PAPILLION, NEB. - Behind a stellar pitching performance, the Omaha Storm Chasers won 6-1 Sunday afternoon at Werner Park as they took five of six games against the Gwinnett Stripers in the homestand.

- The opening frames were some of the quietest in what was an otherwise busy week offensively, as Omaha and Gwinnett combined for 1 single across the first 3 innings ... starters **Jonathan Bowlan** and **Huascar Ynoa** had stellar outings, with 3 strikeouts each and only 1 walk for Ynoa ... Bowlan threw his 2nd quality start of the week, with just 1 run allowed over 6.0 innings and no walks for the second straight start.
- Nick Pratto** started the scoring for Omaha in the bottom of the 4th inning as he belted a homer to left field 1-0 in favor of the Chasers, his first long ball of the year.
- Bowlan cruised through the first five innings and it wasn't until the top of the 6th inning that the Stripers finally got to him, as **Skye Bolt** tripled into left center field, then **David Fletcher** ripped a two-out single into right field to put Gwinnett on the board and tie the game 1-1.
- The game did not stay tied for long, as **John Rave** opened the bottom of the 6th inning with a triple, then scored on a two-out RBI double from second baseman **Michael Massey** to put Omaha up 2-1.
- Rave took his turn to drive in runs in the bottom of the 7th inning, with the fourth of five singles in the inning to drive home **Logan Porter** and **CJ Alexander** with two outs and increase the lead to 4-1.
- In the bottom of the eighth, a single, hit batter and three steals put two runners in scoring position for Omaha and **Tyler Gentry** delivered his biggest hit of the week with a two-run double down the left field line that scored Pratto and Porter for a 6-1 Omaha lead that held to be final.
- Behind Bowlan, **Evan Sisk**, **Steven Cruz** and **Colin Selby** combined for 3.0 scoreless innings, with no walks allowed for pitching staff's first 0-walk game of the season.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

STRIPPED THE STRIPERS

- Last week's series between Omaha and Gwinnett was arguably Omaha's best offensive performance since the 6-game series was implemented in MiLB in 2021.
- Omaha scored at least 6 runs and had 9 or more hits in all six games of the series, with at least 10 hits in all five wins during the week and a total of 60 runs scored over the six games ... the team hit .326 (70-for-215) with a 1.055 OPS against the Stripers.
- Last week against Gwinnett, Omaha set 6-game series records for ... Hits (70), Runs (60), Total Bases (136), RBI (56), Average (.326), Slugging % (.633) and OPS (1.055) ... when factoring in a handful of 7-game series, last week still holds the records for runs, while 2nd in hits and total bases.
- Scoring an average of 10.0 runs/game is the second-most Omaha has averaged in ANY series since 2021, trailing a 12.0 R/G average the club had over 4 games in 2021, from September 29 to October 3 @ Iowa.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

- Last week, Omaha outscored Gwinnett 60-28 to give the team a +32 run differential this season.
- A +32 run differential ranks as the best in the International League and 3rd in Minor League Baseball ... only the Sugar Land Skeeters (Houston AAA) at +36 and Oklahoma City Baseball Clubs (Dodgers AAA) at +33 have outscored their opponent by more runs.
- Last year, Omaha topped out at a +18 run differential, after the third game of the season on April 2 ... the run differential was above 0 after only 27 games last year, with 116 games of a negative run differential.

PUSHING PORTER

- Storm Chasers catcher **Logan Porter** was named the International League's Player of the Week last week, after one of the top offensive performances in Minor League Baseball.
- Porter led the league last week with a .1400 slugging percentage and 2.050 OPS, going 8-for-15 (.533 average) at the plate against the Stripers.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT

- Infielder **CJ Alexander** has been one of Omaha's top hitters through the first 14 games of the season, leading the team in nearly every offensive category.
- Alexander leads the Storm Chasers in hits (18), doubles (6), extra-base hits (10), total bases (36), runs scored (13) and runs batted in (12) ... he is tied for the team lead in home runs (4) ... his .333 average, .667 slugging percentage and 1.035 OPS all lead qualified Omaha hitters too.
- The left-handed hitter is tied 2nd in the International League in doubles, tied 4th in extra-base hits, tied 6th in total bases and tied 7th in hits.

MASS EFFECT

- Second baseman **Michael Massey** continues his Major League rehab today, after joining Omaha last week and appearing in 5 games of the series vs. Gwinnett.
- Massey has gone 9-for-22 at the plate (.409), with 5 doubles, 5 runs scored and 6 runs batted in.
- He has a hit in all 5 games he's played, with 2+ hits in 4 of 5 games and an RBI in 4 of 5 games ... a pair of walks give him a .458 on-base percentage with a 1.094 OPS.

TODAY'S START

- Hoffmann is making his team-leading 4th start of the season with Omaha.
In his second season with Omaha after making his final 8 starts of 2023 in Triple-A with the Storm Chasers

LAST OUTING: WEDNESDAY, APRIL 10 vs. GWINNETT

Made his third start of the season and allowed a run to score in the first inning on a double, single and Leury Garcia sacrifice fly ... settled down after that second out of the inning and did not allow a run the rest of the way ... allowed 1 walk and 5 singles the rest of the way, with a 1-2-3 4th inning ... allowed two singles to open the 6th inning and was relieved by Sam Long, who stranded the inherited runners.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 3 Cactus League games (1 start) and went 0-0 with a 1.93 ERA (1 ER in 4.2 IP), with 4 strikeouts.
In his 2024 season debut on March 31 vs. Iowa, retired 15 of his final 18 after the homer, including his last 7 straight.

CAREER NOTES

- 2023: Opened the season with NW Arkansas (AA) and made 19 starts for the Naturals with 1 relief appearance (as the bulk pitcher) before getting promoted to Triple-A on August 12, where he ended the season ... combined to go 7-9 with a 5.53 ERA (77 ER in 125.1 IP) and 133 strikeouts (9.55 K/9) between the Naturals and Storm Chasers.
Threw 3 quality starts in Double-A: May 9 at Arkansas (SEA), June 1 vs. Corpus Christi (HOU) and August 5 at Springfield (STL), but did not throw one in Triple-A.
Was supposed to make his Triple-A debut on August 13 vs. Iowa (CHC), but the game was rained out ... instead pitched twice in next series, including his Triple-A debut August 15 at Toledo (DET), where he retired 6 of his first 7 with 3 strikeouts, before allowing a 5-run third inning ... tied a season-high at the time with 8 strikeouts on August 20 at Toledo, but also set a career-high with 6 walks.
Threw exactly 5.0 innings in 5 of his last 6 Omaha starts ... held his opponent to 5 hits or less & 3 runs or less in 6 of his last 7 Chasers starts.

- 2022: Split his season between the Rome Braves (A+) and NW Arkansas (AA) traded from the Braves to the Royals on July 11 along with OF Drew Waters and INF CJ Alexander for a draft pick (Competitive Balance A, #35 overall).
Opened the season with the Rome and made 15 starts in the South Atlantic League, going 7-2 with a 2.36 ERA (21 ER in 80.0 IP), with 90 strikeouts to just 21 walks (4.29 K/BB) ... promoted to the Mississippi Braves (AA) on July 8 but did not appear in a game for the M-Braves, was with the team three days before being traded.
Threw at least 5.0 innings in 13 of his 15 starts with the Rome Braves, seven of them being at least 6.0 innings, with a pair of 7.0-inning starts on April 27 vs. Greensboro (PIT) and June 16 at Asheville (COL) ... recorded three scoreless starts, including 2 of his last 3.
Recorded a career-high 13.0-inning scoreless streak from June 16 to 29 spanning parts of 3 starts ... also did not allow a run across his last 9.0 innings in the Braves system before the trade, ending with 6.0 shutout innings July 6 vs. Asheville, where he struck out eight.
