**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the third in a six-game series at the Lake County Captains, High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, the third of 18 meetings between the two ballclubs this year. Last year, the Nuts finished 9-15 vs. the Captains, going 2-9 in Eastlake and 7-8 at home... but two games into this series, the Lugnuts already have won twice at Classic Auto Group Park.

On the Air: Logan Potosky and Tyler Danburg delivers the call via Bally Live and MiLB TV, while Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa are on StreamGuys.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 6, Captains 1. Brayan Buelvas homered for a second straight game, Henry Bolte tripled and homered, Euribiel Ángeles went 3-for-3 with a walk and a pair of RBI singles, and the Nuts won a matinee in Eastlake.

On Deck: The next two days are all 6:35 p.m. starts followed by a 1:05 series finale on Sunday. Then the Lugnuts return to Michigan's state capital for a 12-game, 13-day homestand against the Dayton Dragons and South Bend Cubs.

### Lug•Notes

**Transaction:** Entering this series, the Lugnuts received infielder **Elvis Rijo** from Extended Spring Training. The Nuts had added fellow infielder **Jose Escorche** over the weekend, replacing **T.J. Schofield-Sam.** When he sees action, Rijo will become the 938th all-time Lugnut. He is one of 11 international free agents on the active roster.

Streaking: Colby Halter's 10-game on-base streak ended yesterday with an 0-for-5 showing, while Will Simpson went 2-for-2 with a walk and a sacrifice fly to extend his on-base streak to 10 games.

**Powering On:** The Lugs had hit only two home runs in their first nine games before knocking five homers in the first two games of this series – three in the opener and two yesterday.

Leaderboard: Brayan Buelvas is tied for 1st in runs scored (10) and tied for 5th in walks (9); Will Simpson is 1st in walks (12), 3rd in on-base percentage (.524), tied for 4th in RBIs (10), 5th in OPS (1.076), 7th in slugging (.552) and 8th in batting average (.345); James González is 2nd in ERA (0.79), 3rd in WHIP (0.71) and 4th in innings (11 1/3); and Hunter Breault is tied for 2nd in wins (2).

A Grand Start: On April 3, first baseman Will Simpson crushed a grand slam (as well as a solo shot) in an 18-0 victory over Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown. Ten days later, Simpson launched a grand slam against the Great Lakes Loons in an 8-5 loss.

**EMU to The Show:** 2021 Lansing super utilityman **Max Schuemann** made his Major League debut last Friday as a pinch-runner for the Oakland A's, scoring the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th on an RBI single from **Lawrence Butler** (2021-22 Lugnut), as the A's walked off the Nationals, 2-1. Schuemann is the 185th all-time Lugnut to reach the Majors and the first this year.

Come Together: The Lugnuts' roster includes players representing 10 states, Puerto Rico, and five countries: Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Panama and Venezuela.

**Prospecting:** The Nuts' Opening Day roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 12) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. He spent the 2023 season with Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .257/.356/.421 in 112 games, collecting 17 doubles, five triples, 14 home runs and 32 stolen bases. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/ .367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

## **Today in Lugnuts History**

2014: Kendall Graveman, who would eventually go from Lansing on Opening Day to Toronto by the end of the season, pitched 8 1/3 no-hit innings at Beloit before No. 9 hitting catcher Jose Chavez reached on an iffy infield single to shortstop. Griffin Murphy relieved Graveman and allowed a single to Chih Fang Pan before wrapping up a 5-0 victory with a double play, ending a seven-game losing streak.

2019: The Golden Cycle. Ryan Gold went 4-for-5 with a first-inning single, a third-inning two-run triple, a fourth-inning RBI groundout, a sixthinning grand slam, and - after Dayton third baseman Juan Martinez dropped a foul pop - an eighth-inning double, becoming the seventh Lugnut to hit for the cycle in franchise history in a 12-4 victory over the Dragons at Cooley Law School Stadium.

**Profile** 

 **Home Cooking:** Also from Tucson: Alex Verdugo, four-time All-Star Ian Kinsler, two-time All-Star J.J. Hardy, Cardinals All-Star catcher Tom Pagnozzi and Ron Hassey... in all, Tucson ranks second behind Phoenix in producing Major Leaguers from the Grand Canyon State.

**Glory Days:** Boasting a 96 mph fastball, Dicochea was highly regarded coming out of Sahuarita High School, ranked the No. 1 prep prospect in Arizona by Baseball America entering the 2019 draft... twirled a no-hitter in the state semifinals... signed for \$400,000... signing scout: Scott Cousins... signed away from commitment to University of Arizona... senior year stats: 1.30 ERA, 54 IP, 24 H, 10 ER, 11 BB, 86 K... in addition to pitching, also starred at shortstop.

**Minor League Path:** Dicochea opened his professional career in the 2019 Arizona League after signing, but his 2021 campaign was halted in Single-A Stockton due to injury on June 6 after only six appearances, five starts... returned from Tommy John surgery on August 12, 2022, and made two appearances in the Arizona Complex League before returning to Stockton on August 26, 2022... finished the year with three appearances for the Ports.

**Bagels in April:** Opened 2023 as the Ports' No. 4 starter, firing four scoreless innings at Fresno on April 11... that was the start of three consecutive scoreless outings to begin the year, finishing April with 13 2/3 scoreless innings... didn't allow first run until May 3 vs. Fresno, entering in relief in the fifth inning and allowing two runs in the fifth and two more in the seventh in a 5-4 Ports win... in total with Stockton, posted a 2.42 ERA with a .132 average against in five road starts (22 1/3 IP) compared to 4.24 ERA, .200 avg. in four home appearances (17 IP)... lefties hit .111/.243/.175 compared to righties' .205/.279/.308... base stealers went 2-for-2.

Rave Reviews: Dicochea was promoted from Single-A Stockton to Lansing on June 13, 2023, to replace Jack Perkins, who was transferred up to Double-A Midland... coincidentally, an article about Dicochea had just been written by MLB.com A's beat writer Martín Gallegos a day earlier, quoting A's GM David Forst in including Dicochea's name among the top pitching prospects in the system (Royber Salinas, Gunnar Hoglund, J.T. Ginn and Joey Estes). Wrote Gallegos about Dicochea, "Dicochea, an eighth-round selection by the A's in the 2019 MLB Draft out of Sahuarita (Ariz.) High School, ranks just outside Oakland's Top 30 Prospects list. But his inclusion in that group from Forst speaks volumes about how highly he is viewed. In nine games (seven starts) for Single-A Stockton this season, Dicochea holds a 3.20 ERA with 47 strikeouts against 17 walks in 39 1/3 innings. He has held opposing batters to a .163 average, which ranks lowest among all California League pitchers with at least 30 innings pitched. Dicochea's development hit a snag early in his pro career after he underwent Tommy John surgery in 2021. Since his return from injury, the 22-year-old right-hander is taking a big step forward this season, showing off a fastball that consistently hits 95 mph along with a solid slider and a changeup he's recently added to his mix. A's assistant general manager and director of player personnel Billy Owens added, "He's off to a promising start. Averaging well over a strikeout per inning. Overall, his command has taken a step forward. He's definitely an interesting arm on the horizon.'

**In a Nutshell:** Opens the season in a tandem with Jose Dicochea, relieving Dicochea the second day of the season, April 6 at Dayton, before receiving his first start of the year, April 13 vs. Great Lakes... returns to the bullpen today.

**Home Cooking:** Born in Barquisimeto in the state of Lara, where former Lugnut and current Diamondbacks catcher Gabby Moreno was also born... cousin is Carlos "Cookie" Carrasco, in his 15th year in the Major Leagues and a current member of the Cleveland Guardians rotation; Carlos Carrasco led the Majors in victories (18) in 2017 and finished 4th in A.L. Cy Young voting.
