

#### By the Numbers

OF Jorge Burgos is the 11th Captain to be promoted to Double-A Akron this season. 14 Captains have advanced at least 1 level, with C Zac Fascia (7/13), OF Angel Zarate (7/13) and RHP Juan Zapata (5/9, 7/26) being assigned to Triple-A Columbus.

75 Since being promoted from Single-A Lynchburg on June 3, INF Angel Genao leads the Midwest League with 75 hits. He also leads the league with 19 doubles and is 2<sup>nd</sup> with a .318 AVG in this span.

Lake County leads the Midwest League and is 2<sup>nd</sup> in High-A with 546 walks. <u>The Captains have drawn their</u> most walks through 119 games since at least 2005.

# CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: After 6 innings, rain shortened Lake County's 5-2 win versus Cedar Rapids in Tuesday's series opener.

Captains LHP **Adam Tulloch** (6-0) earned the win in relief, retiring all 4 batters faced in relief. Kernels starter Tanner Hall (0-2) got the loss, allowing all 5 runs across 4.1 innings. Lake County starter **Rorik Maltrud** (ND) tied a High-A best with 6 strikeouts, allowing a pair of solo home runs across 4.2 innings.

THAT 70<sup>TH</sup> WIN: Lake County garnered its 70<sup>th</sup> win on Tuesday, tying the 2022 season for the 2<sup>nd</sup>-fastest team in franchise history to reach 70 wins, trailing only the 2003 team.

TUNED IN: LF Wuilfredo Antunez went 2-for-2 with a double and a 2-run home run, his first at the High-A level, extending his hit streak to 11 games between Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg. <u>During the streak, Antunez is batting .432 (16-for-37) with a 1.315 OPS, 4 HR, 4 2B and 13 RBI.</u>

ON THE MOVE: On Monday, the Cleveland PD system announced Captains OF Jorge Burgos was promoted to Double-A Akron. Burgos leads Lake County and is 6th in the Midwest League with 15 homers. Burgos is the 11th Captain and 5th position player to be promoted to Double-A Akron in 2024.

JOHNNY B. GOODE: With a walk on Sunday, C Johnny Tincher extended his on-base streak to 19. Tincher is tied for the 2nd-longest active on-base streak in the Midwest League and tied for 3rd among Minor League catchers.

THE 30-40 CLUB: INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 24 Cleveland prospect, stole his 40<sup>th</sup> base on Tuesday versus Cedar Rapids, joining OF Greg Allen (2015) as the only Captains in franchise history with 30+ extra-base hits and 40+ stolen bases in a season. Mooney is 1 of 14 Minor Leaguers and the only Midwest Leaguer in 2024 to accomplish the feat. Teammate Esteban González has also reached these marks this year across Single-A Lynchburg and Lake County.

WINNING WAVES: By clinching a winning record this season, the Captains have now had a winning record in 14 of their first 21 seasons, including in each of their last 5 campaigns. By winning the Midwest League East First Half Division title, <u>Lake County will make its 8thelayoff appearance in franchise history (6 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole league title in franchise history.</u>

#### TRENDS & NOTABLES

DELUCIA DOMINANCE: RHP Dylan DeLucia was named Captain of the Week, presented by Official League, for his 2 strong starts at West Michigan. In his 2 starts against the Whitecaps, he pitched 9.2 shutout innings, allowing 4 hits and a walk while striking out 8. <u>DeLucia was 1 of 5 Minor League pitchers to make 2 scoreless starts. In his last 3 starts, DeLucia has an 0.61 ERA, a .122 opposing average and 17 strikeouts.</u>

ROCKET FOR AN ARM: INF Jose Devers was voted "Best Infield Arm" in the Midwest League by MWL managers in Baseball America's midseason poll. In 66 games (all starts) at SS, Devers has 158 assists, which rank 9<sup>th</sup> in the Midwest League and 6<sup>th</sup> among MWL shortstops.

ALL THAT BASE: 2B Travis Bazzana, MLB Pipeline's No. 1 Cleveland and No. 13 overall prospect, is batting .324 (11-for-34) with 1 HR, 4 2B and 5 RBI in his last 10 games. Bazzana has reached base in 14 of his first 15 starts since his July 26 debut at Great Lakes.

T'S GENAO OR NEVER: INF Angel Genao, MLB Pipeline's No. 6 Cleveland and No. 93 overall prospect, went 1-for-3 with a RBI single on Tuesday. He has hit safely in 45 of his first 57 High-A games, and his 136 hits across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg are 5th in MiLB and lead the Cleveland system. He became the 1st Minor Leaguer with a .330+AVG, 130+H, 40+XBH, and 20+SB in the first 112 team games of a season since OF Luis Robert Jr., OF Alonzo Harris, and OF Daniel Carbonell did it in 2019.

TUGBOAT CRUISE: LHP Matt Wilkinson leads Mil.B with a 1.92 ERA and .161 opposing average, and ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> with and 164 strikeouts. Wilkinson is looking to become the 1<sup>st</sup> Minor League pitcher to win both the Mil.B ERA and strikeout titles since eventual 3-time MLB All-Star and 2-time World Series Champion Josh Beckett did so in 2001 across Class A-Advanced Brevard County and Double-A Portland.

THE ATLANTIC CAMPAIGN: Since 2021, 15 of Cleveland's draft picks have come from the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC), including 6 in the 2023 MLB Draft and 2 in the 2024 Draft. Of those 13 ACC draftees, 7 have been Captains this year (LHP Shawn Rapp, LHP Parker Messick, OF Angel Zarate, 1B/LF C.J. Kayfus, C Cooper Ingle, and INF Alex Mooney, C Jacob Cozart), with 5 total '23 draftees being current Top 30 Cleveland prospects by MLB Pipeline.

EXTRA, EXTRA, RUN ALL ABOUT ITI: INF Alex Mooney (34 XBH, 40 SB) and OF Esteban González (35 XBH, 41 SB) are 2 of 10 MiLB players with 34+ XBH and 40+ SB this season. Cleveland is 1 of 3 organizations with multiple players in this group (Oakland and Chicago (NL) also have 2).

ACE OF BASE: In the bottom of the 5th inning during Lake County's 3-1 win over Beloit on August 2, CF Jonah Advincula stole team bases No. 167 and No. 168 on the season, setting a new single-season franchise record in the team's 21-season history. The 2024 Captains surpassed the 2009 team that stole 166 bases. Lake County leads MiLB with an 87.3% stolen base percentage this season.

State University (2007-2019)...Under his guidance, the Owls had 23 pitchers selected in the MLB Draft...his career was highlighted in 2014, leading the pitching staff to a combined 3.50 ERA and saw KSU take its first ever A-Sun Championship as well as the NCAA Division I Tallahassee Regional.

LAST TIME OUT: On Aug. 21 at West Michigan, Matt Wilkinson (4-4) suffered the loss in the 6-2 defeat. Wilkinson pitched 5 innings, allowing a pair of solo home runs and 3 hits, striking out 8 and walking 1. <u>Since August 2 versus Beloit, Wilkinson has retired 64 of 81 batters faced. Since July 6 versus Dayton, his .123 opposing average is 3<sup>rd</sup> in MiLB.</u>

MINOR LEAGUE RANKS: Across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg, Wilkinson leads qualified Minor League pitchers with 13.71 strikeouts per 9 innings and a 39.1% strikeout rate. He also leads MiLB with a 1.92 ERA and a .161 opposing average, while ranking 2<sup>nd</sup> with 164 strikeouts. Wilkinson and then-Double-A Akron (current Triple-A Columbus) LHP Logan Allen are the only Cleveland Minor Leaguers since at least 2005 to reach 100+ strikeouts through a team's first 70 games.

ALL ABOARD THE "TUGBOAT": Wilkinson has held the nickname "Tugboat" from a young age. His father's best friend growing up, Phil McNeil, gave Matt the nickname, "after seeing Wilkinson run around the bases at a pace he thought was similar to that of the boat designed to tow larger vessels," MLB.com's Rob Terranova wrote. "I love it, I love being called Tugboat," Wilkinson said to Terranova. "But I don't want people to forget that I'm Matt Wilkinson, too."

A START FOR THE AGES: On April 25, Wilkinson made Minor League Baseball history in his start against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (Single-A, CHC). The left-hander pitched 6 scoreless, hitless innings, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 15 strikeouts in 82 pitches (56 strikes). According to MiLB.com's Jesús Cano, Wilkinson became the 5th MiLB pitcher since 2005 to record at least 15 strikeouts without allowing a hit. The MLB pitchers to do this are Hall-of-Famer Warren Spahn (1960), 1971 NL All-Star Don Wilson (1967), Hall-of-Famer Nolan Ryan (3 times), 3-time NL Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw (2014, whom Wilkinson said was his favorite player at the 2015 Little League World Series), and 3-time Cy Young Award winner Max Scherzer (2015).

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Wilkinson was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for the month of April as a member of the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. <u>In 4 starts, he went 2-0 with a 0.44 ERA, a Minor League-best 41 strikeouts, and a Minor League-best .091 opposing AVG.</u> Wilkinson also allowed just 6 hits and 6 walks in 20.2 innings of work.

VALIANT VAQUERO: After initially committing to the University of Washington, Wilkinson pitched collegiately at Central Arizona College (JUCO), where he was 2023 NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year, a 2023 NJCAA 1st Team All-American, the 2023 ABCA/Rawlings Pitcher of the Year, and the Arizona Community College Athletic Association Pitcher of the Year In 2023, the he went 10-2 with a 1.07 ERA, 136 strikeouts, a 0.73 WHIP, and 2 complete games in 16 appearances (14 starts) and won the NJCAA Division I Baseball World Series in 2022. Following his 2023 campaign, Wilkinson eventually chose to forgo his commitment to Arizona State after being selected by the Guardians in the 10th round of the 2023 MLB Draft.

LITTLE LEAGUE LEGEND: When he was 12 years old, Wilkinson had a remarkable performance at the 2015 Little League World Series as a member of Team Canada. In his only start, he pitched 5 scoreless innings against Team Mexico, allowing just 2 hits and throwing 16 strikeouts in a 1-0 defeat. "(The LLWS) was definitely a cool experience, it was like a dream come true," Wilkinson told The Daily Sentinel's James Burky. "It felt like more than a game for the first couple of weeks. Leading up to the tournament, you had to do ESPN interviews, all of those walkup things. I loved it because it was something that I wanted to do since I was eight."

MORE ON WILKINSON: Wilkinson grew up in Ladner, British Columbia, the same hometown as current Boston Red Sox LHP James Paxton. Has 2 Australian Kelpie dogs, Reggie and Mookie, named after Baseball Hall-of-Famer Reggie Jackson and 8-time MLB All-Star Mookie Betts.

TRAVIS TRAVERSES THE WATERS: On Friday, July 19, the Cleveland Guardians announced that 2B Travis Bazzana would begin his Minor League career with the Lake County Captains. After being officially assigned to Lake County on Friday, July 26, he became the 716th Captain of all-time.

MAKING HISTORY: On Sunday, July 14, the Guardians selected Bazzana with the 1st overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft. <u>He is the first No. 1 overall pick in Cleveland franchise history, as well as the 1st second baseman and Australian-born player taken No. 1 overall in MLB Draft history.</u>

DOUBLE TROUBLE: On Friday, August 16 versus the Great Lakes Loons, Bazzana tied a Captains single-game franchise record with 3 doubles, which were in each of his final 3 plate appearances. His last 2 doubles each drove in a run, as he was responsible for both of Lake County's runs in an eventual 5-2 defeat. Bazzana became the 14th Captain to achieve the feat, and the first since INF Alex Mooney did so on April 27 at West Michigan.

INSPIRING HIS COUNTRY: Bazzana is seeking to become the 36\* Australian-born player in MLB history. There have been 3 MLB All-Stars born in Australia: 3-time All-Star closer Liam Hendriks, 2013 All-Star closer Grant Balfour, and 1999 All-Star catcher Dave Nillson. "The premise of everything I want to achieve is I want to make Australia a powerhouse in baseball," Bazzana told MLB.com's Sonja Chen. "It's not going to come from me, but I want to start that trend."

KING OF CORVALLIS: Bazzana played 3 collegiate seasons at Oregon State. The left-handed hitter set many school records, including career marks for: hits (251), doubles (52), home runs (45), total bases (460), stolen bases (66), and walks (180). His 36 stolen bases in 2023 also set a single-season school record, and he helped lead the Beavers to a pair of NCAA Super Regionals appearances in 2022 and 2024. Bazzana was a 3-time 1st Team All-Pac-12 honoree, while being named an All-American by multiple organizations in each of his last 2 years at Oregon State. Additionally, he played for the Corvallis Knights of the West Coast League in 2021. Bazzana had a remarkable season, leading the leaque in: batting average (.429, then-single-season league record), hits (81), runs (46), triples (5, tied), slugging percentage (.593), OPS (1.064), and total bases (112) en route to WCL MVP honors and Corvallis's 5st straight league championship.

A SEASON TO REMEMBER: This year, Bazzana ranked top-10 in Division I in: walks (76, 2<sup>nd</sup>), on-base percentage (.568, 2<sup>nd</sup>), slugging percentage (.911, 2<sup>nd</sup>), runs (84, T-6<sup>nh</sup>), home runs (28, T-7<sup>nh</sup>), total bases (195, T-7<sup>nh</sup>), and batting average (.407, 8<sup>nh</sup>). His 84 runs, 28 home runs, and .911 slugging percentage, and 195 total bases were all Oregon State single-season school records, while his 70 walks tied a single-season school record. Bazzana was named the 2024 Pac-12 Player of the Year, while being recognized as a 1<sup>st</sup> Team All-American by the ABCA, Baseball America, the College Baseball Foundation, D1baseball.com, the NCBWA, and Perfect Game. He was also a Golden Spikes Award finalist (best amateur baseball player in U.S.) and Dick Howser Trophy semifinalist (national college baseball player of the year).

BAZZANA TAKES THE CAPE: Bazzana dominated in his lone season in the Cape Cod Baseball League (CCBL) last year. He was named the 2023 Cape Cod Baseball League Pat Sorenti MVP after winning the league's batting title with a .375 average. Bazzana also tallied 51 hits. 33 runs. 6 doubles. 6 home runs. 31 RBI. 14 stolen bases, and a 1.037 OPS in 33 regular-season games.

A PLAYER BEYOND HIS YEARS: When he was 3, Bazzana was playing baseball against 6-year-olds. Then, 12 years later, he was already playing professionally in the Australian Baseball League at just 15 years old. "I was always competitive," Bazzana told ESPN's Jeff Passan. "That's the one thing that I think was the base for me to go far in whatever I was pursuing: a competitive nature to where I was going to find a way to be a little bit better than the next guy or the guy next to me or whoever I was competing with."

THE ATHLETIC AUSTRALIAN: During his time at Turramurra High School in Australia, Bazzana represented Team Australia in the 2019 U18 Baseball World Cup. He recorded 6 hits and 4 RBI in 9 games. Bazzana also played cricket for his high school team, captaining his squad to its first state championship in school history. He also played basketball, soccer, and rugby for Turramurra, while participating in track and field (100m dash, long jump, and high jump) as well.

#### WHAT THEY'RE SAYING

Chris Antonetti, Cleveland Guardians President of Baseball Operations: "We view him to be a dynamic player. He's a guy that makes really good swing decisions, controls the strike zone really well, rarely swings and misses, and can really impact the baseball. And we think he's got a chance to impact the game in a variety of ways.

But as impressive as he is as an athlete and as a player, he's just as impressive, or more impressive, as a person. He has been relentless, I think from the time he was 3 years old, to take advantage of every resource available to him to become the best baseball player he can possibly be. And I think it's a testament to his hard work and the support system that he's had around him to be able to get to this point."

Rob Cerfolio, Cleveland Guardians Director of Player Development: "We are incredibly excited to welcome Travis to the organization and for him to make his Minor League debut with the Captains. Travis's on-field successes over his college career speak for themselves, but we are even more impressed with the type of person he is and his dedication to maximizing his ability. We look forward to partnering with him on future growth both on and off the field."

MLB Pipeline: "Bazzana drew mild interest from big league teams as an Australian amateur before deciding to play collegiately in the United States and impressing Oregon State at an Arizona showcase. He was a Freshman All-American in 2022, then set a Beavers record with 36 steals and won the Cape Cod League MVP award and batting title (.375) as an encore. He took his performance to another level this spring, slashing .407/.568/.911, finishing second in NCAA Division I in on-base percentage, slugging and OPS (1.479) and breaking another school record with 28 homers. After overcoming long odds to win the Draft Lottery, the Guardians selected him with the No. 1 overall pick and signed him for \$8.95 million. Bazzana has no discernible weakness at the plate, where his lightning-fast and compact left-handed stroke allows him to barrel balls with ease. He makes excellent swing decisions, uses the entire field and consistently produces high-end exit velocities. While he's more hitter than slugger, he gets to most of his plus raw power, and it plays from left field to the right-field foul pole. Adding to his offense package, Bazzana possesses plus speed and looks to steal and take extra bases. His athleticism gives him range in the middle infield, where his quick hands are an asset, though his fringy to average arm strength limits him to second base. With Gold Glover Andrés Giménez manning the keystone in Cleveland, it's possible that Bazzana's quickest route to the Majors could be as a center fielder.

Baseball America: "Bazzana has put on a hitting clinic in three years at Oregon State. The Australia native played in the college summer West Coast League as an 18-year-old in 2021 and excelled, setting the stage for a strong freshman season in 2022. Bazzana hit over .300 in each college season and improved year over year, culminating in a 2024 campaign in which he battled Georgia's Charlie Condon for the best overall offensive season in the country, A 6-foot, 199-pound lefthanded hitter and second baseman, Bazzana's offensive profile is built around his elite bat-to-ball skills. He has an unusual-looking swing with a deep bat tip behind his shoulder and a sizable leg kick, but he has always found the barrel at a high clip and produced an 84% contact rate in his three seasons with the Beavers. He pairs that skill with a savvy approach at the plate and strong swing decisions, helping him walk more than he struck out in his career. In 2024, his excellent 25.8% walk rate ranked second only to Nick Kurtz for the best among Division I hitters. Bazzana added more home run power in his draft season as well, going from 11 home runs in 2023 to 28 in 2024, with a corresponding increase in his exit velocity data. Bazzana's swing seems optimized to maximize the power he does have, and while he's nearly maxed-out physically, he might be the sort of player who always makes the most of his natural raw power. Bazzana is a plus runner and strong athlete who should be able to play second base, though he frequently throws with an odd sidearm slot that some scouts question. He could be athletic enough to play center field as well. Bazzana has all-star upside and is the best prospect from Oregon State since Adley Rutschman in 2019."

Oregon State Head Coach Mitch Canham (via The Oregonian/OregonLive's Joe Freeman): "He wants everything. Scouting reports, data, video. He doesn't get locked up mentally by all the analytics. He wants them all."

Trent Oeltjen, former Australian MLB outfielder and current mentor to Bazzana (via ESPN's Jeff Passan): ""He understands that he's doing this for the whole country. And he knows all the kids are now looking up to him and want to be in Travis Bazzana's shoes. He remembers where he comes from, and he's very proud of where he did come from, and he's driving to really change the game of international students and Australians to follow behind him."

Steven Kwan, Cleveland Guardians left fielder, 2024 American League All-Star starter, and former Oregon State Beaver (during Captains rehab media availability on 5/25): "He's a leader. ## CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

7 former Lake County Captains have made their MLB debut during the 2024 season.

INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel: On Wednesday, June 26, INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Baltimore Orioles. He started at first base and batted 9<sup>th</sup> in the Guardians' order, finishing 1-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. In his 1<sup>st</sup> MLB at-bat, Noel hit a 413-foot solo home run to center field, becoming the 4<sup>th</sup> player in Cleveland franchise history to home in his 1<sup>st</sup> career MLB at-bat. He was the first to do so since 2004 Captain Kevin Kouzmanoff, who became the 1<sup>st</sup> player in MLB history to hit a grand slam on his 1<sup>st</sup> MLB pitch on September 2, 2006. Noel played 88 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .238 with 78 hits, 12 doubles, 27 home runs, 67 RBI, a .521 SLG, and an .827 OPS.

LHP Raymond Burgos: On Monday, June 24, LHP Raymond Burgos made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Chicago Cubs. He pitched 1 inning of relief, allowing 3 hits, 1 earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 1 strikeout. Burgos made 48 regular-season appearances (11 starts) for the Captains across the 2019, 2021, and 2022 seasons, going 10-6 with a 2.83 ERA, 115 strikeouts, a 1.29 WHIP, a .255 opposing batting average, and 8 holds, converting 1 of his 2 save opportunities. He also made 3 postseason relief appearances for Lake County in 2022, tallying a 4.26 ERA, 6 strikeouts, 2 walks, and a .150 opposing batting average, converting his lone save opportunity in Game 2 of the Midwest League East Championship Series.

**INF/OF Daniel Schneemann:** On Sunday, June 2, **INF Daniel Schneemann** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Washington Nationals. He started at 2<sup>nd</sup> base and batted 8<sup>th</sup> in the Guardians' order, going 1-for-3 with a 2-run double on his first MLB pitch and a strikeout. **Schneemann** played 98 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2018, 2019, and 2021 seasons, hitting .267 with 86 hits, 13 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 43 RBI, 12 stolen bases, and a .711 OPS. He also played 3 postseason games for Lake County in 2019, hitting .182 (2-for-11) with 2 runs, 2 RBI, and 1 walk.

**1B/OF Trenton Brooks:** On Tuesday, May 28, **1B/OF Trenton Brooks** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Philadelphia Phillies.
