LAST TIME OUT: The St. Paul Saints tied a franchise record by cracking 11 extra base hits, seven of which left the ballpark, while hanging at least a run on the board in seven of their eight offensive frames in a 16-2 rout of the I-Cubs on Saturday afternoon at CHS Field. The onslaught marked the most runs and hits (16) collected by the Saints lineup this year. The Saints staked a 3-0 lead after one and never looked back after two walks came around to score on Ryan Kreidler's three-run blast, his third. The Saints scored in each of the first five innings, including Alex Jackson drilling one off the batter's eye in teh third for a two-run shot and Kaelen Culpepper and Kyler Fedko going back-to-back to lead off the fourth. Walker Jenkins belted his second of the year in the seventh and Orlando Arcia homered in his final two plate appearances in the seventh and eighth. It made a winner out of Zebby Matthews who went 5.0 innings and allowed just a run. Seven home runs tied the most for the Saints in a game at CHS Field.

IT'S OUTTA HERE! The St. Paul Saints have hit 16 home runs in five games of the series so far vs the I-Cubs and now lead Minor League Baseball with 51 round-trippers as a ball club. It's one of the most prolific home run hitting series in Saints history:

BACK, BACK, GONE: Between Orlando Arcia, Kaelen Culpepper, Kyler Fedko, Emmanuel Rodriguez, and Gabby Gonzalez, the Saints are 2nd in Triple-A with five hitters that have slugged at least five home runs (only Louisville has more with six hitters that have eclipsed five homers entering Sunday). The Saints are currently on pace to set a new team franchise record in home runs in a season and surpass 2023's total of 206. Fedko currently leads the Saints with 8 HR in 27 games this year.

WALKER, TEXAS-RANGER- MINNESOTA TWIN: Outfielder Walker Jenkins went 3-for-5 on Friday, including beginning his night with doubles in three straight plate appearances. It marked the Twins top prospect's second three-hit game of the season. The three doubles tied a Saints franchise record for an individual in a game, matching Brooks Lee (6/19/24 vTOL), Michael Helman (6/1/24 @ROC), Anthony Prato (4/24/24 vROC), Jermaine Palacios (8/3/22 @OMA), Mark Contreras (8/18/21 vIOW), and Brent Rooker (6/23/21 @COL). After a two-hit game Saturday that included his second home run of the season, Jenkins is 8-last-19 (.421) with 5 XBH over the course of a current five-game hit streak.

LEADING OFF WITH A BANG: After adding two more inning-opening blasts to their ledger on Saturday afternoon, the Saints are now 2nd in minor league baseball in homers to lead off an inning (see below). Kaelen Culpepper (3), Orlando Arcia (2) Alex Jackson (2), and Emmanuel Rodriguez (2) have all touched off for at least two home runs to lead off an inning each this year, with Culpepper twice leading off with home runs to start the day offensively for St. Paul. Culpepper is one of 13 hitters in MiLB with multiple "leadoff homers" (HR in 1st inning by a leadoff man); nobody in the minors or MLB has more than two.

E-ROD WITH ANOTHER A-BOMB "OUTLIER": Outfielder and Twins No. 2 prospect Emmanuel Rodriguez broke his own Saints record by crushing the hardest-hit ball in Saints history on Tuesday afternoon, an 118.3 mph line drive home run. It is the hardest hit ball in Triple-A this season, and second only to an Oneil Cruz 119.0 mph double on April 16 vs Washington in either MLB or Triple-A this season. E-Rod has produced six of the top-30 hardest struck balls in Triple-A this season and 3 of the top-10.

LOWERTOWN LAUNCH PAD: Entering play Sunday, CHS Field ranks 2nd among all full-season MiLB parks in combined OPS this season (.922 between the Saints and their opponents). The 70 homers featured in St. Paul already are the 2nd-most at an MiLB venue this year, trailing only Truist Field in Charlotte (72). CHS Field ranks t-7th in runs scored (214). Over the previous five years (2021-25), the Saints' home ranked 3rd (.795) among IL ballparks in combined OPS, behind only Truist Field (CLT) & Werner Park (OMA) and 5th in the league in home runs (966), trailing Syracuse, Omaha, Durham, & Charlotte's parks.

TWINS OF TOMORROW: The Saints opened the season with nine of the Twins' Top-30 ranked prospects according to MLB.com, marking the most players listed on MLB's Minnesota Top-30 list to open a campaign in the Saints' history as a Triple-A franchise. Between Walker Jenkins, Kaelen Culpepper, Emmanuel Rodriguez, & Connor Prielipp, they touted four prospects on either the MLB.com or Baseball America Top-100 list, surpassing last year's total of three when Rodriguez, Luke Keaschall, and Zebby Matthews all began the year with the Saints. The remaining ranked prospects included Gabriel Gonzalez (7/10), Andrew Morris (13/13), Marco Rava (18/21), and John Klein (20/23). LHP Kendry Rojas (10/8) also opened the year on the Saints' injured list. RHP Ryan Gallagher (19/22) also joined the Saints mid-season.

CAREER NOTES

- Enters his first season as Twins farmhand...originally a 30th-round pick by the Angels in 2019...was released in May 2020 and signed with Toronto over a year later...spent the last 5 years in Jays system
- Has produced a sub-3.00 ERA in three straight seasons & owns a 2.66 ERA from 2023-25, which ranks 7th in MiLB among pitchers with at least 200 IP

2025

- Named the Warren Spahn Award Winner as the Triple-A Buffalo Most Valuable Pitcher for second year in-a-row
- Spent the entire season with Triple-A Buffalo, going 6-2, 2.57 ERA (24 ER, 84.0 IP) with 72 strikeouts (20 K%) and 36 walks (10 BB%) in 40 app. (5 GS)
- Ranked 7th in the International League in ERA (min. 50 IP)...threw a scoreless outing in 20-of-40 appearances, mostly in relief
- Of his 40 appearances, five were starts...one of which came vs the Saints on May 9 at CHS Field (3.1 IP, 1 Run, 5 hits, 1 BB, 3 SO, 1 HRA, season-high 64 pitches)

2024

- Was named the Warren Spahn Award winner as the Buffalo Bison's Most Valuable Pitcher...led all Bison arms in ERA (min 30 IP)...went 4-0 with a 2.97 ERA (26 ER, 78.2 IP) while ranking top-5 on the staff in wins & strikeouts (72)

- Spun five no-hit innings in his start on June 9 at Lehigh Valley, broken up when he gave up a leadoff double to Scott Kingery in 6th...outdueled Mick Abel for his second win of the season

- Started the year in Indy Ball with the Missoula Paddleheads (Pioneer League)...made five appearances (4 starts) and dominated to the tune of a 2-0 record & 1.80 ERA (5 ER, 25.0 IP)...struck out 27 of 101 batters faced
- Signed by the Blue Jays as a minor league free agent in June after being released by the Angels in May of 2020
- In affiliated ball, had a career-worst season by ERA (5.50), but went 8-1 across just 16 appearances (4 starts) split between 3 levels of the Toronto system

LAST APPEARANCE: Pitched in relief on Tuesday afternoon, throwing 2.0 innings behind starter John Klein (worked the 5th and 6th innings)...worked around a one out walk in a scoreless 5th...retired the first two hitters of the sixth before yielding a solo homer to Kevin Alcantara...retired 6-of-8 overall...threw 11 changeups (33%), 10 four-seamers (30%), 10 sweepers (30%), and 2 sinkers (6%)...induced four swings-and-misses

TROY PERCIVAL, YOU'RE MY HERO: A Southern California native, Bash's family were Angels season ticket-holders while Bash was growing up. He attended Game 7 of the 2002 World Series, where the Angels beat the Giants for the Commissioner's Trophy. Bash would go on to eventually be drafted by the Angels in the 30th round of the 2019 Draft. He would spend just one year with the Halos organization before being released in May of 2020, signing with the Missoula Paddleheads in Indy Ball for the start of 2021, and eventually latching on with the Blue Jays.

IT AIN'T MUCH, BUT IT'S HONEST WORK: Following the cancellation of the 2020 minor league season, Bash was working as a groundskeeper at his old college, California Baptist. In 2021, he got the call from the Missoula Paddleheads (Independent, Pioneer League) in 2021 and signed with them.

THE INVINCIBLE ONE: Spending most of the last two seasons with Triple-A Buffalo in the Toronto system, Andrew Bash is the back-to-back Warren Spahn Award winner, granted to the Bisons' Most Valuable Pitcher each season. Bash ranked 7th in the International League in ERA last season (min 50 IP) with a 2.57 mark, his second straight year throwing up a sub-3.00 ERA. The award is of course named for the Hall-of-Famer, who although he didn't ever play for the Bisons, is a South Buffalo native. Nicknamed "the Invincible One," Spahn won 363 games and threw 382 complete games in his illustrious 21-year career.
