MOVING ON: The Rangers made three deadline moves to fortify their big league pitching staff, swapping six pitching prospects in return. Starter Merrill Kelly was the biggest acquisition; Texas sent three top-15 arms to Arizona in return. One Spartanburger was involved in the trades; lefty starter Mason Molina was sent to the Cardinals as part of a return package for Phil Maton.

TOP 30 RESHUFFLE: With Rangers' trade moves, Dylan Dreiling was bumped to MLB Pipeline's No. 8 Rangers prospect, Anthony Gutierrez to No. 17, Kolton Curtis up four slots to No. 23, and Dalton Pence joined the Top 30 at No. 29. Former Spartanburgers Josh Trentadue (26) and Leandro Lopez (28) also joined the fold.

WEAKNESS V. WEAKNESS: This week, Hub City's offense, a unit with the fourth-worst OPS in the SAL, matchup (.632) matches up with the pitching staff w/ the third-worst ERA in the SAL (4.79). Asheville's road ERA (4.64) is 30 points better than its home ERA, and the 'Burgers hit 10 points better at home (.223).

THE BUFFALO STREAKS ON: Arturo Disla tied the Spartanburgers' record 14-game on-base streak, set by Malcolm Moore. Disla has reached in every game of July. Over that span, he's 16-52 (.308) at the plate and has more RBI (12) than strikeouts (10)

H2H 2K24: Asheville and Hickory matched up 24 times last season. Hickory took 13 of the 24 games, including eight at McCormick Field. Gleider Figuereo led the Crawdads with a .341 average, but surprisingly, hit no HR. Rangers' No. 18 prospect Cam Cauley cranked five long balls against the Tourists, and top prospect Sebastian Walcott, Arturo Disla and Alejandro Osuna tied for second with three.

RANGERS AND TOURISTS: For five years, the Asheville Tourists served as a Rangers affiliate (1976-81) as part of both the Western Carolinas League and the South Atlantic League. Two-time all-star and NL Reliever of the Year Tom Henke was a staple of the Asheville 'pen in 1981. After the Tourists were no longer affiliated with Texas, future Rangers stars Ruben Sierra and Pudge Rodriguez also made stop in Asheville on their way to the bigs.

CLUB INFO & COACHING STAFF



The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the Down East

Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager, and Chad Comer serves as the first manager in Spartanburger's history.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ball-park seats over 5,000 people. The Johnson



Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Sprartanburgers game is the home opener in 2025 against Bowling Green.



Chad Comer - Manager

Chad Comer is the first ever manager of the Hub City Spartanburgers. He enters his tenth year as a coach in the minor leagues and joins Hub City after two seasons as the manager of the then-High-A Hickory Crawdads. Comer played collegiately for the University of Texas-Arlington. A four-year starter, he was named to the Buster Posey Watch List prior to his senior season. He was drafted in the 29th round of the 2011 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves, and he played two seasons of minor league baseball.



Drew Sannes - Hitting Coach

Drew Sannes joins the Hub City Spartanburgers as the hitting coach for the 2025 season after spending the past two years as the hitting coach for the Hickory Crawdads. In 2022, Sannes served as a development coach for the ACL Rangers. His coaching career began in 2020 when he served as the head coach at North Iowa Community College. As a player, Sannes started his collegiate career at the University of North Dakota. He finished it hitting .275 in two seasons with Concordia University-St. Paul.



Thomas St. Clair - Pitching Coach

Thomas St. Clair begins his fourth season as a coach in the Texas Rangers organization and first as the pitching coach for the Hub City Spartanburgers. St. Clair previously served as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College. The Winston-Salem, NC native played his college ball at Lenoir-Rhyne. He was drafted in the 24th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. St. Clair played two seasons in the minor leagues.



Jav Sullenger - Development Coach

Jay Sullenger has served as a player development coach in the Rangers organization since 2019. Previously, Sullenger spent five years as the head coach at Biola University and over a decade as the associate head coach at James Madison University.



Elevys Gonzalez - Development Coach

Elevys Gonzalez began his Rangers coaching career in 2020 as a hitting coach in the DSL. He served as the DSL Rangers manager for two years before coming to the states. Gonzalez is a native of Venezuela and played professionally for six years in the minor leagues.
