brignac enjoyed a long and successful playing career, spending parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School in Louisiana.

-Mariano Duncan begins his fourth year as bench coach with the Rumble Ponies and seventh year in the Mets organization.
