SPRINGDALE, AR — For the second straight game, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals kept the Arkansas Travelers off the scoreboard, with a 4-0 shutout win Sunday afternoon to secure a series split and climb back to .500.

- Anthony Veneziano twirled another brilliant outing, as the left-hander threw 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing
 just three hits and two walks while striking out six. his third straight start of six innings or more.
- Jake Brentz followed Veneziano, pitching a scoreless seventh as the start of his Major League rehab assignment, then Yefri Del Rosario and Andres Sotillet each pitched scoreless innings to finish off the game.
- After erasing a leadoff singe in the first inning with a double play, Veneziano did not put another run on until
 there were two outs in the fourth inning. From the fifth through the end of the eighth, he Brentz and Del Rosairo
 combined to retire 10 in a row, as the Naturals' pitching staff held the Travelers scoreless for the final 19 innings
 of the week
- Northwest Arkansas' offense gave Veneziano early run support, as the team took a 1-0 lead in the first inning.
 Maikel Garcia walked and stole second to lead off the inning, moved to third on a Tucker Bradley single and scored on a fielder's choice off the bat of Logan Porter.
- Three more runs scored in the third inning, as Porter doubled, Seuly Matias was hit by a pitch and they both scored on a two-run double from John Rave. Rave then scored moments later on a single from Tyler Cropley, the final run of the afternoon
- Cropley reached base in all four of his trips to the plate, also being hit by a pitch three times, tying a Naturals
 record. Bradley and Brhet Bewley each had two hits, with Bewley drawing a walk as well.

This Day in Naturals History

The Naturals are 5-7 all-time when playing on June 21

On June 21, 2018, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals handily beat the Tulsa Drillers, 17-3 at ONEOK Field. Second baseman Nicky Lopez led the charge, hitting for the first (and only) cycle in Naturals history, as he went 5-for-6 from the leadoff spot, with four runs scored and two driven in. Lopez singled to cap an 8-pitch at-bat in the first inning, doubled in the third, tripled in a run in the fourth and homering in the sixth inning, completing the cycle in order in his first four trips to the plate. He added a single for good measure in the seventh inning and later came around to score as the Naturals scored at least two runs in the 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th innings. Seven Naturals batters recorded hits, while seven scored at least two runs and eight different Naturals hitters drove in a run, including a team-best four from catcher Nick Dini in a 3-for-4 day at the plate with a pair of homers.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 17 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 8 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Ouad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi**. Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Jake Means, Noah Murdock, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter and John Rave.

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 25-2, while when scoring six runs or less, just 6-29.
- The Naturals are 19-6 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 12-25.
- The Naturals are 20-8 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 2-23 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 20-10, whereas 11-21 when the opponent scores first.

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 3-13 in one-run games this season, meaning 13 of their 31 losses this season have been decided by just one run.

- Nine of the Naturals' last 17 losses have been by just a run, as well as four of seven losses to the Travelers this season.
- The Naturals have had the winning run at the plate in six losses this season (all one-run losses) and had the tying run at the plate or on base in 13 losses this season (including 10 of their one-run losses).

RIGHT WHERE THEY BELONG

The Northwest Arkansas Naturals have generally hovered around .500 for most of the season, with the win Sunday bringing the team back to .500 with a 31-31 record ... the Naturals have been at or within a game of .500 after 39 of 62 games this season.

- The team has peaked at two games above .500, at a 15 13 record after the game May 10, but with a low-point of four games under .500 on two
- After 14 of 62 games this season, the Naturals have ended the day with an even .500 record.
- After 25 of 62 games this season, the Naturals have ended the day within a game of .500, either one game over or under.

Yo, You Wanna See Some Real Speed?

Through 62 games, the Naturals have stolen 87 bases in 103 attempts (average 1.40 steals/game, 84.47% success rate).

- 87 steals ranks third in the Texas League, fifth in Double-A and 22nd in the Minors.
- Maikel Garcia's 20 steals (in 22 attempts) ranks fourth in the Texas League and tied eighth in all of Double-A.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 12 times, meaning 24 of 87 steals this year (27.6%) have come on a double-steal.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 40 of 62 games this season, including 23 games with two or more steals, with three occasions where the team has stolen five bases, with perfect 5-for-5 steal efforts as a club on 5/13 vs. Wichita and 5/21 @ Arkansas.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop Maikel Garcia has reached base in 52 of the 59 games he has played in this season, reaching base multiple times on 35 occasions, including a team-best 20 multi-hit games.

- In 279 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 104 times (71 hits +35 walks), for a .381 on-base percentage.
- Garcia has walked 35 times and struck out 46 times, a 0.76 K/BB rate.
- The shortstop places among the Texas League leaders in several categories, ranking tied third in hits (71), fourth in doubles (18) and steals (20) and tied eighth in runs scored (45) ... he ranks among the Double-A leaders in hits (tied fifth), doubles (tied sixth), steals (tied sixth) and runs scored
- His 14-game hitting streak between April 27 and May 12 is the longest on the Naturals this year, tied for the 15th-longest in club history and tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in those 14 games, he hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS.

Pushin P(orter)

Catcher **Logan Porter** has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- · Among full-season Minor League hitters, Porter ranks third in on-base percentage (.468) he places second among Double-A hitters in OBP and seventh in batting average (.329) OPS (1.002) ... in the Texas League, he is second in OBP, fifth in OPS, sixth in batting average and ninth in slugging percentage (.534).
- Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter has the highest on-base percentage and OPS, is tied with teammate Tyler Gentry for the highest batting average and ranks third in slugging percentage behind Omaha's Vinnie Pasquantino (.586) and Gentry (.537).
- Porter has reached base in 41 of 44 games he's played this season, with hits in 30 of 44 and 16 multi-hit games, nine of which came in May.
- In the month of June, Porter is hitting .359 (14-for-39) with three home runs and eight runs batted in, along with a 1.211 OPS. His batting average this month ranks seventh in the Texas League, while his OPS ranks as the second-highest.
- In the month of May, Porter hit .343 (24-for-70) with a team-best 1.017 OPS and he had drove in 13 runs with 11 walks.

Tyler, the Creator (Of Runs)

Since joining the Naturals at the start of last week from High-A Quad Cities, outfielder Tyler Gentry has not skipped a beat from his hot start with the River Bandits.

- Through his first five games with the Naturals, Gentry is hitting .286 (6-for-21) with four extra base hits (two doubles, two home runs) and five runs batted in ... his five RBI last week were tied for the team lead.
- Gentry ranks as one of best hitters in the Royals' system this season, tied with Logan porter for the highest batting average (.329), while second in on-base percentage (.420), slugging percentage (.537) and OPS (.957).
- While he played in just 10 games in April, the 2020 Draft Pick had a ridiculous start to the season, hitting .471 (16-for-34) with five extrabase hits and seven runs batted in for Quad Cities ... he had hits in his last seven games with the River Bandits before being promoted to Northwest Arkansas, each of his first seven games in the month of June.

Pitchers of the Month (1)

May: LHP Drew Parrish ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

- April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.
- May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

Pitchers of the Week (3)

- May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five
- May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.
- June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.

#6 ABRAHAM NÚÑEZ • HITTING COACH

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).
- Núñez played for parts of 12 seasons in the Majors with the Pirates (1997-2004), Cardinals (2005), Phillies (2006-2007) and Mets (2008). A switch-hitter, he owns a career average of .242 as a utility infielder in the big leagues, primarily playing third base, but could play all four infield positions.
- His best season came in 2005 when he batted .285 in 139 games for the National League Champion St. Louis Cardinals.
- Lifetime .346 (9-for-28) hitter in the postseason, including the 2005 National League Championship Series with St. Louis when he hit .385, though did not play in the World Series.
- Born in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, he now resides in Hudson, Massachusetts.



#27 CHRISTIAN COLON - Assistant HITTING COACH

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- · Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



#23 MIKE JIRSCHELE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.
- Jirschele previously managed the Triple-A Omaha franchise for 11 seasons (2003-13), leading the team to four division titles, three-straight trips to the Pacific Coast League championship round (2011-13), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and a Triple-A Championship in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field.
- Prior to his 11-year stint with Omaha, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years (1998-2002), while he held managerial positions with Omaha (1995-97), Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021.
- He was slated to serve in that role with Wilmington in 2020 and previously filled those roles with Lexington in 2019, Burlington from 2017-18 and with Surprise in 2016.
- Accola graduated from the University of Central Missouri in 2014 and previously held an athletic training internship with the Denver Broncos in 2013.
