**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn's three-game winning streak was snapped in a 6-4 loss at Wilmington on Wednesday...The Blue Rocks jumped out a 3-0 lead in the first before the Cyclones rallied for four runs in the fifth to take the lead on a two-run LF **Chris Suero** single...Wilmington regained the lead in the bottom half on a two-run fielding error and never relinquished the advantage...Suero and 2B **D'Andre Smith** each posted multi-hit games for Brooklyn...IB **Roismar Quintana** registered a team-high three hits for the Blue Rocks, while RF **Jared McKenzie** tallied two knocks and two RBI.

**THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY:** On August 15, 2002, 1B **Brett Harper** went 5-for-5 at Aberdeen to tie the then-franchise record for hits in a game...In 2010, the Cyclones and Williamsport Crosscutters were tied at one until the 14th inning...IB **Jeff Flagg** provided the go-ahead sacrifice fly in the top of the 14th in a 2-1 victory...In 2014, RHP **Marcos Molina** struck out 12 hitters over 7.0 innings of one-hit shutout ball in a 7-0 win at Vermont...RHPs **Luis Rengel** (1.0 IP, 3 K) and **Edioglis Villasmi** (1.0, 1 H, 1 K) combined on a two-hitter, while DH **Tomas Nido** went 3-for-4 with a double and a RBI...In 2017, the original "Voice of the Cyclones" **Warner Fusselle** was posthumously inducted into the New York-Penn League Hall-of-Fame before the league All-Star Game in Troy, N.Y...In 2018, 3B **Brian Sharp** tied a franchise record by drawing four walks in a 4-1 win vs. Vermont...He also stole two bases part of seven on the night for the Cyclones.

**NO TRESS-PASSING:** RHP **Austin Troesser** was added to the Cyclones' roster from Single-A St. Lucie on Thursday...In 12 appearances (6 starts) with the Mets, the 22-year-old posted a 1-4 record with a 4.25 ERA (17 ER in 36.0 IP), 16 walks, and 52 strikeouts...Troesser spent over a month on the injured list from May 26 until July 19...In 3 appearances (1 start) since returning, the University of Missouri alum has not allowed a run on two hits in 5.0 innings, walking one and striking out seven...Among Florida State League pitchers (min. 30.0 IP), Troesser was tied for seventh in strikeout-to-walk rate (23.8%) and eighth in strikeout rate (34.4%).

**NONE SHALL PASS:** The Cyclones' bullpen has been near perfect since the tail end of Saturday's Seinfeld Night festivities vs. Hudson Valley...Brooklyn relievers have not allowed an earned run in 171 innings dating back to the fourth inning on Saturday...The Cyclones bullpen did not allow a hit in 11.0 consecutive innings with 19 strikeouts from SS **George Lombard Jr.**'s two-out single in the eighth inning on Saturday night until 1B **Roismar Quintana**'s single in the sixth inning on Wednesday...RHP **Eduardo Herrera**, LHP **Ryan Ammons**, RHP **Jordany Ventura**, and RHP **Alan Perdomo** also combined to retire 22 hitters in a row from one out in the ninth inning on Saturday until one out in the eighth inning on Tuesday.

**LONG ARM OF THE LAW:** RHP **Justin Lawson** tossed a career-high 4.0 innings to earn his second win in Game 2 of August 4's doubleheader at Aberdeen...The 23-year-old allowed just two hits and one walk, striking out four...Lawson has not allowed an earned run in his last 13.0 innings dating back to July 21 vs. Jersey Shore...Since June 15 at Hudson Valley, the Winfield, La. native has composed a 2-2 record and a pristine 0.70 ERA (2 ER in 25.2 IP), earning two saves...No South Atlantic League reliever with 20.0 or more innings pitched since June 15 has a lower ERA than Lawson (0.70)...Among all pitchers with at least 25.0 frames on the bump, the right-hander is second in the league in ERA (0.70) in that time.

**TO SMITH-EREENS:** UT **D'Andre Smith** has been blasting the ball across the diamond since returning from the 7-day injured list on July 22...The 23-year-old picked up his third multi-hit game during a six-contender hitting streak dating back to the opening game of last Wednesday's doubleheader vs. Hudson Valley...In that span, Smith is 9-for-22 at the plate (.409) with two doubles, two runs batted in, and two stolen bases...The 23-year-old is hitting .278/.291/.370 in 15 games since being reinstated but has hit another gear since the calendar flipped to August...In 9 games this month, Smith is batting .387/.406/.548 with a .954 OPS, two runs scored, two doubles, a home run, four runs batted in, and two steals...The former fifth-round pick is third in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.387) during August (min. 30 PA).

**A DOZEN DONUTS:** Brooklyn's 2-0 win at Wilmington on Tuesday night marked the team's 12th shutout of the year, setting a new single-season franchise record...The Cyclones tied the 2023 squad's franchise record with its 11th shutout in July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The Cyclones had blanked Wilmington in consecutive matchups and had thrown 21 consecutive scoreless frames against them dating back from the fifth inning on July 13 until the first inning on Wednesday...The 12 shutouts are two behind Rome (14) for the most in the South Atlantic League.

**WENN IN BROOKLYN:** RHP **Jack Wenninger** suffered the defeat in his first start at the High-A level, but has quickly figured things out at the classification since...After tossing 5.0-plus innings of shutout ball for his first High-A win on Tuesday, the 22-year-old is a 1-0 with a 1.31 ERA (3 ER in 20.2 IP) and one hold in his last 5 appearances (4 starts) since July 14 at Wilmington...Wenninger has surrendered 15 hits and 9 walks while striking out 27 in that span...The Barrington, Ill. native is fourth in the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.31) and seventh in batting average against (.192) in that time.

**vs. WILMINGTON:** The Cyclones play their final in-division road series of 2024 against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks have two of Washington's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP **Jarlin Susana** (4) and OF **Robert Hassell III** (13)...Hassell is with the club on a Minor League rehab assignment...The Cyclones are 7-9 against the Blue Rocks this season, but just 3-7 at Frawley Stadium...Since moving to the full-season level in 2021, Brooklyn is 49-48 all-time against Wilmington (.505).

**MORABITO BITE:** OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The McLean, Va. native is tied for seventh in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (49)...With two swipes (39) last Thursday, he broke OF **Omar De Los Santos'** single-season franchise record of 37, which was set last year...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (87), is second in stolen bases (38), tied for second in games played (76), sixth in runs scored (50), and seventh in batting average (.285)...The former second-round selection is fourth in the SAL in stolen bases (38) and seventh in batting average (.285) for the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.308), stolen bases (49), on-base percentage (.399), and hits (118)...He is also tied for second in runs scored (64), third in total bases (148), tied for third in triples (4), and fourth in OPS (.785).

**THE TONG SONG:** RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native is second in the circuit and third among all High-A pitchers in strikeouts (93)...The 93 strikeouts are also tied for 10th in the circuit overall...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 80.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.13), fourth in strikeout rate (35.2%), and ninth in strikeouts (129) and strikeout-to-walk rate (24.9%).

**OMAR-I-GONE:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...The 24-year-old powered a walk-off solo home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Rome on July 28 and five of his last six home runs have tied the game or provided Brooklyn the lead...Since the All-Star break, Omar is tied for second in the league in triples (2), tied for third in home runs (5), tied for ninth in extra-base hits (8) and slugging (.500)...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still sixth in the South Atlantic League for the year with 35 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's then-single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (72) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is second in the South Atlantic League (72) and is tied for fifth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (144).

**TAKING KELLUM 123:** OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since...The 23-year-old has seven multi-hit efforts in his last 25 games...Since July 6, he has been hitting .294/.368/.329 with nine runs scored, three doubles, three runs batted in, 10 walks, and three stolen bases over the 25 games...Clark is 10th in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.294) in that span.

**IT'S A WALK-OFF:** For the fourth time in 10 home games, Brooklyn earned a walk-off victory thanks to 3B **Jacob Reimer's** two-run single in the bottom of the seventh in Game 1 of Wednesday's double-dip with Hudson Valley...In the Cyclones' previous home game, on July 28 vs. Rome, 3B **Jeffrey De Los Santos** blasted a game-tying two-run home run in the ninth before LF **Omar De Los Santos** followed with a walk-off solo shot in a 7-6 triumph...The back-to-back jacks marked just the second time Brooklyn had accomplished the feat in 2024...SS **William Lugo** and CF **Stanley Consuegra** clubbed consecutive home runs in the sixth inning on May 18 at Bowling Green...It was also Brooklyn's second walk-off home run of the season...3B **Nick Lorusso** smacked a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14...The Cyclones also earned walk-off wins in the last 10 home affairs on July 19, via C **Chris Suero's** game-winning bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Jersey Shore and, again, on July 24, courtesy of SS **Wilfredo Lara's** walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Rome...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 18 walk-off losses, accumulating 14.63% of all defeats, including 26.09% of all road losses, while earning 12 walk-off wins...30 of Brooklyn's 241 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.45%)...The Cyclones have also earned 24 wins in their last at-bat.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The Cyclones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesús Báez** (10), RHP **Jonah Tong** (17), INF **Jacob Reimer** (22), RHP **Jack Wenninger** (27), and RHP **Calvin Ziegler** (30)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season IL...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (10), Báez (14), OF **Nick Morabito** (19), Reimer (20), and Wenninger (30).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered his fourth loss of the season last Thursday night vs. Hudson Valley...Game featured a pair of rain delays...Contest was halted due to rain for 12 minutes in the top of the fourth and for 35 minutes in the top of the eighth...Entered in support of LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** (6.0 IP) and RHP **Luis G. Moreno** (1.0+ IP) after the second delay and Brooklyn trailing 3-2...Permitted one unearned run on two hits over 3.0 innings...Did not issue a walk and struck out two...Threw 36 pitches and 24 strikes (66.67%)...Cyclones tied the game with back-to-back singles from CF **Nick Morabito** and 2B **D'Andre Smith** with two out in the bottom of the ninth...Allowed the automatic runner in the top of the 10th to score on a ground ball double play...Cyclones could not score in the bottom half and fell to the Renegades, 4-3.

**RELIEF ACE:** Entering play on Thursday, Lawson is tied for sixth in the South Atlantic League in saves (6).

**LONG ARM OF THE LAW:** The 23-year-old has not allowed an earned run in his last 13.0 innings dating back to July 21 vs. Jersey Shore...Lawson holds a 2-2 mark in that time with 10 hits allowed, four unearned runs, five walks, seven strikeouts, and a pair of double plays...Since June 15 at Hudson Valley, the Winnfield, La. native has composed a 2-2 record and a pristine 0.70 ERA (2 ER in 25.2 IP), earning two saves...Lawson has surrendered 17 hits and walked eight, while striking out 15...No South Atlantic League reliever with 20.0 or more innings pitched since June 15 has a lower ERA than Lawson (0.70)...Among all pitchers with at least 25.0 frames on the bump, the right-hander is second in the league in ERA (0.70) in that time.

**START ME UP:** Lawson made his professional debut with the Cyclones in April after he did not pitch following being selected in the 2023 draft...The 15th-round selection did not allow a run over the first 10.0 innings of his professional career...Lawson's streak without allowing an earned run came to a close after 14.0 frames when he allowed a two-out RBI single to DH **Mac Horvath** on May 5 vs. Aberdeen.

**LEADER OF THE PACK:** Lawson was selected in the 15th round of the 2023 draft out of N.C. State University and signed for \$125,000...The 23-year-old spent the final two years of his college career in Raleigh, N.C., posting a 5-0 record with a 3.27 ERA (19 ER in 52.1 IP) and three saves over 27 appearances as a senior in 2023...Lawson walked 17 and struck out 67...The Winnfield, La. native led the Wolfpack in appearances (27) last year and topped all relief arms in innings pitched (52.1) and strikeouts (67)...Lawson started his college career with two seasons (2020-21) at Bossier Parrish Community College (Bossier City, La.).
