vs. the Nashville Sounds (Milwaukee Brewers). It is the 10th of 18 games between the two clubs this season, and the fourth of 12 games Gwinnett will play in Nashville. With a victory tonight, the Stripers would have their first threegame road winning streak of the year.

VS. NASHVILLE: Following 7-2 and 4-1 wins, Gwinnett is 5-10 (.333) all-time in Nashville and 15-23 (.395) vs. the Sounds overall. In six series against the Sounds since first meeting in 2021, the Stripers are 1-4-1. Their only series win was 6/15-21, 2021 at Coolray Field (won 3-2).

STIFLING STAFF: Gwinnett leads Triple-A in ERA in June with a 3.32 mark in 20 games. That's 0.29 points lower than Scranton/WB (2nd, 3.61 ERA in 21G). Stripers' starters Tucker Davidson, Bryce Elder, Nolan Kingham, Kyle Muller, and Huascar Ynoa have combined to post a 3.43 ERA (43 ER in 112.2 IP), 9.83 SO/9.0 IP ratio (123 SO), and 10 quality starts this month.

KINGS OF THE "K": The Stripers' pitching staff leads Triple-A in strikeouts with 708 in 69 games (10.26 SO per game). That's nine more than Sacramento of the Pacific Coast League (2nd, 699 SO in 69G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (teamrecord 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (1st, 92), Tucker Davidson (6th, 66), and Huascar Ynoa (T-11th, 57) all rank in the International League top 15 in strikeouts.

CASTEEL IN THE CLUTCH: Ryan Casteel lifted an oppositefield two-run homer (#6) to right off RHP Alec Bettinger last night, snapping a 1-1 tie in the seventh. Of Casteel's 15 hits this season, 10 have gone for extra bases (3 doubles, 1 triple, 6 homers). For his Gwinnett career, 48.0% of his hits have been for extra bases (24 of 50), including nine doubles, one triple, and 14 homers.

JOLTIN' JOE DUNAND: Joe Dunand capped a near-cycle (3-for-4, 12B, 1 HR, 2 RBI) with his first homer as a Striper last night, a 428-foot solo shot to left off RHP Alec Bettinger in the ninth. In 13 games with Gwinnett, he is batting .304 (14-for-46, 3 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 8 R, 7 RBI, .863 OPS).

DESHIELDS STREAKING: Delino DeShields Jr. (0-for-1, BB) saw his seven-game hitting streak and seven-game run scoring streak ended last night, but extended his on-base streak to 11 games. He's batting .414 (12-for-29, 1 2B, 1 HR. 10 R. 5 RBI. 5 SB. 10 BB. 1.113 OPS) on the on-base streak since 6/3, tied for his longest of the year (had an 11G streak from 4/21-5/5). Overall with Gwinnett, DeShields has reached base safely in 41 of 48 games (85.4%), batting .281 (38-for-135, 5 2B, 1 HR, 24 R, 15 RBI).

• IL Leaderboard: DeShields ranks among IL leaders in stolen bases (T-7th, 15) and walks (T-11th, 35).

RISING WATERS: Drew Waters is batting .333 (8-for-24, 1 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 2 R, 3 RBI, 1.012 OPS) over his last six games since 6/17, including a pair of three-hit efforts (3-for-5 on 6/19 vs. IND, 3-for-4 on 6/22 at NAS).

- Start it With a Bang: Waters has three XBH on the first pitch of the game this year (leadoff homers on 5/3 vs. CLT and 5/11 at DUR, leadoff triple on 6/11 at JAX).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .249 (161-for-646, 33 2B, 3 3B, 17 HR, 105 R, 61 RBI, 32 SB, .715 OPS) in 164 games.

TONIGHT: The Stripers play game four of a six-game series **CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN:** Michael Tonkin locked down his team-leading fifth save last night (5-for-6, T-12th in IL). Over seven June outings, he is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (1 R, 0 ER in 7.1 IP), .120 BAA, and two saves (2-for-2). In 21 games overall. Tonkin is 3-0 with a 2.57 ERA (6 ER in 21.0 IP), .190 BAA, and 14.57 SO/9.0 IP ratio (34 SO).

> KRAMER SAYS "GIDDY UP": Kramer Robertson is riding a seven-game hitting streak, batting .364 (9-for-26, 2 2B, 1 HR, 6 R, 5 RBI, 4 SB, 1.007 OPS) since 6/12. He blasted his first Gwinnett homer on 6/17 vs. Indianapolis, a solo shot on the first pitch of the game from RHP Jerad Eickhoff (GWN's 4th leadoff HR, Waters has 2, Gosselin has 1).

> **SHEW-MAKING IT HAPPEN:** Playing for the first time since 6/12 at Jacksonville, Braden Shewmake went 2-for-5 with a homer (#4) and two RBI on Wednesday (first multi-RBI game of his Triple-A career). He has hit safely in six consecutive games since 6/7, batting .348 (8-for-23, 2 2B, 1 HR, 3 R, 4 RBI, 1 SB, .925 OPS) in that stretch.

> **DOMINANT NIGHT FROM DAVIDSON:** Tucker Davidson logged 6.2 scoreless IP (6 H, 0 BB, 9 SO) on Wednesday, improving to 2-3 with Gwinnett this season. It was his second scoreless start this year, first since 5/17 with Atlanta at Milwaukee (5.0 IP. 3 H. 3 SO in 3-0 win).

• IL Leaderboard: Davidson has fanned 32 batters over 26.1 IP (10.94 SO/9.0 IP ratio) over his last four starts, and now ranks sixth in the IL in strikeouts (66)

MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller retired the final 19 batters he faced on Sunday vs. Indianapolis (6.2 IP. 3 H. 3 ER. 0 BB. 8 SO, 1 HR), producing his fourth straight quality start in a no-decision. He is 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA (5 ER in 26.2 IP), 1.12 WHIP, .221 BAA, and 12.15 SO/9.0 IP ratio (36 SO) during that four-start stretch.

- IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (92) and is among the top 10 in innings (4th, 69.0), WHIP (4th, 1.12), ERA (5th, 3.00), and BAA (5th, .221).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-7 with a 3.21 ERA (53 ER in 148.2 IP), .222 BAA, and 185 strikeouts (11.20 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 29 starts.

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte is batting .129 (4for-31, 4 R, 1 RBI, 1 SB) in eight games with Gwinnett since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 167 of 197 games (84.8%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .277 (189-for-682, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 130 R, 138 RBI, 14 SB, .920 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

TONIGHT'S START: Huascar Ynoa makes his 11th start for Gwinnett and 13th start of the season overall in game four of a six-game series at Nashville.

- <u>GWN Career:</u> Makes his 30th career appearance (27th start) with Gwinnett dating back to his Triple-A debut in 2019 (6-8, 4.93 ERA, .250 BAA, 147 SO in 133.1 IP).
- <u>Triple-A Splits:</u> In 26 career starts, is 5-8 with a 5.04 ERA and .254 BAA ... In 14 career Triple-A road appearances (12 starts), is 3-3 with a 5.10 ERA and .266 BAA.

2022 WITH GWINNETT: Since joining the Stripers on 4/19, has pitched at least 5.0 innings in seven of his nine starts ... **4/24-5/26:** Over his first six starts, went 1-2 with a 5.64 ERA (19 ER in 30.1 IP) and .228 BAA ... **Since 6/1:** In four starts in June, is 2-1 with a 2.86 ERA (4 ER in 16.0 IP) (ranks 8th in the IL) and .192 BAA ... **6/7 at JAX:** Fired 7.0 no-hit innings (3 BB, 6 SO) for the win, combining with **Brandyn Sittinger** (1.0 IP, 1 H) and **Brad Brach** (1.0 IP, 0 H) on a one-hit shutout in a 7-0 victory.

2022 WITH ATLANTA: Made the Braves' Opening Day Roster for the second time in his career (also in 2021) ... Served as the fifth starter, going 0-2 with a 13.50 ERA (10 ER in 6.2 IP) and .355 BAA over two starts ... Optioned to Gwinnett on 4/19.

2021 REGULAR SEASON: In an injury-shortened year with Atlanta, went 4-6 with a 4.05 ERA and .224 BAA in 18 games (17 starts) ... Was on the Braves' Opening Day roster for the first time in his career ... Won four consecutive starts from 4/23-5/9 (4-0, 1.11 ERA, .165 BAA), and drove in more runs (6) than he allowed (4) over that stretch ... Homered in back-to-back games (solo off CHC's Kyle Hendricks on 4/28, grand slam off WSH's Tanner Rainey on 5/4) ...
