**Today:** It's the first Dog Days of Summer, with dogs welcome to the ballpark, as the Lansing Lugnuts, the Athletics' High-A affiliate, play the second in a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, the Dodgers' High-A affiliate. The Nuts' **Yunior Tur**, who started last week against Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown, makes his official Lugnuts debut against Loons southpaw **Luke Fox**, a product of Duke University.

**Last Night: Loons 10, Lugnuts 5.** Playing in temperatures sinking below 30 degrees (with wind chill in the teens), **Rodney Green, Jr.** slugged a pair of solo home runs, but the Lugnuts lost the opener of a six-game series behind a 15-hit attack from Great Lakes.

### LUG•NOTES

**Atop the Majors:** 2022 Lugnut **Tyler Soderstrom** is tied with the Yankees' Aaron Judge for the most home runs in MLB (6). Soderstrom ranks 2nd in OPS (1.262), total bases (37) and slugging percentage (.822). But Soderstrom does not lead the A's in hits; he trails 2023 Lugnut **Jacob Wilson** by one. Wilson's 18 hits are tied for 2nd in the Majors and lead the American League, while his .400 batting average is tied for 3rd in baseball.

**Atop the Minors:** 2024 A's first-rounder **Nick Kurtz** jumped over Lansing on his way up the ladder and is excelling with Triple-A Las Vegas. Kurtz leads all of Minor League Baseball with 36 total bases and 15 RBIs, and is tied for 1st in MiLB with 10 extra-base hits and five home runs.

**Roundtrip Tours:** **Rodney Green, Jr.**, launched the Lugnuts' first two home runs of the season last night, becoming the first Nut since **Jonny Butler** (July 11, 2024) with a multi-homer game. The Nuts had collected only two extra-base hits in their first 27 innings before Green's longballs.

**Breaking Out:** Set aside extra-base hits. Lansing's offense collected 16 hits in the first three games of the season before erupting for 14 hits against Great Lakes yesterday. In contrast, the winless Dayton Dragons only have 19 hits total through four games.

**Prospecting:** The Nuts boast the A's second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman **Tommy White** (40th overall), southpaw starter **Gage Jump** (73rd), shortstop **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (75th) and outfielder **Rodney Green, Jr.** (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 14 and Green is No. 20. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old **Steven Echavarria**, rated No. 12, and outfielder **Nate Nankil**, who is No. 30.

**Welcome Back:** The Lugnuts' roster features 17 returning players, from position players **Jonny Butler**, **Cole Conn**, **Jared Dickey**, **Clark Elliott**, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, **Nate Nankil**, **CJ Rodriguez**, **T.J. Schofield-Sam** and **Casey Yamauchi** to pitchers **Mark Adamiak**, **Hunter Breault**, **Jake Garland**, **Garrett Irvin**, **Grant Judkins**, **Blaze Pontes** and **Yehizon Sanchez**.

**Roll Call:** The last two Lugnuts on the Opening Day roster to make their season debut are tonight's starting battery, pitcher **Yunior Tur** and catcher **Nick Schwartz**. They become the 962nd and 963rd players in franchise history.

**Transaction:** **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (hamstring) was placed on the 7-day Injured List on Monday, with no corresponding move.

**A No-No for Stockton!** The Single-A Stockton Ports, one level below the Lugnuts on the Athletics' organizational ladder, became the first Minor League team to throw a no-hitter this season with a 2-0 win on Sunday at Fresno. Jefferson Jean walked one batter, Fresno's only base runner, while striking out five in five hitless innings (on 53 pitches). Tzu-Chen Sha followed with six strikeouts in three hitless innings before 19-year Wilfred Alvarado wrapped things up with a 1-2-3 ninth.

### APRIL 9TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2010:** The Dragons walked off the Lugnuts for the second straight day to start the year, winning 4-3 on a throwing error by 3B Oliver Dominguez. The Lugnuts committed seven – count 'em, seven – errors in the loss. (This is not the franchise record. That's nine errors, 6-13-03 vs. Fort Wayne.)

**2016:** After the first two games of the year were postponed in Lansing, the Lugnuts got the season going with a 5-4 loss at Great Lakes. During the game, the Loons' Jordan Paroubeck fouled a ball into the visiting broadcast booth that broke the Lugnuts' broadcast computer.

**2021:** Arizona's Tim Locastro (2015 Lugnut) breaks Tim Raines' MLB record for consecutive successful stolen bases to begin a career, swiping 2nd base vs. Cincy for his 28th straight successful steal. Locastro went on to extend his record to 29 straight steals before the streak ended.

**In a Nutshell:** Making his Lugnuts debut this season... only native Cuban on the team... noted for mid-90s fastball / split-changeup combo... one of three pitchers scheduled to work today standing at least 6-foot-6 or taller (Kyle Robinson, Jake Pfennigs)... looking to become second ever Major Leaguer named Yunior (joining Santo Domingo native Yunior Marte, who spent last season in the Phillies' pen).

**Hometown Hero:** Though born in La Habana, Yunior grew up in Santiago de Cuba, which also produced such notable Major Leaguers as Bábaro Garbey, Adeiny Hechavarría and Orestes Destrade.

**Dominating in Cuba:** Yunior pitched three seasons for Avispas ("Wasps") de Santiago de Cuba in the Cuban National Series, from 2018-2021... in 2019-20, at age 19, posted remarkable line: 0.00 ERA, 9 saves, 22 scoreless innings, 8 hits, 16 walks (two intentional) and 24 strikeouts... teammate: Oscar Colás, now with the White Sox... followed up in 2020-21: 2.11 ERA, league-leading 14 saves, 38 1/3 IP, 32 hits, 10 runs (9 earned), 25 walks, 45 strikeouts.

**2023 - Joining the A's:** Signed with the Athletics for \$100,000 three days before the end of the international signing period on May 8, 2023... made his pro debut with the Arizona Complex A's on June 5, allowing two runs (one earned) in four innings with no walks and four strikeouts against D-Backs Black... moved up to Stockton on June 17 and finished the season with 19 appearances out of the Ports' pen.

**2024 - Back to Stockton:** Pitched in relief for the Ports on Opening Day, April 5, and pitched a scoreless sixth before allowing three runs in the seventh inning, suffering the loss in a 7-2 defeat to Modesto... worked as a piggybacker throughout the year, alternating starts and relief appearances... tossed career five innings on four different occasions, allowing one run or fewer each time; curiously, these gems happened once a month - April 18, May 23, June 15, July 31... struck out seven Lake Elsinore Ports in three hitless innings, August 6, setting pro high... vs. lefties: .285/.356/.468, 6 HR... vs. righties: .255/.339/.418... base-stealers went 14-for-16 in successful attempts.
