**ELIJAH EATING:** On Wednesday night, Elijah Dunham tied two career-highs with three runs scored and three stolen bases. THE RICE IS RIGHT: Ben Rice (2-for-5, 2 RBI, R) picked up two hits in his Double-A debut. Rice's first hit tied the game at 5-5 in the eighth inning for Somerset. His second hit gave the Patriots an 8-7 lead one inning later in the top of the ninth.

T.J. TIME: T.J. Rumfield has started this week's series with back-to-back multi-hit games. Now in five games since the All-Star break, Rumfield has four multi-hit games and is 7-for-18 (.389/.522/.556) with 4 RBI, 2 R, 3 2B and 4 BB.

**<u>COMING UP ROSIE</u>**: On Wednesday, Jeisson Rosario (3-for-5, R, 2B) registered a season-high three hits for the second time this season (last on April 23 vs. New Hampshire). With the performance, Rosario extended his on-base streak to a season-best 14 games. **2023**: Assigned to the High-A Hudson Valley break camp roster, making his professional debut for the Renegades on April 11 vs. Aberdeen. Went 2-1 with a 2.68 ERA in nine High-A starts before he was promoted to Double-A Somerset on 6/15. At the time of his promotion, Hampton's 77 strike-outs led the Yankees organization and ranked 5th in all of MiLB. Over his final four High-A starts, Hampton posted a 2.31 ERA and struck out 35 batters over a span of 23.1 IP.

**Career Notes:** Selected by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Texas Tech as a draft eligible sophomore, signing for a \$497,500 bonus. Pitched to a 4.29 ERA over 15 total appearances including 11 starts his sophomore year, where he ranked third on the team with 72 K in 56.2 IP. Set a career high with 12 strikeouts in his final collegiate outing in the Statesboro Regional versus Notre Dame, matching the program record for most single game strikeouts in a NCAA tournament game. Posted a 3.84 ERA his freshman season in 18 total appearances with 34 K in 44.1 IP.

**Personal Notes:** One of three former Texas Tech Red Raiders on the Patriots, joining Clayton Beeter and TJ Rumfield. Attended Kilgore High School in Kilgore, TX. Finished high school career with 284 strikeouts and a 1.94 ERA in 162 innings pitched, earning First Team All-State and District MVP honors his senior year. Was also awarded 2020 Perfect Game Preseason All-American and First Team All-Region honors. Helped Kilgore reach 2019 State Championship game his junior year.

Dominguez begins his 1st season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 9th overall as a manager and 17th overall coaching in the Yankees organization. He spent the past two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and was assigned to the same post for 2020, before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Dominguez becomes the 5th manager in Patriots franchise history and the 3rd since becoming the Yankees Double-A affiliate. He succeeds 2022 Eastern League Manager of the Year Dan Fiorito. Dominguez also previously served as the defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). The Panama City, Panama native has managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). From 2012-2015, his teams finished at least 10 games over .500, including reaching the DSL semifinals in 2012 and 2015. An outfielder during his playing days, Dominguez signed with the Yankees as an undrafted free agent in 2001 and spread four minor league seasons for New York between the DSL and the GCL. He then began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as the Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic. >>> Assistant coach bios on next page. >>>

Rosario was ranked by Baseball America as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in the Red Sox system. 2017 - 2019: Rosario spent the first three seasons (2017-19) of his career with the Padres organization. In 2018 and 2019, he was ranked by Baseball America as the "Best Athlete" in Padres farm system.

**Personal Notes:** Initially signed by the Padres as an international free agent on 7/2/16 for \$1.85 million. He was traded by the Padres to the Red Sox on 8/30/20 in a package for Mitch Moreland. His favorite MLB player of all-time is Carlos Gomez.

He played in 14 games during the Covid-shortened 2020 season and hit .351. During his freshman season in 2019, he appeared in 55 games, hitting .266. Sweeney was drafted 20th overall in the first round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Yankees, signing for \$3 million as one of three first rounders in EIU history.
