TODAY'S GAME: Good morning and welcome to LoanMart Field! Your first-place Quakes open a six-game set against the San Jose Giants (SF) today. Today is our first of two Education Days, thanks to Verizon 5G Home Internet, with a special start time of 11am. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE PORTS: Today's game is the first of 18 games against the Giants and the first of 12 here at home. The Quakes were 7-5 against the Giants in 2024, 4-2 here at LoanMart Field.

LAST GAME: The Quakes played their best road game of the series on Sunday, bringing home a 10-1 win over the Stockton Ports in the series finale at Banner Island Ballpark. Rancho's Raynerd Ortega enjoyed a career-day, going 4-for-5 with two homers and four RBIs in the win. The Quakes totaled four homers on the day, with Kellon Lindsey (1) smashing his first as a pro, while Eduardo Quintero (2) hit his second of the road trip. Quakes' starter Christian Zazueta was outstanding in the no-decision, allowing one run on five hits over 4.1 innings, while striking out seven. Reliever Marco Corcho (1-0) earned the win with 1.2 innings of scoreless relief, while Michael Vilchez earned the three-inning save with scoreless ball, his first of the year. Stockton's Sam Stuhr (0-1) took the loss. The win for Rancho gives them just two wins in the six games, as they suffered their first series-loss of the year.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made a roster move early Tuesday morning, placing Oswaldo Osorio on the Injured List. Taking his place is infielder Eduardo Guerrero, who joins the team from High-A Great Lakes.

STILL WEARING THE SAME SHOE: The Quakes have welcomed back Manager John Shoemaker, who returns to Rancho to guide the Quakes for a fifth straight year, a franchise record. The club is 271-243 in four seasons under "Shoe", having made the playoffs twice, including one appearance in the Championship Series (2023). The Quakes have only one returning coach to this year's club, as pitching coach Ramon Troncoso returns to Rancho, joining Shoemaker for his fifth year as well. New members of the coaching staff include hitting coach Johermyn Chavez, pitching coach Brandon Bailey, Bench Coach Dunior Zerpa, Bullpen Coach and former Quake Marco Hernandez, Athletic Trainer Alfredo Casillas, Performance Coach Jake Taylor and Video Associate Max Delorme.

PROSPECT HEAVY: According to MLB Pipeline's rankings the Dodgers have stocked the Quakes with seven of their top-30 prospects. In order, they are: INF Kellon Lindsey (#8), OF Eduardo Quintero (#9), INF Joendry Vargas (#12), RHP Hyun-Seok Jang (#17), OF Mike Sirota (#21), OF Jaron Elkins and RHP Samuel Sanchez (#28). Of the 29 active players on the Rancho roster, 15 of them saw time in a Quakes' uniform in 2024.

SAMUEL SANCHEZ: Right-hander Samuel Sanchez makes his second start of 2025, as he'll face the Giants for the first time. In his 2025 debut, Sanchez allowed three runs (two earned) on four hits over four innings, walking three and striking out just two in a no-decision at Stockton on April 9th. Sanchez made two starts for Rancho last season, going 0-0 with an ERA of 3.00, allowing two runs over six innings. He also made 11 appearances (eight starts) for the ACL Dodgers, going 2-2 with a 4.98 ERA, allowing 19 earned runs over 34.1 innings. Sanchez signed with the Dodgers in January of 2023 out of Venezuela and is ranked as the Dodgers 28th-best prospect, according to MLB Pipeline.

HUNTER DRYDEN: Right-hander Hunter Dryden makes his second start of the year and his first against the Quakes. In his pro debut on April 8th at home against Visalia, he allowed just four hits and no walks over four innings, striking out seven in a no-decision. Dryden was a 17th-round selection by the Giants in the 2024 draft out of Whitworth College in Spokane, Washington.
