By the Numbers

21 The Captains lead the MWL and rank 2nd in High-A with 21 home runs this season. Lake County has 1 HR so far this series, a solo shot from OF Esteban González on Tuesday night.

.154 RHP Dylan DeLucia, tonight's expected Captains piggyback pitcher, has held Loons hitters to a .154 AVG in 3 career appearances against Great Lakes across 2024 and 2025.

+4 Lake County has a +4 run differential so far this season, outscoring opponents 90-86 through 16 games. The Captains are 1 of just 2 Midwest League East teams with a positive run differential this year (West Michigan, +50).

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: Great Lakes scored 7 of its 9 runs with a 3-run home run and a grand slam in a 9-3 Captains defeat on Tuesday night at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake.

ROSARIO RAKES: RF Alfonsin Rosario, MLB Pipeline's No. 25 Cleveland prospect, recorded a single in the bottom of the 1st inning to extend his hitting streak to 11 games. The 20-year-old is batting .341 with 15 H, 4 2B, 3 HR, 11 RBI, 4 BB, 4 SB, a .636 SLG, and a 1.032 OPS during this span.

GONZÁLEZ GOES YARD: OF Esteban González recorded the Captains' lone RBI with a 2-out solo home run in the bottom of the 6th inning, his 3rd homer of the season. The 22-year-old has now homered in 2 of his last 3 games.

PÉREZ'S PERFECT RELIEF: LHP Steven Pérez (ND) pitched 3 perfect innings of relief out of the Lake County bullpen, throwing 3 strikeouts. The southpaw is off to an impressive start in his first 5 appearances of the season, recording a 1.04 ERA, 0.46 WHIP, .107 opposing AVG, and 12 strikeouts to just 1 walk across 8.2 innings of work.

CAPTAINS SWIPE SEVEN: The Captains recorded 7 stolen bases as a team, their most in a game so far this season. CF Jaison Chourio, MLB Pipeline's No. 3 Cleveland and No. 56 MLB prospect, swiped 3 bags, while SS Jose Devers and RF Alfonsin Rosario, MLB Pipeline's No. 25 Cleveland prospect, each tallied 2 stolen bases for Lake County.

DEFEND THE 'SHIP: This season, the Captains are looking to win back-to-back Midwest League Championships. Lake County will look to record the 7th instance of a franchise winning consecutive MWL titles.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

JOSE'S HOT START: After winning the 2024 Midwest League Championship with Lake County, SS Jose Devers has excelled early to begin the 2025 campaign. The Samana, DR native leads the Midwest League with 5 HR, 12 XBH, and 7 2B (tied), while also ranking top-10 in: TB (39, 2nd), SLG (.629, 3rd), OPS (.986, 8th), RBI (12, T-9th), and H (17, T-9th). After hitting 7 home runs in 102 games with the Captains last year, Devers already has 5 homers in just 15 games this season.

ADVINCULA'S AT IT AGAIN: After playing a significant part in the Captains' 2024 Midwest League Championship run, OF Jonah Advincula is off to a strong start in 2025. The 2023 8th-round pick out of Washington State ranks 3rd in the Midwest League with a .371 AVG, while also ranking top-10 in OBP (.489, 4th), SB (8, T-4th), and OPS (.903, 6th). He is currently on a 7-game hitting streak, batting .458 with 11 H, 1 2B, 2 RBI, 3 BB, 5 SB, a .517 OBP, a .500 SLG, and a 1.017 OPS during this span.

ALFONSIN'S AWESOME OFFENSE: OF Alfonsin Rosario, MLB Pipeline's No. 25 Cleveland prospect, has become one of the Midwest League's premier hitters to begin his High-A career. The 20-year-old ranks top-10 in the MWL in: SLG (.583, 6th), OPS (.960, 9th), and HR (3, T-9th). Rosario was the only Single-A player with 15+ HR, 70+ RBI, and 20+ SB last year with Single-A Myrtle Beach (CHC).

JASIAK'S SCORELESS STRETCH: RHP Jack Jasiak is off to an impressive start to begin his High-A career. The 2022 12th-round pick out of South Florida has yet to allow a run in his first 4 appearances for Lake County, spinning 10.1 consecutive scoreless innings during this span. Jasiak is 1 of just 4 MWL pitchers with 10+ IP, 1-or-fewer walks, and 0 R allowed this season.

TUGBOAT CRUISE: After being named a 2024 Midwest League All-Star, LHP Matt Wilkinson continues to fare well for Lake County's pitching staff. The southpaw is tied for the Midwest League lead in both K (22) and GS (4), while ranking T-9th with 15.0 IP. Last year, Wilkinson led MWL with an average of 13.20 K/9 and a 37.6% strikeout percentage across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg, while ranking 2nd in MWL with 174 K, a 1.90 ERA, a .169 opposing AVG, and a 0.91 WHIP.

LAKE COUNTY IS BACK: Lake County has had a strong offensive start so far this year. Through their first 16 games of the season, the Captains lead the MWL and rank 2nd in High-A in HR (21) and SLG (.425). Additionally, the Captains rank top-5 in High-A in: TB (225, 4th), R (90, 5th), and OPS (.786, 5th).

WELCOME BACK, OMIRI! On Jan. 30, it was announced that Manager Omir Santos would return for his 3rd season as Lake County's skipper. He is now the longest-tenured manager in Captains history, and 1 of just 2 to win a championship for Lake County (Ted Kubiak, 2010). With a 151-124 (.549) record at the helm, Santos is 21 victories away from becoming the winningest manager in Captains history.

BIO

Mokoro (wears #43) enters her first season as Lake County's Bat Dog, and first season with the Guardians organization. The 1-year-old Chocolate Labrador Retriever is owned and trained by **Victoria Brody**. **Brody** is a professional dog trainer who started Mission Empawthy, LLC, a local dog training company which focuses on specializing in psychiatric service dogs for those whose disabilities aren't always visible. **Mokoro will retrieve bats and balls for the Captains alongside Brody at all Thursday home games this season!**

Mokoro is named after a type of dugout canoe found in Botswana. These vessels, which usually carry 1-2 passengers, are commonly used to navigate the Okavango Delta for both transport and game viewing safaris. While mekoro (plural form of "mokoro") used to primarily be made from Jackalberry, Mangosteen, and Sausage trees, they are now mainly made from fiberglass.

LAST TIME OUT: Back on Thursday, April 17, LHP **Michael Kennedy** (ND) made his 2nd piggyback relief appearance of the season on the road against the Fort Wayne TinCaps. The left-hander pitched 4 innings, allowing 5 hits, 4 earned runs, and no walks, while throwing 6 strikeouts in 65 pitches (46 strikes). **Kennedy** tied his pro career-high with 2 home runs allowed, permitting a 2-run homer in the bottom of the 5th inning and a solo shot 3 frames later.

TOP 20 PROSPECT: **Kennedy** is the Guardians' No. 18 prospect according to *MLB Pipeline*. **MLB Pipeline on Kennedy:** "Kennedy's fastball averaged just under 90 mph and peaked at 93 last season, though it was effective because he creates deception and carry with a flat approach angle. Hitters also can't sit on his heater because he has a pair of solid secondary pitches that elicit a lot of chases. His sweeping low-80s slider keeps left-handers in check and his sinking low-80s changeup keeps right-handers at bay." In his career with the Pirates organization, the left-hander compiled a 3.11 ERA, with a 158/44 K/BB ratio over 130.1 innings pitched. **In 2024, Kennedy had just a 6% walk rate, which ranked 3rd among teenagers in MiLB (min. 80 IP).**

TOP 30 PROSPECT: **Kennedy** is also rated as the Guardians' No. 26 prospect by *Baseball America*. **Baseball America on Kennedy:** "...a deceptive low-slot release and shorter arm path have allowed the sturdily-built lefthander to elicit whiffs at the top of the zone with his heater and mostly stymie lower-level hitters... **Kennedy** throws plenty of strikes and repeats his delivery well."

WELCOME TO THE LAND: On Dec. 10, 2024, **Kennedy** was traded to the Cleveland Guardians from the Pittsburgh Pirates. He was traded to Cleveland along with fellow Captains LHP **Josh Hartle** and current Guardians RHP **Luis Ortiz** in exchange for INF **Spencer Horwitz**.

ROOKIE BALL LEGEND: With the FCL Pirates in 2023, **Kennedy** was awarded FCL Pitcher of the Month for August and was named a *Baseball America* Rookie Leagues All-Star. In August, he had a 0.61 ERA in 14.2 innings pitched, holding opponents to just a .109 AVG. **Kennedy** threw back-to-back scoreless starts on 8/8 and 8/15, tallying 8.2 straight scoreless innings. **Kennedy's 0.61 ERA in August ranked 3rd in all of Rookie Ball (min. 14 IP), and his 6.00 K/BB ratio ranked 4th in all of professional baseball in the month of August.**

FIDGET SPINNERS: During 2024 Spring Training, **Kennedy** was bored in his house in Bradenton, Florida, so he decided to purchase fidget spinners from Amazon. He brought them to the clubhouse, and they were an immediate hit. **As a result, the left-hander purchased a Pirates branded fidget spinner for each Single-A Bradenton pitcher.** That season, **Kennedy** finished 5th on Bradenton in strikeouts (80), innings pitched (73), and games started (15, tied), **proving the fidget spinners to be effective.**

HIGH SCHOOL STARDOM: A two-way star in high school at Troy High School in Troy, New York, **Kennedy** was named New York's 2022 Gatorade Player of the Year following an incredible senior season both at the plate and on the mound. **As a pitcher, the southpaw did not lose a single game in his high school career, going a perfect 13-0.** In his senior season, he boasted a 0.61 ERA, adding 65 strikeouts to just 8 walks. **In the final game of his high school career, Kennedy threw a no-hitter vs. Albany Academy, propelling Troy to the Section 2 Class A Semifinals.** As a hitter, he was just as good, finishing his high school career batting .437 while slugging 7 home runs.

LAST TIME OUT: Back on Thursday, April 17 at Fort Wayne, RHP Dylan DeLucia (1-2) suffered the loss in a 9-1 Captains defeat. The right-hander pitched 3 innings, allowing 5 hits, 5 earned runs, and no walks, while throwing 5 strikeouts in 66 pitches (43 strikes). DeLucia tied his pro career-high with 2 home runs allowed, surrendering a pair of 2-run home runs in the bottom of the 1st and 4th innings.

DeLUCIA VERSUS THE LOONS: DeLucia has made 3 starts against Great Lakes across 2024 and 2025. The right-hander has gone 0-1 with a 3.97 ERA, 0.97 WHIP, and .154 opposing AVG in these outings, recording 16 strikeouts to just 5 walks in a combined 11.1 innings of work.

DeLUCIA DELIVERS IN THE PLAYOFFS: DeLucia was 1 of just 4 pitchers to make 2 starts during the 2024 Midwest League Playoffs. The right-hander pitched a combined 9 innings, allowing 9 hits, 4 runs (3 earned), and 2 walks, while throwing 10 strikeouts, which ranked 2nd during the 2024 MWL Playoffs. This includes his start in the winner-take-all Game 3 of the 2024 Midwest League Championship Series, in which he pitched 4.2 scoreless innings in Lake County's eventual 9-4 championship clinching win.

CAPTAIN OF THE WEEK: DeLucia was named Captain of the Week, presented by Official League, on Aug. 26, 2024 for his 2 strong starts at West Michigan. In his 2 starts against the Whitecaps on Aug. 20 and Aug. 25, he pitched 9.2 shutout innings, allowing 4 hits and a walk while striking out 8. DeLucia was 1 of 5 Minor League pitchers to make 2 scoreless starts during this span. In his 3 starts from Aug. 13 to Aug. 25, DeLucia recorded a 0.61 ERA, a .122 opposing AVG, and 17 strikeouts.

RETURN FROM INJURY: After undergoing Tommy John surgery in June of 2023, DeLucia returned in 2024, making 2 starts for the ACL Guardians and 3 for Single-A Lynchburg. With the ACL Guardians, he made 2 scoreless starts and pitched 5 shutout innings, allowing 3 hits and striking out 3 in his first appearances since the 2022 College World Series at Ole Miss. From July 1 to July 21 with Lynchburg, he posted a 4.15 ERA (4 earned runs) while striking out 10 across 8.2 innings. In his 3 starts for the Hillcats, DeLucia threw 69% of his pitches for strikes.

OMAHA LEGEND: DeLucia spent his 3rd and final season of college baseball with Ole Miss in 2022, where he led the Rebels to their first College World Series title and won CWS MOP. In the CWS, he pitched went 2-0 with a 0.53 ERA (1 earned run), 17 strikeouts and no walks in 16.2 innings. On June 23 versus Arkansas – his last college start – he pitched a 9-inning, complete game shutout to send Ole Miss to the CWS Finals. DeLucia threw 100+ pitches in each of his last 4 starts in the Super Regionals and College World Series. There are 35 pitchers to win CWS Most Outstanding Player, including 2024 All-Star Game starting pitcher Paul Skenes (LSU, 2023), former Cleveland Guardian and Lake County Captain Adam Plutko (UCLA, 2013) current Athletics manager Mark Kotsay as a two-way (Cal State Fullerton, 1995), and Baseball Hall-of-Famer Dave Winfield as a two-way (Minnesota, 1973).

HOTTY TODDY: In 2022 at Ole Miss, DeLucia was named a 3rd Team All-American by Baseball America, starting 12 of 21 games in Oxford, MS. The Port Orange, FL native ranked 2nd in the SEC in innings pitched (95.1), 2nd in strikeouts looking (33), 4th in strikeouts (105), and 12th in ERA (3.68). In the Coral Gables Regional on June 4, he fanned a career-high 12 batters in a 7-4 win against Arizona. **College Major: Multi-Disciplinary Studies.**

JUCO BANDIT: After spending the 2019 fall season at the College of Charleston, DeLucia pitched 2 seasons at Northwest Florida State College in Niceville, FL from 2020-21, where he was 1st Team All-Conference and 2nd Team All-State. In 23 career appearances and 18 starts, he was 15-2 with a 1.91 ERA, 163 strikeouts and 32 walks across 127 innings. In 2021, he led NJCAA Region 8 with 119 strikeouts and 9 wins. 2 notable NWF alumni are 11-year MLB pitcher and 2005 Lake County Captain Tony Sipp and 11-year MLB outfielder and former Cleveland Indian Jason Michaels.

CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

7 former Lake County Captains made their MLB debut during the 2024 season.

INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel: On Wednesday, June 26, **INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Baltimore Orioles. He started at first base and batted 9th in the Guardians' order, finishing 1-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **In his 1st MLB at-bat, Noel hit a 413-foot solo home run to center field, becoming the 4th player in Cleveland franchise history to homer in his 1st career MLB at-bat. He was the first to do so since 2004 Captain Kevin Kouzmanoff, who became the 1st player in MLB history to hit a grand slam on his 1st MLB pitch on September 2, 2006.** Noel played 88 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .238 with 78 hits, 12 doubles, 27 home runs, 67 RBI, a .521 SLG, and an .827 OPS.

LHP Raymond Burgos: On Monday, June 24, **LHP Raymond Burgos** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Chicago Cubs. He pitched 1 inning of relief, allowing 3 hits, 1 earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 1 strikeout. **Burgos** made 48 regular-season appearances (11 starts) for the Captains across the 2019, 2021, and 2022 seasons, going 10-6 with a 2.83 ERA, 115 strikeouts, a 1.29 WHIP, a .255 opposing batting average, and 8 holds, converting 1 of his 2 save opportunities. He also made 3 postseason relief appearances for Lake County in 2022, tallying a 4.26 ERA, 6 strikeouts, 2 walks, and a .150 opposing batting average, converting his lone save opportunity in Game 2 of the Midwest League East Championship Series.

INF Angel Martínez: On Saturday, June 22, **INF Angel Martínez** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Toronto Blue Jays. He started at designated hitter and batted 9th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-3 with 1 strikeout. **Martínez** played 77 regular-season games for the Captains in 2022, hitting .288 with 81 hits, 17 doubles, 3 triples, 10 home runs, 27 RBI, 10 stolen bases, and an .861 OPS.

INF/OF Daniel Schneemann: On Sunday, June 2, **INF Daniel Schneemann** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Washington Nationals. He started at 2nd base and batted 8th in the Guardians' order, going 1-for-3 with a 2-run double on his first MLB pitch and a strikeout. **Schneemann** played 98 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2018, 2019, and 2021 seasons, hitting .267 with 86 hits, 13 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 43 RBI, 12 stolen bases, and a .711 OPS. He also played 3 postseason games for Lake County in 2019, hitting .182 (2-for-11) with 2 runs, 2 RBI, and 1 walk.

1B/OF Trenton Brooks: On Tuesday, May 28, **1B/OF Trenton Brooks** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Philadelphia Phillies. He started at 1st base and batted 9th in the Giants' order, going 0-for-2 with 1 strikeout. **Brooks** played 29 games for the Captains in 2017, hitting .214 with 24 hits, 5 doubles, 1 home run, 8 RBI, 12 walks, and a .588 OPS.

OF Johnathan Rodríguez: On Tuesday, May 21, **OF Johnathan Rodríguez** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the New York Mets. He started in right field and batted 7th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **Rodríguez** played 103 games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .275 with 103 hits, 20 doubles, 23 home runs, 70 RBI, and an .862 OPS. In 2022, he led the Midwest League with 21 home runs.

RHP Cade Smith: On Saturday, March 30, **RHP Cade Smith** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Oakland Athletics. He pitched 2 scoreless, hitless innings of relief, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 5 strikeouts. **Smith** made 23 relief appearances for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, going 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA, 48 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP, and a .156 opposing batting average, converting 6 of his 7 save opportunities.
