Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Logan Allen** to the mound tonight, looking to snap their 2G losing streak. Iowa will counter with RHP **Paul Campbell**. Columbus is 7-4 (.636) versus right handers this year. Campbell has never pitched against Columbus in his career, having appeared in only 5G in Triple-A, all with Jacksonville from 2021-22 (11G in affiliated ball since).

vs. the Cubs

Since a 5G win streak against Iowa from 5/12-6/14/24, the Clippers are 13-14 opposing the I-Cubs (28-21 in the last 49 matchups). In Columbus, the Clippers are 24-21 all time (2-0-5 in 6G series, 0-2-0 in other series). Individually, **CJ Kayfus** has 5HR and 14RBI in 16G against Iowa in his career, while **Nolan Jones** has hit .309 (30x97) with 9HR and 29RBI in 27G.

Crazy Eights

Columbus surrendered eight runs in last night's loss, marking the fourth time allowing eight in the last week (seventh game of 8+ this season, most in the IL). Since 4/2, the Clippers have allowed 78 runs in 11G, 10 more than all other teams with 11G played (Rochester has allowed 77 runs in 12G). In those 11G, the staff has allowed at least five runs on 10 occasions, while notching a shutout in the other.

Second to None

The Clippers scored in the 1st last night, embiggening the opening frame season total to 17, then they went scoreless in the 2nd for the 11th game in a row (two in the 2nd inning all year: single tallies on 3/31 and 4/1). Columbus was also scoreless from the 4th-6th, as they have scored only a trio of runs in the middle third of the last 8G. The Clippers average 5.3 runs per game (3.0 from the 1st, 8th and 9th).

Modest Streak

Travis Bazzana doubled last night to give him a 4G hit streak since 4/10 (6x14, 3XBH; was 2x18 with 0XBH in 4G prior). He has also drawn 3BB in the last 4G, but has been plated only 33% of the time reaching base safely in that stretch (all three runs scored on 4/11 at Worcester). Bazzana has not homered since 9/7/25 (69AB) and has only 3RBI on the season (3x17 with runners in scoring position).

First at First

CJ Kayfus will get the start at 1B tonight (141st start at 1B in minor league career, 71% of minor league starts), following a series of fill-ins to start the season (**Kody Huff**- 6GS, **Dayan Frias**- 4GS, **Dom Nunez**- 3GS and **Juan Brito**-2GS have combined for 109 starts at 1B in 1,936 career games, 5.6%). He was 2x4 last night, but is hitting just .212 (7x33) in his last 9G at Triple-A (since 7/20/25).

Gearing Up

Kahli Watson snapped a 19AB hitless streak on Saturday, going 3x4 with a triple and a pair of homers (second career 2HR game, 6/18/25 with Akron), and followed up with a double last night (+112 in SLG over last 2G, had 1XBH in first 12G). Watson did not draw a walk last night for only the third time all season (7th in the IL with 14BB), but had 2K (4th with 22K; only IL player in top ten of BB and K).

Slump Town

Stuart Fairchild is only 4x27 (.148) in 8G since going 4x4 on 4/3 vs. Indianapolis, having gone hitless in each of his last 16AB. **Milan Tolentino** is just 6x33 (.182) in his last 10G since doubling twice on 4/2 vs. Indianapolis. **Dayan Frias** is 1x13 (.077) in 4G since a 3x4 effort at Worcester on 4/8 (was 2x20 in 7G prior). As a team, the Clippers are hitting .215 in the last 8G (2-6; .278 in first 8G, 6-2).

Eye is for Ingle

Cooper Ingle has drawn 12BB in his first 32PA (38%) this season, following a Triple-A debut that saw 21BB in 107PA (20%) last season. Though Ingle has hit only .238 (24x101) in his Columbus career, he has a beefy .439OBP and a +12 differential in the walk to strikeout department (33 to 21). Since his Triple-A debut on 8/13/25, his 33BB are tied for 4th in the IL (missed last 5G, lower body).

No Middle Ground

The bullpen gave up 5ER last night (5.1IP), following four straight outings with 1ER or fewer to end the Worcester series (15.0IP, 3ER). In the 6G prior to the hot streak, Clipper relievers gave up at least 5ER in five instances, while allowing 1ER once. The 5G before that saw a pair of 4ER games against a trio of 0ER efforts. The bullpen has yet to post a 2ER or 3ER game this year (5.71ERA ranks 19th).

This Date in Clipper History

4/15/1991

The Clippers outlasted the Tides in 16 innings at Cooper Stadium, winning 5-4. Tidewater plated a run in the top of the 12th before the Clippers answered in the bottom half. Then, in the 13th inning, the Clippers snuffed out a Tide rally with a triple play (**Andy Stankiewicz to Dave Sax**). The game would end following a **Jim Walewander** sac fly, 5:13 after the first pitch had been thrown.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,409 to 1,355).

Challenging Times

The Clippers were 132-174 (.431, 2nd worst in the IL) in pitch reviews last season, with batters going 79-117 (.403) and pitchers/catchers going 53-57 (.482). They ran out of challenges in 57G and did not challenge in 13G.

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus was 5-5 in extra innings last season, following a 9-loss campaign in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-33 when playing past regulation (.602, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-16 at home (.619, but 4-6 in last 10G). Of the 83G to require extra play, 66 have needed only one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Return of the Defense

The Clippers were 1st in the IL in defense (.985), a season after turning in their worst fielding percentage (.978) since 2009. They had only two series with more than 5E (8/26-8/31 at Louisville, 9/17-9/21 vs. Omaha), topping out at 3E in a game twice and playing flawlessly 86 times on the year (44-42, .512; 16G errorless streak from 6/20-7/8, longest in the IL over the last 20 years). Behind the plate, Clipper catchers did not have a passed ball from 9/22/24-5/28/25 (53G; 3,949 pitches with men on base between).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Milan Tolentino moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 4/7 at Worcester and those runners came around to tie the game in an eventual win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-22 (.792) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-1 (.500, blew 7-run lead in loss) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 394-414 (.488), 364-368 with Columbus (.497).

Workhorse

Allen is averaging 83.5 pitches per start through the early going, over 10 pitches more than the next closest Clipper (**Trenton Denholm**, 72.3). Averaging almost 93 pitches per outing in the Majors last season, Allen hit triple digits six times (Columbus has not had a pitcher reach 100 since **Peyton Battenfield** on 9/2/22, 480G ago)

2026 Spring Training:

Allen pitched four times for Cleveland during spring training, going 0-2 with an 18.00ERA (10.0IP, 25H, 20R, 20ER, 8BB, 9K). He was optioned to Columbus on 3/22, but did not join the team until 3/31.

Last Season:

Pitched the entire season with Cleveland... after season opening loss at San Diego on 4/1 (5.1IP, 7H, 4R, 4ER, 5BB, 1K), went 1-0 with a 0.56ERA (16.0IP, 1ER) in next 3GS (4/9-4/20), before loss vs. Boston on 4/27 (4.1IP, 9H, 7R, 7ER, 3BB, 2K)... won with a scoreless start on 5/13 vs. Milwaukee (6.0IP, 3H, 1BB, 6K) and earned a win in a relief outing on 5/31 vs. Los Angeles (1.0IP, 2K)... went 3-3 with a 3.34ERA (35.0IP, 13ER) in 6GS (4QS) prior to the All-Star Break (6/11-7/11)... lost a pair out of the Break before winning vs. Colorado on 7/29 (7.0IP, 8H, 2R, 2ER, 1BB, 3K)... struggled over 5GS from 8/12-9/4, turning in a 6.66ERA (25.2IP, 19ER)... won a scoreless start on 9/20 at Minnesota, following a nine-day layoff (8.0IP, 4H, 1BB, 7K)... did not pitch in the AL Playoffs.
