**LAST NIGHT:** Rocket City scored three runs in the seventh to break a 4-4 tie and defeat Tennessee 7-4 on Thursday. The Smokies scored first in the second on a solo-homer by Chase Strumpf. Twice the Trash Pandas would score two runs in an inning without the benefit of a hit. The first one came in the bottom-half as a hit batter, two walks and two double steals and a wild pitch gave Rocket City the lead. Rightfielder Ryan Aguilar scored on a wild pitch, while Jose Gomez stole home. The Smokies would then score single runs in innings 4-6 to take a 4-2 lead. Jake Washer had an RBI single in the fourth, Alexander Canario belted a solo blast in the fifth, and Jake Slaughter singled in another run in the sixth. Again, Rocket City plated two runs without a hit in the bottom of the sixth. Four consecutive walks to start the inning by Smokies reliever Kyle Johnson, the final one coming with the bases loaded to Gomez pulled the Trash Pandas to within one. Jordyn Adams followed with a run-scoring double play ball to tie the game. The Trash Pandas finally took the lead in the seventh on a Preston Palmeiro two-run shot. Later in the inning, Torii Hunter Jr. tripled and Aguilar singled him home for the final margin. There were a combined 16 walks, 22 strikeouts, and five hit batsmen between the teams. Reliever Luke Murphy tossed a scoreless seventh for the win. Closer Eric Torres picked up his league-leading 12th save by firing two scoreless innings and striking out four to finish the game.

**OBP...RYNO EXPLAINS IT:** Now owning a .261 batting average after hitting .344 for the month of July, outfielder Ryan Aguilar has compiled the best on-base percentage in the Southern League at .413. One reason for the high OBP is because he leads the team in walks with 54, which is fourth in the League. On 7/2 at Tennessee, Aguilar showed his penchant for getting on base by drawing five walks in five plate appearances. He also scored three times and stole a base in that game as well. Aguilar is also seventh in OPS at .878. He has blasted four homers over his last 15 games. He is 23-69 (.333) over his last 20 games. He is currently tied for first on the team in homers with 12.

**BULLISH PEN:** A huge key to Rocket City's success has been the work of its bullpen. Specifically, co-closers Kolton Ingram and Eric Torres and setup man Luke Murphy have been especially tough. Ingram has posted a 1.23 ERA with six saves and 35 Ks in his last 29.1 innings of work with only six walks. Torres, meanwhile, has eight saves and a 2-1 record in his last 24.2 innings with 10 hits and four ER allowed for a 1.46 ERA to go along 37 punchouts. Murphy is tied for second on the team with seven wins. In fact, in 27 appearances this season he has not allowed a run in 20 of them. Over his last 15 appearances he is 3-0 with a 2.16 ERA over 16.2 innings and 18 strikeouts with four ER. Furthermore, middle reliever Nick Jones has been strong of late, striking out 30 over his last 21 innings of work. He has not allowed a run in his last five outings (7.1 innings).

**CLOSING IT OUT:** The work of Ingram and Torres have provided the Trash Pandas with a nice two-headed monster at the end of games. Torres' 12 saves are tops in the Southern League with Ingram owning seven more and sitting in a tie for fifth. Rocket City, as a team, currently leads the league in saves with 29.

**TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER:** Pitching in a Trash Pandas uniform for only the second time since 6/19 will be RHP Chase Silseth. The Angels #18 prospect according to MLB.com has bounced back-and-forth between AA and the Majors. He last pitched on 7/30 for Los Angeles against Texas and allowed five runs on five hits in four innings of a no-decision. While with the Trash Pandas, Silseth has been one of the best compiling a 2-0 record with a 2.01 ERA with 54 strikeouts in 40.1 innings with opponents batting .199 against him. The 11th round draft choice out of Arizona started four games earlier this season for the Angels and went 1-1 with a 4.96 ERA. He won his MLB debut on 5/13 at Oakland when he fired six innings of shutout ball on one hit. Before the callup, he was 1-0 with a 1.35 ERA and 27 Ks over 20 innings and a .188 opponents' average. He was awarded the Southern League's Pitcher of the Week honors for the week of 4/18-4/24 when he allowed a run on three hits over six frames, walked one and struck out seven in an 8-3 win. It was his first win in a Trash Pandas uniform after two no-decisions to start the season. He followed that up by firing six more innings and allowed an unearned run on four hits with eight punchouts in a win over Birmingham on 4/28.

# WHAT IS A TRASH PANDA?

The name was chosen in a name-the-team contest and is a reference to the area's association with the space industry and the determination and ingenuity of raccoons, aka trash pandas.

Trash Pandas, slang for raccoon, was included in the original 10 nominations following several Brandiose-led focus groups in Madison and Huntsville. The ballot descriptor read: Our community is known for engineering, and no creature in our galaxy is as smart, creative, determined and ingenious a problem solver - dedicated to the challenge at hand - as our local raccoons!

In July 2018, after the results from several focus groups in Madison and Huntsville, 10 names were selected, based on their uniqueness and how each name relates to the characteristics of the area: (Alphabetically) Army Ants, Comet Jockeys, GloWorms, Lunartics, Moon Possums, Puffy Head Bird Legs, Space Chimps, Space Sloths, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas. The focus groups were led by San Diego-based Brandiose, the Minor League Baseball industry's premiere branding partner.

Over the next few weeks, two rounds of online voting took place. The first round narrowed the list to Comet Jockeys, Moon Possums, Space Chimps, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas.

Trash Pandas won the final round with 44.75 percent of the vote to ThunderSharks 19.25 percent. Moon Possums was third (12.57 percent); Space Chimps fourth (12.05 percent); and Comet Jockeys fifth (11.38 percent).

By the way, Trash Pandas dominated both rounds.

More than 28,500 nominations and votes were recorded. According to Brandiose, this represented - by far - the largest community participation in a Name the Team contest in the history of Minor League Baseball.

The team name was announced in a local microbrewery in September 2018 with nearly 1,500 fans on hand. Trash Pandas was nominated by Matthew Higley of Lacey's Spring, Ala. He received two box seats for the first five seasons and will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at a Trash Pandas home game.

The regional identifier was also chosen by the community. Out of 13,559 votes cast, 67.4 percent chose Rocket City over North Alabama (18.09 percent) and Madison (14.51 percent).



# NEW MiLB RULES FOR 2022

*Press Release From Major League Baseball - March 14, 2022*

Major League Baseball announced a variety of experimental playing rules that have been approved by the Competition Committee and the Playing Rules Committee for use during the 2022 Minor League season. Consistent with the preferences of fans, these rules are designed to improve the pace of play, create more action on the field, and reduce player injuries.

Many experimental rules were first tested on a limited basis in 2021. The use of the most promising rules has been expanded to additional levels of play, providing more players and fans with exposure to the rules and allowing the Competition Committee to better evaluate the impact of each on game play. Below is a summary of the experimental rules that will be tested during the 2022 Minor League season:

**PITCH TIMER:** On-field timers will be used at all full-season affiliates to enforce regulations designed to create a crisp pace of play, with batters required to be ready to hit and pitchers required to deliver the pitch within allotted periods of time. With runners on base, pitchers will have additional allotted time for each pitch but will risk automatic baserunner advancement if a third pick-off attempt or step-off within the same plate appearance is made without recording an out. These rules were used in tandem in the Low-A West and in the Arizona Fall League in 2021 and led to a significant improvement in pace of play and a reduction in average game time of more than 20 minutes.

**LARGER BASES:** The size of first, second and third base will be increased from 15 inches square to 18 inches square at all full-season affiliates to reduce player injuries. Bigger bases were used in 2021 at the Triple-A level and in the Arizona Fall League, and were associated with a decrease in the severity of base-related injuries. In addition, the reduction in distance between bases led to a modest increase in the rate of successful stolen base attempts.

**DEFENSIVE POSITIONING:** In Double-A, High-A and Low-A, the defensive team must have a minimum of four players on the infield, with at least two infielders completely on either side of second base. These restrictions on defensive positioning are intended to allow infielders to better showcase their athleticism, to increase batting average on balls in play, and to restore a more traditional set of aesthetics and outcomes on batted balls.

## ANDY SCHATZLEY — MANAGER

**Born:** October 23, 1984, Paragould, Arkansas

**Managerial/Coaching Career:** Begins his third season with the Angels organization at the helm of the Trash Pandas for their second season ... In his professional managerial debut, led High-A Tri-City to a 43-68 record in 2021 where he coached future Trash Pandas standouts including Brendon Davis, Kolton Ingram, Davis Daniel, Ryan Smith, and Cristopher Molina ... Was slated to debut with Rookie-Level Orem in 2020, but the season was cancelled due to the pandemic ... Prior to joining the Angels, Schatzley spent eight seasons as an Associate Head Baseball Coach at Harding University in Searcy, Arkansas ... Previously, he came to Harding from Emporia State University in Emporia, Kansas where he worked as an assistant in 2011 ... During the 2009-10 seasons, he was a Graduate Assistant at Lubbock Christian University, where he won a NAIA title in 2009 ... Also was the Head Coach of the Outer Banks Daredevils of the Coastal Plain League, a summer wood bat league for collegiate players ... Served as Head Coach of the El Dorado Broncos of the Jayhawk League from 2009-10, including a National Baseball Congress World Series title in 2009.

**Playing Career:** Played at Pratt Community College in Pratt, Kansas from 2004-06 and Lyon College in Batesville, Arkansas (2006-08) ... Earned a master's at Lubbock Christian University in organizational leadership in 2010.




## MICHAEL WUERTZ — PITCHING COACH

**Born:** December 15, 1978, Austin, Minnesota

**Resides:** Scottsdale, Arizona

**Coaching Highlights:** The first pitching coach in franchise history, Wuertz returns for his second season with the Trash Pandas after 10 former Rocket City pitchers made their MLB debut for the Angels in 2021 ... He spent three of the previous four seasons played with High-A Inland Empire ... In 2018, he was the Pitching Coach for Rookie-level Orem ... Was scheduled to return to Inland Empire in 2020 before the MiLB season was cancelled.

**Playing Career:** Pitched in 426 Major League games over eight seasons between the Chicago Cubs (2004-08) and Oakland Athletics (2009-11) ... Posted a 21-11 record and 11 saves with 444 strikeouts over 414.1 career innings for a solid 9.6 strikeouts per nine innings ... Led American League relievers and tied for second in the Majors with a career-high 102 strikeouts in 2009, becoming the third A's reliever after Rollie Fingers (1972-73, 75-76) and Dennis Eckersley (1987) to fan 100 in a season ... Made MLB debut for the Cubs in 2004 and spent all or parts of five seasons in the Cubs bullpen from 2004-08 ... Appeared in a team-leading 75 games for Chicago in 2005 ... His 265 relief appearances for the Cubs ranked eighth-most in franchise history prior to his trade to Oakland in February 2009 ... Finished his playing career with parts of two seasons for the York Revolution of the Independent Atlantic League from 2013-14.



## KENNY HOOK — HITTING COACH

**Born:** July 6, 1975, Houston, Texas

**Resides:** Kansas City, Missouri

**Managerial/Coaching Highlights:** The first hitting coach in Trash Pandas history, Hook begins his second season in Rocket City and third with the Angels after leading a powerful Trash Pandas offense to a Double-A South best 152 home runs in 2021 ... Was scheduled to be the hitting coach for High-A Inland Empire in 2020 ... Spent the previous six seasons played in the Texas Rangers organization ... Started as the hitting coach for the Arizona Rookie League Rangers from 2014-15 before moving up to Class-A Short Season Spokane in 2016, followed by a season with both Class-A Hickory in 2017 and Class-AA Advanced Down East in 2018 ... He returned to Spokane in 2019 for his first season managing in affiliated baseball and led the Indians to the Northwest League playoffs after posting a 45-31 record. However, the Indians were eliminated in the first round of the postseason ... Prior to his stint with the Rangers, he began his coaching career as the hitting coach for the Kansas City T-Bones of the Independent American Association in 2011 while also working as an assistant head coach at Maple Woods Community College ... Became manager of the T-Bones in 2012 and in his first season as a manager at any level, he led Kansas City to a 51-49 record in 2012 before posting a 40-60 record in 2013.

**Playing Career:** Played collegiately for Crowder College (Neosho, MO) and Benedictine College (Atchinson, KS) ... Made his pro debut for the Amarillo Dillas from 1997-2000 and was a part of their 1999 Texas-Louisiana League Championship club ... After a year off, played in 38 games as a player/coach for the Central League's Rio Grande Valley WhiteWings in 2002 ... Over 351 games in his five-year pro career, hit .277 (360-1300) with six HR and 192 RBI.



## DANN BILARDELLO — COACH

**Born:** May 26, 1959, Santa Cruz, California

**Resides:** West Palm Beach, Florida

**Managerial/Coaching Highlights:** Enters his first season in the Angels organization after spending most of the last 15 years in the Cardinals system ... Managed High-A Palm Beach (2014, 2017-20), Double-A Springfield (2015-16), Low-A Peoria (2013), and Rookie-Level Batavia (2010-12) after he was a minor league catching instructor from 2006-09 ... Won a Pioneer League Championship in his managerial debut for the Great Falls Dodgers in 2002 ... Stayed in Dodgers system from 2002-04 before a season in Red Sox organization in 2005.

**Playing Career:** Appeared in 382 MLB games over eight big league seasons from 1978-1994, playing for the Cincinnati Reds, Montreal Expos, Pittsburgh Pirates, and San Diego Padres ... Hit .204 with 18 home runs, 91 RBI, and 79 RBI in his MLB career ... Also played in over 800 minor league games, hitting .260 with 90 home runs, 385 RBI, and 347 runs ... During his big league career, was teammates with Hall of Famers Tony Gwynn, Johnny Bench, and Andre Dawson.

### TRASH TALK

**THE SILSETH FILE:** RHP Chase Silseth is back in Rocket City after his third stint of the season at the MLB level. Most recently, he didn't factor in the decision on 7/30 vs. Texas, allowing five runs on five hits over four innings. In his most recent Rocket City start, he didn't factor in the decision after striking out seven on 7/15 at Mississippi. Before the demotion, he took a loss at Baltimore on 7/7, giving up four runs in four innings after allowing three runs over 4.1 innings on 6/28 against the White Sox. He was optioned to Rocket City on 7/11. Earlier on 5/13, he became the first member of the 2021 draft class to reach the show with his MLB debut at Oakland, firing six scoreless innings with two walks and four strikeouts to earn his first MLB win. He followed that by pitching 4.1 innings in both of his next two starts on 5/20 vs. Oakland, suffering the loss while striking out six before a no-decision against Toronto on 5/27. In his last game of his first stint for the Angels on 6/3, he got rocked for four runs in Philadelphia on homers from Kyle Schwarber and Bryson Stott over 1.2 innings for his second big league loss. Silseth was optioned back to Rocket City on 6/7. In his first start back, he allowed one run on three hits over four innings on 6/12 against Mississippi. On 6/19, he fired a quality start by allowing a run on three hits with seven strikeouts as Rocket City went on to clinch the first-half title with a 7-2 win over Montgomery. Before his MLB promotion, he was dominant for the third straight Rocket City start on 5/5 vs. Chattanooga, recording a career-high 10 strikeouts in his third quality start in a row in what proved to be a 3-2 Rocket City walk-off win. He earned his second straight win on 4/28 vs. Birmingham, striking out eight while giving up an unearned run over 6.0 innings. The Angels' 11th round draft pick in the 2021 draft was named Southern League Pitcher of the Week on 4/24, having earned his first professional win at Tennessee with a career-high 6.0 strong innings and seven strikeouts. Made his 2022 debut at Birmingham on 4/10, giving up one run on four hits with two walks and six strikeouts in a no-decision as Rocket City went on to win 4-1.

**VS. TENNESSEE:** Silseth will face the Smokies for the second time in his career tonight. He earned his first professional win at Smokies Stadium on 4/22, striking out seven and allowing a single run over 6.0 innings in his first pro quality start.

### MORE NOTES

**PRO DEBUT:** Debuted for the ACL Angels on 9/2/21 against the ACL Reds and pitched 2 relief innings before joining Rocket City. In his Double-A debut on 9/7/21 at Birmingham, he allowed one run with three strikeouts over 3 innings, but the Trash Pandas were shut out so Silseth took the loss. He became the first of the Angels' 2021 draftees to reach Double-A. Five days later, Silseth couldn't make it out of the first inning in the finale against the Barons, allowing 5 runs for his second loss.

**FIRST AWARDS:** On April 24, Silseth was named the second Southern League Pitcher of the Week for the 2022 season after fellow Rocket City starter Brett Kerry won the award in the season's first week. Silseth made one start that week and was sensational, giving up one run on three hits with one walk and seven strikeouts on 4/22 at Tennessee to earn his first professional victory. The award is the first of Silseth's professional career. A week later, he was named Southern League Pitcher of the Month for April after going 2-0 with a 1.35 ERA (3 ER/20.0 IP) and 27 strikeouts over his first four starts of the year.

**PLAYOFF PERFORMANCE:** Silseth made 3 postseason starts for Arizona and posted a 7.07 ERA to end 2021. He opened the Tucson NCAA Regional against Grand Canyon. He then started Game 1 of the Tucson NCAA Super Regional vs. Ole Miss and gave up 3 runs over 4.2 innings. He ended his NCAA career in the College World Series opener vs. Vanderbilt and outdueled two-time first round pick Kumar Rocker with 6.1 strong innings on 6/19, but Arizona came up short in extra innings.

**HIGH SCHOOL NOTES:** Attended Piedra Vista High School in Farmington, New Mexico and went 7-3 with a 2.35 ERA and hit .328 as a junior in 2018.
