JACKSONVILLE DROPS SERIES OPENER TO NORFOLK

The Jumbo Shrimp hit three home runs but fell 9-5 in Tuesday's series opener to the Tides. After Norfolk plated two runs in the first, Jacksonville scored on a balk in the first before **Maximo Acosta** went deep to tie the score in the second. A **Joe Mack** RBI double put the Shrimp ahead in the third, but a pair of Tides three-run homers - one from **Samuel Basallo** in the fourth and another from **TT Bowens** in the fifth - put Norfolk ahead for good. **Matt Mervis** and **Jacob Berry** went deep in the seventh to set things at 9-5.

WHEN YOU'RE HOT, YOU'RE HOT

Jacksonville has now won 16 of their last 24 games, the seventh-best such record in Triple-A since this stretch began on June 10. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp have outscored their opponents by a whopping 137-96 (+41) margin. The club has yielded the the third-fewest runs (96) in Triple-A while also ranking tied for second in fewest hits allowed (179), third in ERA (3.79) and fourth in BAA (.232). Offensively, Jacksonville ranks first in home runs (43), third in slugging (.498), tied for fourth in stolen bases (40), fifth in OPS (.845), 10th in average (.269), 11th in hits (220) and 12th in average (.270).

MARSEE-SAW

Heading into play on June 8, **Jakob Marsee** was hitting just .193 with a .651 OPS. Since that point, the Allen Park, Mich., native has registered hits in 20 of his 24 starts, including 11 contests with multiple hits. During this stretch, Marsee is 33-for-96 (.344/.413/.729/1.142 at the plate with six doubles, two triples, nine home runs, 19 RBIs, 12 walks and 19 runs scored. On the season, Marsee leads the IL in steals (40) and walks (53) while sharing the league lead in triples (5). He also ranks tied for 17th in home runs (12) and tied for 24th in hits (70).

BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry mustered just a .126 batting average and .452 OPS with 35 strikeouts through his first 30 games on the season. The former LSU Tiger has completely changed around his season since that point. Over his last 39 games, Berry has earned more walks (20) than strikeouts (19) while going 38-for-117 (.325/.429/.530/.959) at the plate with 10 doubles, one triple, four home runs, 21 RBIs and 23 runs.

FOUR SCORE AND SEVEN YEARS AGO

Jacksonville lost 9-5 to Norfolk on Tuesday. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 20 of their last 24 games (83.3 percent), including 17 contests with five tallies or more. Prior to this stretch, Jacksonville had plated four runs or more in just 30 of their first 63 games (47.6 percent). Perhaps the biggest reason for the increase in runs scored has been home runs; the Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A with 43 home runs over the last 24 games. They hit just 52 bombs over the first 63 games of the season, tied for 26th in Triple-A.

THE MORE, THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 87 games this season, the Shrimp have already used 25 different starting pitchers. Of the three lid-lifters to register double-digit starts for Jacksonville in 2025, only one is still in the rotation (**Adam Mazur**). **Freddy Tarnok** is now a member of the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen while **Robinson Piña** is a member of the Toronto Blue Jays' organization. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 334.2 innings (3.8 per start) this season, the third-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.74 starters' ERA ranks third at the level.

MACKTION

In 30 games from May 10-June 21, **Joe Mack** went just 18-for-113 (.159) at the plate, totaling just a .428 OPS. The East Amherst, N.Y., native has been on an absolute tear over his last 12 games, however. During this stretch, Mack is a whopping 21-for-49 (.429/.451/.898/1.349) with five doubles, six home runs, 11 RBIs, two walks and 11 runs scored. Mack is also the first Jumbo Shrimp to be selected for the MLB All-Star Futures Game since right-handed pitcher **Sixto Sánchez** in 2019.

SHRIMP BITES

At 53-34 (.609), Jacksonville is off to its best start since the 2006 Jacksonville Suns started 56-31 (.646). That team finished 86-54 (.614)... **Graham Pauley** is slashing .300/.388/.614/1.002 (4 2B, 6 HR, 12 RBIs, 12 R) in his last 18 games.

ABOUT ADAM

-Laskey was originally selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 31st round in the 2016 MLB Draft. He ultimately didn't sign with the Giants and committed to play baseball at Duke. He had scholarship offers from Notre Dame, Wake Forest and Duke. He also drew heavy recruiting interest from Virginia Tech, Boston College, the University of Miami, Stanford, St. Johns and Michigan.

-Didn't garner attention until his summer in the Cape Cod League. Pitched for Falmouth, posted a 1.18 ERA in 30.1 innings and won Whitehouse Outstanding Pitcher Award.

-Pitched three seasons at Duke, had ERAs over five during his first two seasons. His last year, he made only six appearances but was selected in the 19th round by the Chicago Cubs.

-After reaching as high as Double-A Tennessee, Laskey was selected by the Marlins in the minor league phase of the 2023 Rule 5 draft.

2025 SEASON

-Tossed immaculate inning on April 11, 2025 for the Blue Wahoos.

-Made 11 appearances, 10 starts with Double-A Pensacola. Totaled 50 strikeouts in 52.2 innings. Allowed 26 R, 22 ER for a 3.76 ERA, while posting a 2-5 record.

-Posted a 12.0 scoreless innings streak back in April.

2024 SEASON

-Spent his first full season in the Marlins organization. Went 6-2 in 31 appearances, six starts.

-Totaled 81.1 innings, allowing 28 R, 28 ER for a 3.10 ERA. Laskey held opponents to a .217 batting average against (63 hits allowed) and striking out 76 against 20 walks.

2023 SEASON

-Laskey started the season with High-A South Bend. In 33 appearances out of the bullpen, he allowed 22 runs, 17 earned runs for a 3.14 ERA. He posted a 4-1 record and held opponents to a .242 batting average against.

-Lettered one season in high school in soccer, led team to state championship.

-Was a former volunteer assistant at the Miracle League of the Triangle.
