FRISCO FALLS IN EXTRAS, 7-3:

In their first extra-inning game of the season, the Frisco RoughRiders fell to the San Antonio Missions Thursday night, 7-3, in ten innings. **Blaine Crim** homered to give Frisco a 3-2 lead, but the Missions answered with the tying run in the seventh to force an extra frame. Crim's home run was his tenth of the season to lead all Riders (23-19) batters this season. It's the second-consecutive game with a home run for Crim and his eighth of the month after going deep in game two of Wednesday's doubleheader. Both teams were held scoreless in the eighth and ninth before San Antonio (22-20) plated four in the top of the tenth inning, a deficit too tall for Frisco to answer. Missions reliever Angel Felipe (3-0) held the Riders hitless in his two innings, striking out four of his six outs recorded. In his eighth start of the year, Riders starter **Jack Leiter** gave up two runs in his first inning but held San Antonio hitless in his final four frames. Leiter exited with five strikeouts and one walk, despite the Riders trailing 2-0. The RoughRiders' first run came in the bottom of the fifth on a Trey Hair sacrifice fly to score **David Garcia**, who began the effort with a one-out double, cutting the Missions' lead to 2-1. Crim homered in the following inning to give the Riders their only lead into the seventh, 3-2. Riders reliever **Seth Nordlin** relieved Leiter for the following four outs, giving up the tying run on four hits in the sixth and into the seventh inning. Frisco turned to reliever Fer Ozuna with two on and one out, needing one pitch to force San Antonio to roll over a double play and end the scoring threat. **Chase Lee** (1-1) gave up his first earned runs of the season Thursday night, as he was tasked with staving the Missions away in the 10th. Lee produced the first two outs before the next four Missions batters reached, forcing Lee out of the tenth inning. **Kevin Gowdy** delivered the final out with a punch out.

I'LL HAVE THE REGULATION, PLEASE:

After 41 games in which the Riders did not play extra baseball, Frisco finally played their first extra innings game on Thursday against San Antonio, falling 7-3 in 10 innings. The 41-game drought was the longest to start a season in franchise history (average 11.4 games before playing the first extra-inning game).

CRIM CRUSH:

Blaine Crim has heated up as the season has shifted into late May. Over his last 22 games, Crim is hitting .337 (28-for-83)/.400/.723 with five doubles, nine home runs and 23 RBIs. Crim is also on a seven-game hitting streak, hitting .444 (12-for-27) with three home runs and nine RBIs. Crim led the Riders organization in 2021 with 29 home runs and he is atop the org again this season with 10 so far in 2022. His eight homers in May are tied for the most in the Texas League and the 8th-most in Minor League Baseball.

DURAN, DURAN: DOUBLE TROUBLE

Riders infielder **Ezequiel Duran** leads all of Minor League Baseball in doubles with 18. After a monster Sunday in Tulsa on May 15th, going four-for-four with two doubles, two home runs, five runs scored (tying a franchise record) and five RBIs, Duran is now hitting .392 (29-for-74)/.434/.784 over his last 19 games with nine doubles, one triple, six home runs, 20 RBIs and one steal. The Rangers No. 4 prospect by MLB.com has a .926 OPS this season now. In May, Duran is fourth in the Texas League in OPS (1.143) and first in extra-base hits (16).

AYYY, IT'S THE FOSC:

Riders infielder **Justin Foscue** has caught fire for Frisco. After starting in Extended Spring Training because of back tightness, he joined the club on April 19th. Foscue went 1-for-7 in his first two games, but in his last 24, the former Mississippi State Bulldog has hit .303 (27-for-89)/.426/.539 with 13 doubles, a triple, two home runs, 16 RBIs, 18 walks and 14 runs. He snapped a 20-game on base streak on Wednesday, where he owned a .462 OBP and a 1.016 OPS. He was the first RoughRiders player since 2017 (**Scott Heineman**, 25 games) with an on-base streak of 20 games or longer. The longest streak in franchise history is 50 games in 2012 by **Jurickson Profar**.

JONNY ON THE SPOT:

Riders infielder **Jonny Ornelas** has been tearing the cover off of the baseball in recent days. Ornelas has batted .358 (54-for-151)/.394/.490/.884 in his last 36 games and .369 (45-for-122) with .941 OPS over his last 29 games. He has eight games with at least three hits this season to lead the club. Ornelas is also the youngest player on the Riders and the 21-year-old is the 10th-youngest in the Texas League. Ornelas owns a .346 average on the season, which is first in the Texas League, third in Double-A, the best in the Texas Rangers organization and 12th in MiLB. Ornelas owns 55 hits, the most in the Texas League and third in MiLB.

REARVIEW MIRRORS:

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 996 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well.

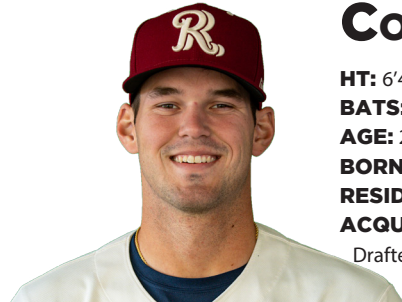

ABOUT COLE

-Selected by the Rangers with the 30th overall pick in the 2016 draft. Highest high school lefty taken by the Rangers since they took Matt Purke with the 14th overall pick in 2009 (Purke did not sign). Before that, Kasey Kiker, who was selected with the 12th-overall pick in 2006 was the highest drafted high school lefty by Texas.

-Originally committed to Florida State University before being drafted, Ragans was ranked as the 12th-best high school pitcher in the draft and the 6th-best left hander by *Baseball America*.

-At North Florida Christian High School, was 9-2 as a senior with a 0.90 ERA. He struck out 104 batters over 90.0 innings while holding opponents to a .122 batting average.

-Ragans studied and modeled his game after Cole Hamels. After being drafted by the Rangers, Hamels, who was a member of the Rangers at the time, took Ragans under his wing. He shadowed him for an entire day, following him around during 2017 Spring Training and learned everything he could from him. Most of all, he learned about what it took on the mental side to be a starting pitcher. When he was first promoted to Frisco in July of 2021, Hamels happened to be throwing a bullpen for scouts at Riders Field and Ragans had the opportunity to reconnect with the veteran lefty.

-Ragans was selected to play in the 2021 All-Star Futures Game in Denver, along with teammate RHP Cole Winn. After receiving that news, he was informed a few days later that he would join the RoughRiders and be promoted to Double-A right after the game. He called it, "an unbelievable moment given what he had been through." He enjoyed the emotional moment with his wife over the phone.

2022 SEASON

-Struck out seven over 3.1 innings in 2022 debut on April 10th.

-Became first Riders starter to record an out in the sixth inning on May 1st, going 6.1 IP against Midland in his first victory of the year.

-Threw first quality start of the season on May 8th against Arkansas, striking out a season-best nine over his six shutout innings. It was his first six-inning shutout performance since 2017 and his 96 pitches were the most in the Rangers minors to that point in the season.

2021 SEASON

-Started the season with High-A Hickory, going 1-1 with a 2.50 ERA over his last four starts (18.0 IP, 14 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 6 BB, 21 K) before being promoted to Double-A Frisco.

-Made Double-A debut in relief on July 18th against Springfield, allowing three runs over two innings of work.

2020 SEASON

-Made return from injury in Fall Developmental League, throwing 13.0 innings, striking out 20 while walking eight. Owned a 38 percent strikeout rate.

2019 SEASON

-Missed season due to second "Tommy John" surgery.

2018 SEASON

-Missed season due to first "Tommy John" surgery.

2017 SEASON

-Dominated Short-Season Low-A Spokane, leading the league with 87 strikeouts, and was tabbed as the No. 1 prospect in the Northwest League by *Baseball America*.

-Finished the season as the No. 6 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

2016 SEASON

-Struck out nine batters over 7.2 innings in pro debut.

-Finished the season as the No.5 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.
